

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HECTOR MACPHERSON BANNOCKBURN FARMS, INC. 29626 CHURCH DRIVE ALBANY, OR 97321

confirms the right to use the waters of MUDDY CREEK, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 40.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 12956. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 23, 1938. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.5 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN JOHN G. WILSON DLC 60, SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.; 150 FEET SOUTH AND 450 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF DLC 60; AND

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN JOHN G. WILSON DLC 60, SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.; 800 FEET SOUTH AND 50 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF DLC 60.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.2 ACRES SE 1/4 SE 1/4 32.0 ACRES BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN JOHN G. WILSON DLC 60 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 4.8 ACRES

SECTION 20 TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of

the date of service.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 20, 1979, and supersedes Certificate 19822, State Record of Water Right Certificates.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.





ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4214

On May 7, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Hector Macpherson for approval of a change in place of use of water from Muddy Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 19822, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Hector Macpherson, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second from Muddy Creek for irrigation of a certain 4.8 acres in SE¼ NE¼, 24.8 acres in NE¼ SE¼ of Section 20; and 10.4 acres in NW¼ SW¼ of Section 21, Township 12 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of February 23, 1938.

The two authorized points of diversion are located: (1) 150 feet South and 450 feet East; and (2) 800 feet South and 50 feet East, both from the Northwest Corner of D.L.C. No. 60, being within the NE¼ SE¼ of Section 20, Township 12 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The applicant herein proposes a change in place of use by severing the right from a certain 21.6 acres in NE¼ SE¼ of Section 20 and 10.4 acres in NW¼ SW¼ of Section 21 of the lands above described and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 32.0 acres in SE¼ SE¼ of Section 20, Township 12 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Mr. L. Gene McGinnis, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in place of use is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate recorded at page 19822, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein confirming the change authorized herein and covering the balance of the right NOT involved in the change.
