Final Order

This order confirms the right of record to use the waters of DREWS CREEK AND DREWS RESERVOIR, COTTONWOOD CREEK AND COTTONWOOD RESERVOIR, TRIBUTARIES OF GOOSE LAKE, for IRRIGATION of 14.6 ACRES.

This right of record was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for LAKE County, dated October 3, 1961, in the matter of LAKEVIEW WATER USERS, INC. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 478. The date of priority is January 21, 1907, Drews Creek; July 31, 1908, Cottonwood Creek.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4217

On May 8, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Kay C. Clark for approval of a change in place of use of water from Drews Creek and Drews Reservoir, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

As modified in accord with the provisions of the order of the Water Resources Director entered February 2, 1979, approving transfer No. 3885, the water right previously allowed by Decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County, entered on October 3, 1961, In the Matter of the Determination of the Extent of Completion of the Inchoate Water Rights Allowed by Decree of the Court in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Drews Creek, Antelope Creek, Cottonwood Creek, Thomas Creek and Cogswell Creek, and Their Tributaries, Tributaries of Goose Lake, now exists for the use of 62,500 acre feet of water stored in Drews Reservoir and not to exceed 223 cubic feet per second of water from Drews Creek under a priority date of January 21, 1907, and 4,400 acre feet of stored water from Cottonwood Reservoir and not to exceed 200 cubic feet per second of water from Cottonwood Creek under a priority date of July 31, 1908, for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 14.6 acres in NW4 NW4 of Section 18, Township 40 South, Range 19 East, W.M., as described by the certificate issued to Lakeview Water Users, Inc., recorded at page 47469, Volume 40, State Record of Water Right Certificates. Said lands are irrigated by means of the Lakeview Water Users, Inc., canal system.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 2.0 acres in NW4 NE4 of Section 32; 3.5 acres in SW4 SE4 and 9.1 acres in SE4 SE4 of Section 33, Township 39 South, Range 19 East, W.M.

Mr. Howard Daggett, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights. No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources
Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended
under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore
issued to Lakeview Water Users, Inc., and recorded at page 47469, Volume 40, State
Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a new confirming
certificate of water right be issued to Lakeview Water Users, Inc.



Dear Mr. Bogardus;

As we discussed by phone today, here is a copy of the final proof survey map prepared for transfer 4217. It appears that about 2.9 or 3.0 acres of the land mapped as irrigated is appurtenant to your clients land.

The major difference from the applicants map (copy also enclosed) is on the north and east sides. Our field inspector talked to Mr. Frakes who claimed to own the land at the time. Mr. Frakes did not claim the land on the north end of the parcel as irrigated. It is possible that a mapping error accounts for the difference on the east side.

A copy of our map and the Proposed Partial Certificate were mailed to the Lakeview Water Users Association. We did not receive any comments from them about a possible error. The department has not issued a final certificate to confirm this and other changes in the water rights of the association.

If our map and findings are in error we would make needed corrections. One problem to overcome is the placement of some of the acreage under the transfer elsewhere. One possible solution may be an association petition under the provisions of HB-3111 (1989 session).

After your review, please let me know how you wish to proceed.



Dear Mr. Garner:

Mr. Dennis Glender, the Lake County Water Master, has suggested that I correspond directly with you.

I represent Mrs. Sandra Skubinna, who acquired five acres of land here in Lake County in 1984. This five acre tract is located in Township 39, Range 19, Section 33 in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 thereof. I am attaching to this correspondence an exact legal description of the five acre tract. At the time of the acquisition, my client received five acres of water rights through the Lakeview Water Users, Incorporated.

In 1988 my client sold the property to Frakes and Snyder, at which time the five acres of water right was transferred to them and on the books of the Lakeview Water Users, Incorporated. Due to a default by Frakes and Snyder, my client accepted the property back via deed in 1990. Almost simultaneously with the reacquisition, my client learned that the water right had been reduced from five acres to 2.5 acres through the apparent authority of the State Water Resources Department. I am enclosing a copy of a letter from the Lakeview Water Users to their attorney, indicating that the Water Resources Department had determined that the land in question could only use 2.5 acres of water as opposed to the previous five.

Dear Mr. Mateson:

This is a follow up to various correspondence between myself, you, your Salem office and my attorney, Robert F. Nichols and specifically concerning my request to transfer 14.6 acres of water rights.

I regret that we were unable to get you the information earlier, however, the secretary of Lakeview Water Users, Inc. which has the most accurate information has been in Portland undergoing cancer surgary, so we have had to rely upon other sources.

I have previously submitted to you the sum of \$200 which is the usual transfer or release fee requested. There is enclosed and attached hereto a map of Township 40 South, Range 19 EWM. The specific property which we are asking to have released at least in so far as the water rights are concerned is the NE4NW4NW4 and a portion of the E½ of the NE4NW4NW4, all in Section 18 of Township 40 South, Range 19 EWM. On the map you will see the designated portion which has been cross hatched. The specific water/rights are evidenced by individual certificates of stock and may be transferred separately from the land.

I sold the 14.6 acres for \$250 per acre for a total of \$3,650.00. Actually I sold 7 acres to Dave Sohr and 7.6 acres to Wayne Lee. The reason for the sale, of course, was the fact that it amounted to a duplication since I have developed a water well and put in a sprinkler system to upgrade my ranch. The additional improvements which I put in add to the value of the ranch upon which you have a first mortgage, in excess of \$100,000.00.
