ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4218

On May 9, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Mikami Bros. for approval of a change in point of appropriation from ground water, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 24264, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Allan C. & Florine R. Langenwalter, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second from a certain ground water aquifer for irrigation of a certain 1.6 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 4 North, Range 28 East, W.M., with a date of priority of April 13, 1950.

Water for the said right is diverted from a well located 400 feet South and 2800 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 16, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 4 North, Range 28 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of appropriation therefrom, without loss of priority, to a well located 420 feet South and 2900 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 16, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 4 North, Range 28 East, W.M.

Mr. William S. Bartholomew, Hydrogeologist, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

Mr. William I. Porfily, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of appropriation, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point

of appropriation under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of appropriation as herein confirmed:

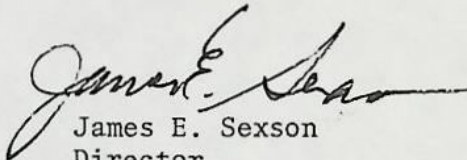
That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of appropriation is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 24264, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

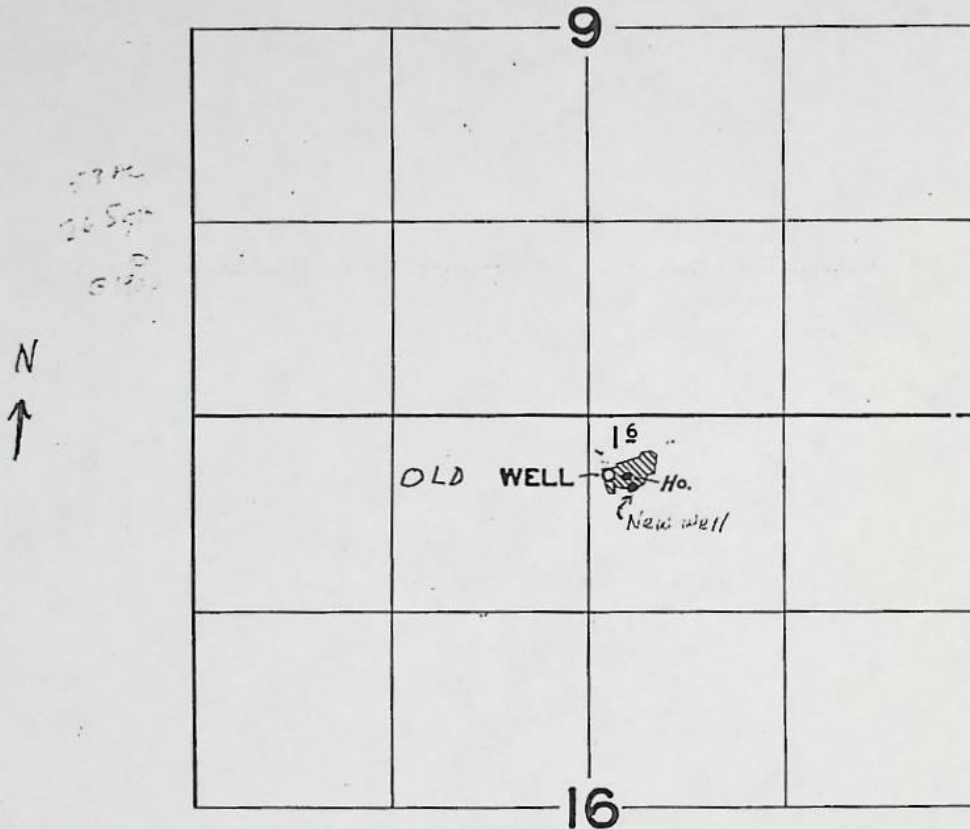

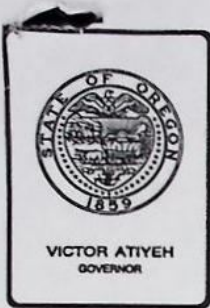

On February 22, 1983, our representative contacted you in connection with the final proof survey for Transfer #4218. The transfer allowed for a change in point of appropriation for the water right described under Certificate No. 24264.

According to the field report, although the new well was drilled, it does not develop sufficient water, so it is used only for household (domestic) purposes. Assuming this information is correct, the right for the irrigation of 1.6 acres appears to have been abandoned and should be cancelled.

I am enclosing an affidavit of abandonment for your use in requesting this cancellation. When the affidavit, signed by you in the presence of a notary, is returned in his office, an order will be entered to cancel the right for irrigation.

The use of water from a well for domestic purposes is exempt under Oregon Law from filing requirements, so no right of record is required.

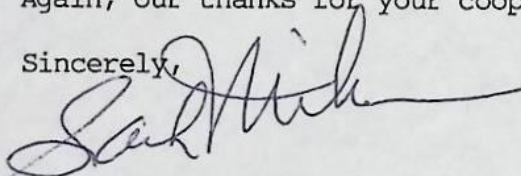

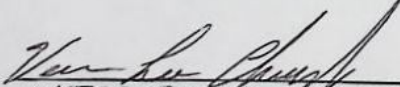

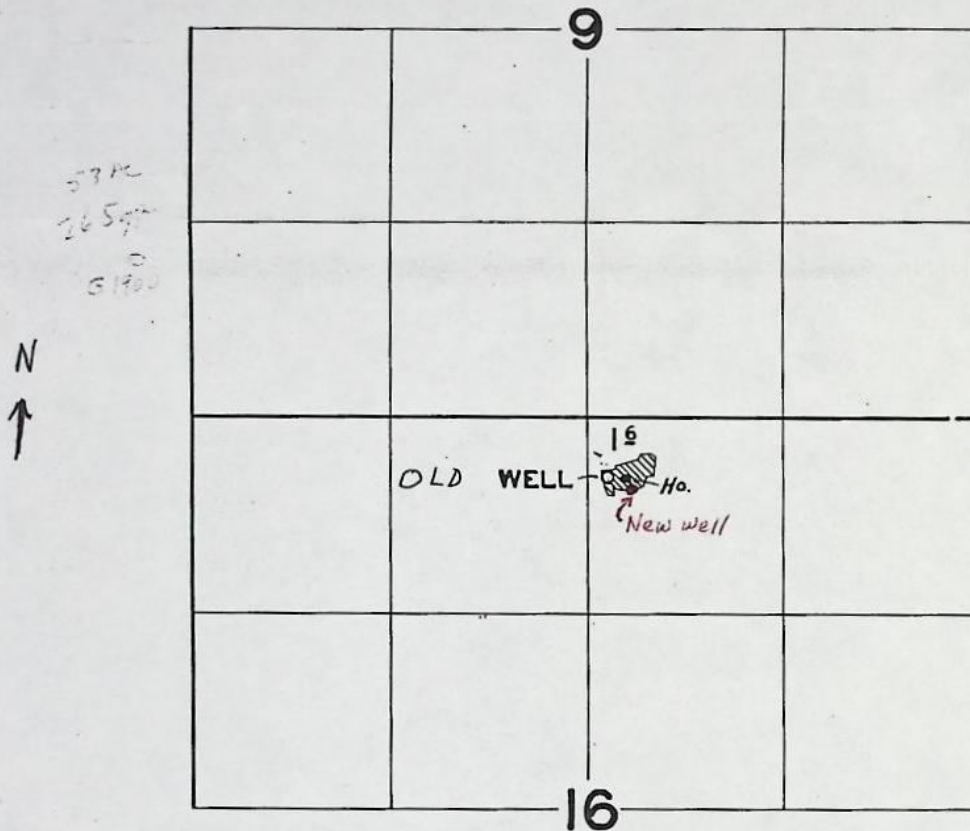

On January 26, 1979, we received an application in the name of the Mikami Brothers which proposed the appropriation of 0.04 cubic foot per second for domestic use and the irrigation of 3.0 acres. The application was not filed because location is within the Ordinance Critical Ground Water Area. New applications cannot be accepted for the appropriation of water within this area.

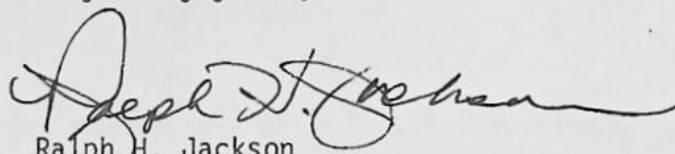
Mr. Christensen requested a copy of the well log for the well providing water under permit No. U-331. The copy fee for this is \$1.50, which has been deducted from the \$30.00 which was submitted with the application. The remainder has been placed in a pending account.

I am told by our ground water geologists that an application for a transfer in point of diversion for the 1.6 acres proposed under permit No. U-331 and confirmed by certificate No. 24264 would be accepted; however, this would not be for acreage in excess of the 1.6 allowed in the earlier right. If a transfer is submitted, it will be necessary to abandon use of water from the old well completely. If this well is left in place to be used for ground water level observations, it will be necessary that a welded cover plate and access port be constructed.

In the event that you wish to make application for a transfer in the point of diversion, I am enclosing a transfer form and instructional brochure.
