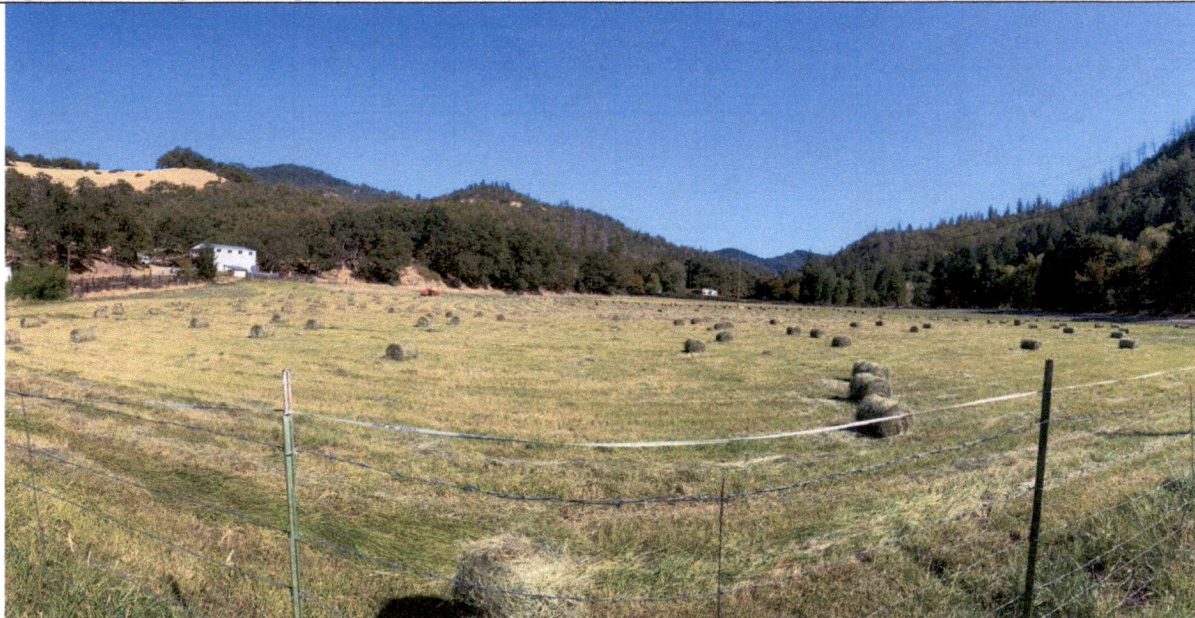


Figure 2. East field looking northeast showing hay production of this field (9/27/2024).

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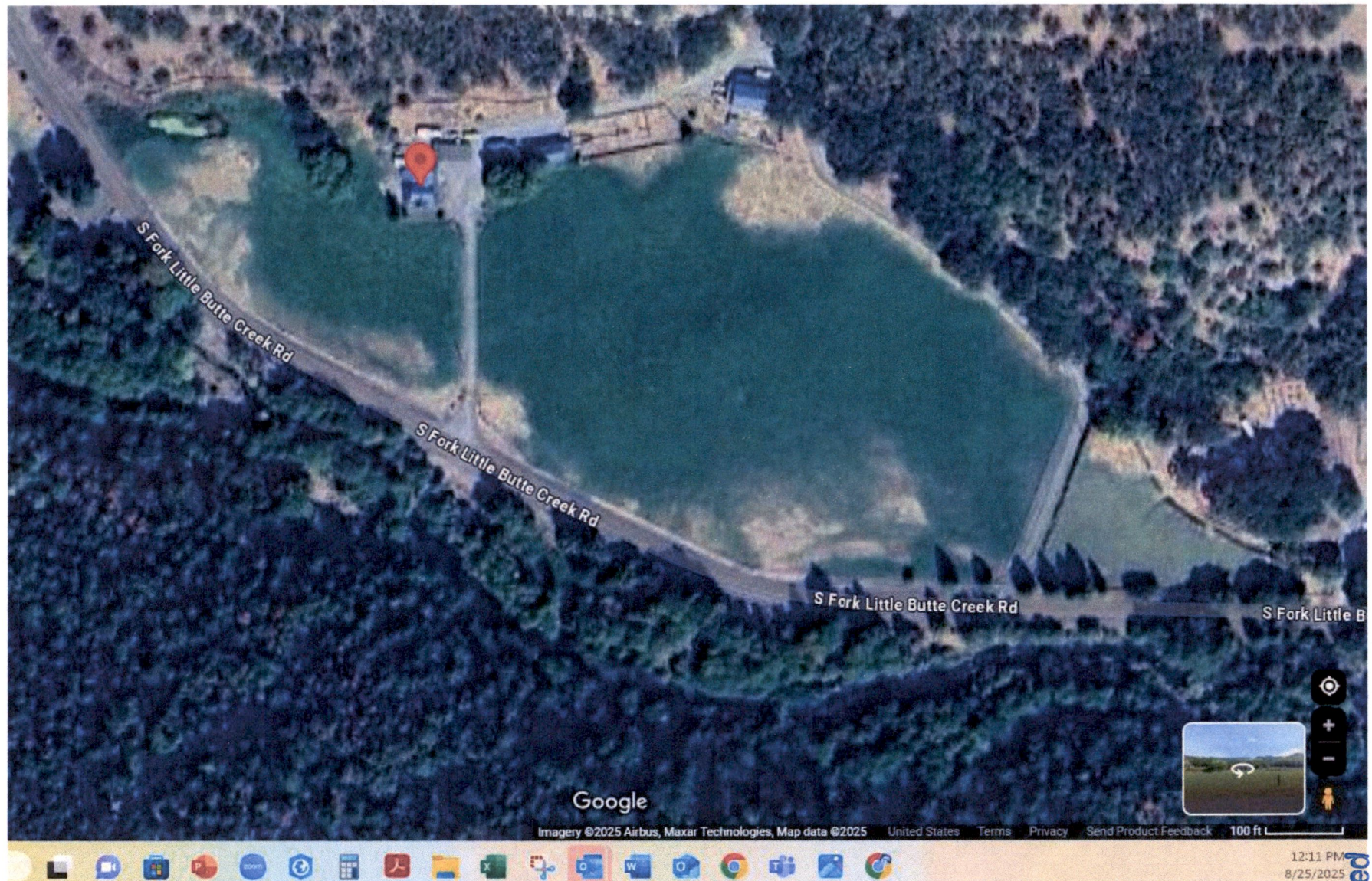
Figure 3. West field looking west showing hay production of this field (9/27/2024).
