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

1. Provide a general narrative description of the distribution works. This description must trace the water system from the point of diversion or appropriation to and include the place of use:

The water is diverted through a lift gate structure at the edge of the South Fork of the Klaskanine River. The old concrete diversion dam has been removed, a series of riffles were constructed to provide flow to the diversion gate and allow free passage of the fish. A winter storm disturbed the rifle system and the Clatsop County Fisheries Council is in the process of permitting to repair the riffles. At the time of inspection the riffles were working with the aid of a few hand placed sand bags. The water flows through approximately 100' of ditch to the fish screen. The fish screen was designed and is maintained by ODFW. The fish screen structure allows bypass flow to return to the river through 12" PVC pipe. The fish screen is self cleaning powered by the water flow downstream of the fish screen.

The water flows from the fish screen through 950 feet of 30" diameter HDPE pipe underground northwest to the distribution system at the fish rearing pond. The water enters a diversion box where the flow distribution can be controlled with flash boards. The outlet works at the north end of the rearing pond is a flash-board weir, this weir system is used as the measuring device to gauge water flow. These flash boards also control the pond water elevation. The rearing pond is used to raise and protect two types of salmon. Chinook salmon are spawned on site. Coho salmon juveniles are brought in and raised in the pond.

The water overflows the flash boards and flows through a 30" steel pipe into the spawning pen below the pond. The spawning pen has removable bars by the spawning shed and at the bottom attached to the fish ladder, these structures allow or prevent the adult fish from entering and passing through the spawning pen. The water flows through the spawning pen to a concrete fish ladder along the South Fork of the Klaskanine River. The fish ladder uses flash-boards to control the water level of the spawning pen. The water rejoins a small side channel of the river below the fish ladder approximately 1,400' below the diversion gate.

Although there are ditches in the aquaculture system none of the ditches flow at capacity because the flow is restricted by the diversion lift gate and the by-pass gate. The water levels in the pond and spawning pen are controlled with the flash boards at the pond outlet and the fish ladder.

We do not consider this as a reservoir and do not include it in this section.

The fish screen is operated by water flow and maintained by Fish and Wildlife. The flow is controlled by the diversion gate and the water levels are controlled by the flash boards in the pond outlet and the fish ladders. The water flow is diverted through the fish hatchery and returned to the river directly below the hatchery.

A Wild NA24 level was used to check the vertical drop through the system.







- 7. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and/or safely transport fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted and that the diversion is currently equipped with an appropriate fish screening and/or by-pass device.
- 8. On August 6, 2007, the Clatsop County Assessor's office was contacted to clarify current ownership of the lands involved in Transfer T-10403. The Assessor's office confirmed that Weyerhaeuser Corporation is the current owner of record for Tax Lot 4900 in the SE ¼ SW ¼ of Section 30 and the NE ¼ NW ¼ of Section 31, T 7 N, R 8 W, W.M., as well as the existing and proposed points of diversion (Tax Lot 3100 in the NW ¼ NE ¼ of Section 31, T 7 N, R 8 W, W.M.) for Certificates 63289 and 63301. The place of use is in Tax Lot 700, owned by Clatsop County.
- 9. On October 24, 2007, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10403 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline of November 30, 2007, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 10. On January 3, 2008, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer T-10403 and mailed a copy to the applicants. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on January 15, 2008, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 11. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the
 existing rights was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application
 T-10403.
- 13. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.

14. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

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Conclusions of Law

The change in point of diversion proposed in application T-10403 appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The change in point of diversion proposed in application T-10403 is approved.
- Water right certificates 63289 and 63301 are cancelled.

Hi Tom,

Per my phone message, here is a power point (in PDF) that Sean Welch of NRCS and I provided to John Johnson and Megan Callahan Grant at NMFS yesterday. John provided NOAA concurrence on the designs, completing the ESA compliance (under USFWS programmatic restoration BO).

The project will remove a 27 year old concrete dam on the South Fork Klatskanine River (just above confluence with the main Klatskanine River and about 300+ yards above tidal influence in Youngs River). The dam is used by the county for a fish hatchery. It is a substantial fish passage barrier, limiting access for salmonids and coastal cutthroat trout to 3.1 miles of spawning/rearing habitat above.

The dam will be replace by a series of three low head diversions with rocks spaced to allow streaming flow for fish passage (including chum) at all velocities. Sean has modeled the hydraulics on the system and has output showing predicted flow depth and velocities at the structures that should pass fish including at 5% and 95% exceedence levels. Ryan at the Screen Shop has designed a fish screen. Reducing the size of the wasteway (or accomodating fish movement via fishway) was recommended by John Johnson, but otherwise the screen part is pretty solid.

There is a substantial grade differential below the dam due to blockage of sediment transport processes. The design proposed to fill the plunge pool with native material and rebuild the channel grade via geomorphic riffle structures that provide for fish passage at all flows. Some root wads and large wood will be placed through this section to further reduce velocities along the bank. The design overall should provide immediate fish passage throughout the entire channel reach as well as enhanced habitat.

Enclosed is our presentation to NMFS. I will follow with 3 emails that break down Sean's design package.

Maybe we could discuss these a bit and then have a teleconference with Sean to ensure we have all your input prior to submitting the fish passage permit request. Feel free to give me a call when you have a chance.

This memorandum has been prepared to document that the following project is consistent with the June 25, 2004 biological opinion (BO) from NOAA Fisheries, and the November 22, 2004 BO from the Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) for the Partners for Fish and Wildlife Program formal consultation.

Project Description:

This project will address fish passage barriers on the South Fork of the Klatskanine River near Olney, Oregon. The project will remove a ~6' high diversion dam, replace it with a low-head diversion, provide a fish screen, and rebuild channel features to stablilize against a headcut, provide instream habitat complexity, and maintain floodplain connectivity. A total of 3.1 miles of spawning and rearing habitats will be made accessible for fish on the South Fork and another low gradient tributary.

- Quantify footprint of activity: 300' in channel (dam removal, diversion structure, channel enhancements), 1500 ft² upland (screen and infrastructure).
- · Quantify area adversely affected by activity: 0 feet.
- Quantify area restored by restoration activity: 3.1 miles fish passage, 300' of channel.

- Total number of days for project implementation: 45
- Total number of days for project implementation above ambient noise: 30

Project Category I - Riparian Habitat Restoration

Breaching, removing, and constructing berms and dikes - This restoration activity will allow more natural hydrologic flows to occur in riparian areas and may increase the width of channel migration zones. Existing berms and dikes will be breached or completely removed at specific locations. These activities will be designed not to cause the artificial entrapment of fish and other aquatic species in adjacent areas. Constructed berms and dikes will be used to protect existing infrastructure from restoration activities that will be completed in the immediate project area. The height and width of constructed berms and dikes will depend on site specific conditions and the intent of the project. Heavy equipment will be used to complete these activities. Site preparations may involve the removal of vegetation on and around berms and dikes. Soil disturbances will be primarily limited to the areas where these structures will be altered or constructed.

Installation of bio-engineered stream bank stabilization structures - Installation of stream bank stabilization structures will minimize or eliminate sedimentation and erosion and improve water quality in adjacent streams. Natural materials (e.g., native vegetation, boulders, and woody debris) will be used to redirect flows in stream channels to minimize stream bank erosion. Structures (e.g., rock barbs, tree revetments, and fascines) will be placed and anchored within the toe and bank areas of stream channels. Similar materials and/or structures may be placed in adjacent floodplains to redirect flows across these areas. Stream banks may also be reshaped or graded and planted with native vegetation to stabilize them. Heavy equipment will be used to complete these activities.

<u>Planting native riparian plant species</u> - Native vegetation will be planted to increase the composition and abundance of riparian plant communities. Native vegetation to be planted will include conifers and hardwood trees, forbs, shrubs, and grasses, and any other vegetation that would have naturally occurred at a project site. Vegetation will be planted by hand, mechanical planters, or broadcasted with hand or mechanical spreaders (e.g., no till seed drill and hydro-seeding with vehicle mounted pressurized equipment). Cottonwood (*Populus spp.*), willows (*Salix spp.*) and other tree species able to propagate readily from cuttings may be bundled and buried into shallow, narrow trenches along stream banks to promote a greater abundance of seedling sprouts. Heavy equipment may be used to excavate and backfill the trenches.







6. Notice of the application for transfer was published on June 12, 2007, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.

- The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and/or safely transport fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted and that the diversion is currently equipped with an appropriate fish screening and/or by-pass device.
- 8. On August 6, 2007, the Clatsop County Assessor's office was contacted to clarify current ownership of the lands involved in Transfer T-10403. The Assessor's office confirmed that Weyerhaeuser Corporation is the current owner of record for Tax Lot 4900 in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 30 and the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31, T 7 N, R 8 W, W.M., as well as the existing and proposed points of diversion (Tax Lot 3100 in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 31, T 7 N, R 8 W, W.M.) for Certificates 63289 and 63301. The place of use is in Tax Lot 700, owned by Clatsop County.
- 9. On October 24, 2007, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10403 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline of November 30, 2007, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 10. On January 3, 2008, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer T-10403 and mailed a copy to the applicants. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on January 15, 2008, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 11. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 12. A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application T-10403.
- 13. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 14. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The change in point of diversion proposed in application T-10403 appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The change in point of diversion proposed in application T-10403 is approved.
- Water right certificates 63289 and 63301 are cancelled.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 63289 and 63301, and any related decree.
- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
- The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.
- 6. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. The water user shall maintain and operate the measuring device as required by the Department.
- Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. The water user shall maintain the headgate as required by the Department.
- The approved change shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 2009. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
- 9. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.





Our evaluation of the report of ownership and lien information for the Clatsop County Economic Development Council Fisheries Project has revealed the need for some additional information.

The report prepared by the title company provides legal descriptions for two parcels owned by the Weyerhauser Corporation. However, each of these legal descriptions includes an exception for lands conveyed to Clatsop County. The lands owned by Clatsop County are not identified in the report in a way that would allow us to determine their precise location. At the same time, the transfer map indicates the fisheries complex is part of Tax Lot 700, which may be the identifier for the lands that were conveyed to Clatsop County.

Please clarify which tax lot the Place(s) of Use of the water rights to be transferred are located on, and if any part of the POU is on a parcel other than 3100 and 4900, (e.g. Tax Lot 700), provide a report of ownership and lien information for that parcel.

If you can provide this additional information to us by the end of this month we will do everything we can to expedite your Preliminary Determination.

Dorothy,

I've prepared my working PD document for this transfer, which is attached for your reference. Finding #8 was revised on the assumption that Weyco owned the lands, but that appears now not to be the case, as shown below. I will send a final PD and cover after I hear back from you.

- 1) On the ROLI prepared by Ticor Title, the legal descriptions do not mention the Q-Q in Section 31 where the POD is located. On the tax map the POD appears to be in TL 3100.
- 2) Also the legal descriptions for TL 3100 and TL 4900 state that some lands within these tax lots were conveyed to Clatsop County. Those lands are not described, but it is stated that they are identified in Book 660 page 338, Clatsop County Records. The current tax maps do not show this information.

This is the first indication that I've had that the county may control the lands under the water right (likely only the POU) after all (the application lists TL 4900 as the POU as well as the POD).

So we don't really have a valid ROLI at this time. I'd suggest that you/I could make a call to the Assessor to get the info in Book 660, and/or request the applicant have the title company prepare a new ROLI based on that info. Then I can modify Finding #8 and prepare the cover letter.

Let me know what you think.







Our evaluation of the report of ownership and lien information for the Clatsop County Economic Development Council Fisheries Project has revealed the need for some additional information.

The report prepared by the title company provides legal descriptions for two parcels owned by the Weyerhauser Corporation. However, each of these legal descriptions includes an exception for lands conveyed to Clatsop County. The lands owned by Clatsop County are not identified in the report in a way that would allow us to determine their precise location. At the same time, the transfer map indicates the fisheries complex is part of Tax Lot 700, which may be the identifier for the lands that were conveyed to Clatsop County.

Please clarify which tax lot the Place(s) of Use of the water rights to be transferred are located on, and if any part of the POU is on a parcel other than 3100 and 4900, (e.g. Tax Lot 700), provide a report of ownership and lien information for that parcel.

If you can provide this additional information to us by the end of this month we will do everything we can to expedite your Preliminary Determination.





Dear Dorothy:

The CEDC fishery project is in the process of making various system improvements to its South Fork Klaskanine Fish Hatchery. One of the proposed improvements is to replace its water intake diversion structure located in the South Fork Klaskanine River. The current diversion structure is a passage barrier to native migratory fish, primarily salmonids. The replacement diversion will allow unimpeded passage to all life stages of fish for both up and downstream migrants. Site conditions and design requirements necessitates CEDC gaining approval from OWRD to change their point of diversion from its existing location to a point upstream approximately 150 feet. Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife - North Coast Watershed District is supportive of this action as it will resolve a long standing fish passage problem at this location. The affected water rights of this proposal are #63289 and #63301 and are for non-consumptive aquaculture use. No changes to these certificates are anticipated other than moving the point of diversion. The benefits include: Improved/non-impeded juvenile and adult fish passage, improved fish screening at the new water intake, and improved ability for the hatchery facility to manage its water withdrawal.

I have received your initial draft documents for T-10403. Since we need to have the watermaster's review in order to make a determination, I'll hold these documents until we have that review, then let you know what revisions may be needed.

It was a good observation that the application was not signed by the applicant. We will need to request their signature. In this case I think it would be appropriate to ask for a replacement signature page that includes the applicant's signature. It would be good also, in this case, to have documentation from the applicant that clearly authorizes the agent to represent them in matters relating to this transfer application.

I do not agree with you, however, about the ownership and lien information. The Fisheries Project and the water rights involved do not seem to fit the criteria in ORS 540.510(3)(b). We should use the standard language and require a report of ownership and lien information, and consent of landowners.
