





Background

- 1. On June 6, 2007, James F. Hammett of the U.S. Department of Interior (John Day Fossil Beds National Monument) filed an application to change the place of use under a portion of Certificate 24976. The Department assigned the application number T-10405.
- 2. The Department received an amended application and revised map from the applicant on January 8, 2009, to clarify the proposed place of use.
- 3. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

- 6. Notice of the application for transfer was originally published on June 12, 2007, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 7. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and/or safely transport fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted and that the diversion is currently equipped with an appropriate fish screening and/or by-pass device.
- 8. On January 8, 2009, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10405 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline of February 8, 2009, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

9. On February 10, 2009, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10405 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on February 17, 2009, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 10. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 11. A ditch, pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application T-10405.
- 12. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 13. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10405 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10405 is approved.
- 2. Water right certificate 24976 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of the right NOT affected by this transfer and further describing the authorized point of diversion (as identified in Finding of Fact #4).
- 3. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 24976 and any related decree.
- 4. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 5. The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

- 6. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. The water user shall maintain and operate the measuring device as required by the Department.
- 7. The water user shall maintain the existing headgate and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 8. The approved change shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2010**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 9. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

The water is diverted from Rock Creek at POD indicated on attached map. This POD was reconstructed in the 2002 in cooperation with NRCS. This is the only POD for this transfer. The water then flows approximately 400 feet through an open ditch to a fish screen maintained by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife and a volumetric weir installed and maintained by the owner. The water then enters a 24" steel culvert, flows east under State Highway 19, then north approximately 550 feet parallel to the John Day River, still in a 24" steel culvert. The water then enters a concrete lined ditch which measures 81" at the top in cross section, is 2.5' deep and measures 3 feet horizontally at the bottom of the ditch. The water continues in a concrete-lined ditch for approximately 1260' to the first place of use covered by this transfer. After the first place of use, the remaining water enters a 18" diameter plastic pipe and travels approximately 3000 feet to a second concrete-lined open ditch segment . All concrete-lined ditch is identical in cross section. The water then travels approximately 680' through this concrete-lined ditch, before entering another 18" plastic pipe. The water travels through this plastic pipe for approximately 242 feet at which point it enters another concrete-lined ditch identical in cross section to the first. This concrete-lined ditch is approximately 900 feet long. After this, the water again enters a 18" diameter plastic pipe which extends for approximately 1800 feet to a transition and vertical culvert where the water enters from the 18" diameter pipe and exits into a 8" diameter pipe which extends for approximately 3000' to the second point of use. This arrangement allows approximately 4 feet of head pressure to be maintained at the entrance to the 8" pipe. This section of pipe is the most restrictive segment of the distribution system, but is capable of flowing sufficient water to irrigate the orchard area, which is incorporated into this transfer, and, in addition, a 16.4-acre alfalfa field (see flow calculations later in this document).

This transfer only transfers the point of use of this water in this distribution works. There is no change to the volume of water taken from the POD as the POD is the same for the original point of use as for the new point of use.



Hello, hate to bother you with this, but I cannot find an exemption in rule or in statute (ORS 540.510) where the Department of the Interior/Nat'l Park Service-JD Fossil Beds (T-10405) is not required to submit a land ownership and lien information report required under OAR 690-380-(13) (c), and do not see on the Page 6 of the transfer application the applicable exemption under the "12. SIGNATURES" where they would fit in either.

Do they somehow fit into a sub-category of the "municipality definition?



Hi Jim, as discussed, I called and left a message with Laura Snedaker in Salem. She has not returned my call as of yet. As soon as I can go over this issue with her, and get better direction on what steps to take next, I'll let you know.

As pointed out, Eric Julsrud and I believe this might be a win win situation with the amendment to your transfer application to include a character of use change to convert the (remaining) additional 2.03 acres instream.

In addition to amending the application, the map of course would need to be fixed as well. The additional change would also require a \$350 add'l fee, but I will get some guidance on how to get that reduced 50%. As also discussed, needed will be to publish this notice within a local newspaper because of the change in character of use. We will prepare that Public Notice and send out with the Preliminary Determination. The Department would also re-notice the addt'l filing in our weekly public notice. I will send back the original application and map when we get there.



From there it flows through a concrete lined ditch and 10" diameter plastic pipe to flood irrigate approximately 10 acres located approximately ½ mile from the point of diversion. The water is further piped to a pump sump approximately 1½ mile further down the ditch. It is then pumped with a 10-hp pump through 8-inch mainline to irrigate approximately 16 acres via rain bird sprinklers and 3-inch aluminum

handline. The final 8 ½ acres is irrigated via a 2-inch plastic pressure pipe and rain-bird impact sprinklers and 3-inch handline.
