Background

- On June 25, 2007, Joan Howard and Wade Bettis filed a filed a transfer application to change the point of diversion to reflect historical use under Certificate 13182. The Department assigned the application number T-10413.

- 4. Notice of the transfer application was published on July 3, 2007, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 5. The Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and/or safely transport fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted and that the diversion is not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screening and/or by-pass device. Listed fish species are not present at the point of diversion, the originating water right diversion is not screened, cost-share funds are not currently available, and the proposed diversion may be eligible for ODFW's cost-share program. A grace period of two years is appropriate until such time as cost share funds become available to assist in the construction of a fish screening and/or by-pass device. If cost share funds do not become available, the water user must screen within the indicated time period regardless of the availability of cost share funding.
- 6. On September 19, 2008, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Final Order proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10413 to the applicants. The draft Final Order set forth a deadline of October 20, 2008, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Final Order and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

7. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-2120(2)(a), evidence has been submitted that the actual, current point of diversion for the water right in question, as described in Finding No. 3, has been in use for more than 10 years.

- 8. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-2120(2)(c) the Watermaster provided a statement that to his knowledge there has been no complaint of injury due to the use of water at the actual, current point of diversion, prior to the transfer request.
- 9. Pursuant to 690-380-2120(3), the Department determined that two neighbors using water under the same Water Right Certificate 13182 are affected water rights. The Department provided the applicant a list of the affected water right holders and a copy of the notice to be provided to each affected water right holder.
- 10. On September 8, 2008, the applicant provided written proof of service of delivery of notice of the proposed transfer to each of the holders of the affected water right. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 11. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540,610.
- 12. A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
- 13. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 14. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Partial Cancellation of a Water Right

15. On September 19, 2008, William S. Roberts, owner of lands in which a portion of Certificate 13182 is appurtenant to, submitted a voluntary cancellation affidavit meeting the requirements of ORS 540.621 for partial cancellation of the 0.6 acres adjacent to the applicant's property. The portion of the water right is described as follows:

Conclusions of Law

The proposed change in point of diversion to reflect historical use in Transfer Application T-10413 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000. The portion of Certificate 13182 described in Finding No. 14 as abandoned will be cancelled.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in point of diversion proposed in Transfer Application T-10413 is approved and shall be effective immediately upon issuance of this order.
- 2. The portion of Certificate 13182 that has been abandoned is cancelled.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 13182 and any related decree.
- 4. Water right certificate 13182 is cancelled. Certificate 84976 will be issued to describe that portion of the right **not** modified and cancelled by this order, and along with Certificate 84977, will supersede Certificate 13182.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
- 6. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 7. Within two years after the date of this order, the water user shall install a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) design and construction standards. Prior to installation, the water user shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screen and/or by-pass device meets ODFW's criteria. The water user may withdraw water at the new point of diversion without screening or by-pass devices until two years after the date of this order. The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's required screening and/or by-pass device operational and maintenance standards.

8. Certificate 84977 shall be issued to confirm the right described by Certificate 13182 changed by Transfer Application T-10413 under the terms of this order.

Affidavit Attesting to the Use of Water

The property at 81160 Couse Creek Road was purchased by my great-grandfather, Nathan Sams, in 1887. In approximately 1906 my grandfather, Jasper Sams, moved to the property and lived there until his death in 1965.

During his lifetime, 'Grandpa Jap' ditched our property and the neighbors' properties to irrigate a prune orchard, pasture, garden and yard and to maintain the water right on the property.

In 1965 my grandfather died. That year my father, Bob Howard, purchased irrigation pipes and a pump and installed them at the present location. I was ten that year and for 6 years after that I moved the pipes each summer and helped maintain the water right by helping with the irrigation.

In 1983 I moved from the property and the property was rented out between 1983 and 1999. I returned to the property in 1999.

Photographs included with this application show the property today and identify the pasture, garden and yard which have been irrigated since the mid-60's.


