Authority

ORS 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

Findings of Fact

Background

1. On June 26, 2007, Robert Donaldson, filed an application to amend place of use and for additional points of appropriation under Permit G-13677. The Department assigned the application number T-10415.
2. The permit to be amended is as follows:

Permit:	G-13677, in the name of Robert Donaldson;
Use:	Cranberry Use
Priority Date:	February 19, 1998
Quantity:	0.18 cubic foot per second (cfs)
Rate/Duty:	The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands, is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre; For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cubic foot per second per acre; For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. For the irrigation of any other crop, ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

5. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on July 3, 2007, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5). No comments were filed in response to the notice.
6. The Department's Groundwater Section has found that the locations of proposed Wells 1 and 2, as originally proposed, would have potential for substantial interference with a nearby surface stream and would result in injury to instream Water Right Certificate 76053. The Groundwater Section recommended re-locating the proposed wells beyond one quarter mile distance from surface water source.

7. On January 23, 2008, the applicant amended the permit amendment application to re-locate Wells 1 and 2 more than one-quarter mile from surface water sources.
8. The change, as amended, would not result in injury to other water rights.
9. The proposed place of use is owned by the permit holder.
10. The change does not enlarge the permit.
11. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.
12. The proposed place of use is contiguous to the authorized place of use.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use and additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-10415 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The changes and subsequent use of water shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
2. Prior to water use from the proposed points of appropriation, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.

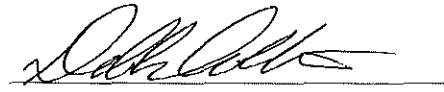
The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

3. Water shall be acquired from the same ground water source as the original point of appropriation.
4. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.
5. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-13677 remain the same.

6. Permit G-13677, in the name of Robert Donaldson, is amended as described herein.

Bob –

Per our telephone conversation, attached is a map that I sketched out to show those areas on your property that are more than ¼ mile away (approximately) from surface streams to the North and South of your property.

Proposed well locations 1 and 2 were found to pose a risk of substantial interference with an unnamed stream just to the North of your property. The interference could potentially injure instream water rights on Floras Creek into which that unnamed stream flows. By statute, proposed changes in Permit Amendment applications must not injure other water rights. I will send you a copy of the Groundwater Section's memo summarizing their review of your permit amendment application in a separate e-mail just in case your e-mail server does not like multiple attachments.

If you wish to re-locate Wells 1 and 2, you will need to send me a letter stating your intent to amend your permit amendment application and the survey coordinates of the new proposed well locations along with a amended map (you can use a copy of the map you have already submitted, just cross out the previous well sites and draw in your new sites.)

If you wish to drop the 2 proposed wells entirely, just send me an e-mail telling me to do that.

The proposed sump (well 3) and change (correction) in place of use pose no issues and can be approved once Wells 1 and 2 are re-located or dropped from the application.

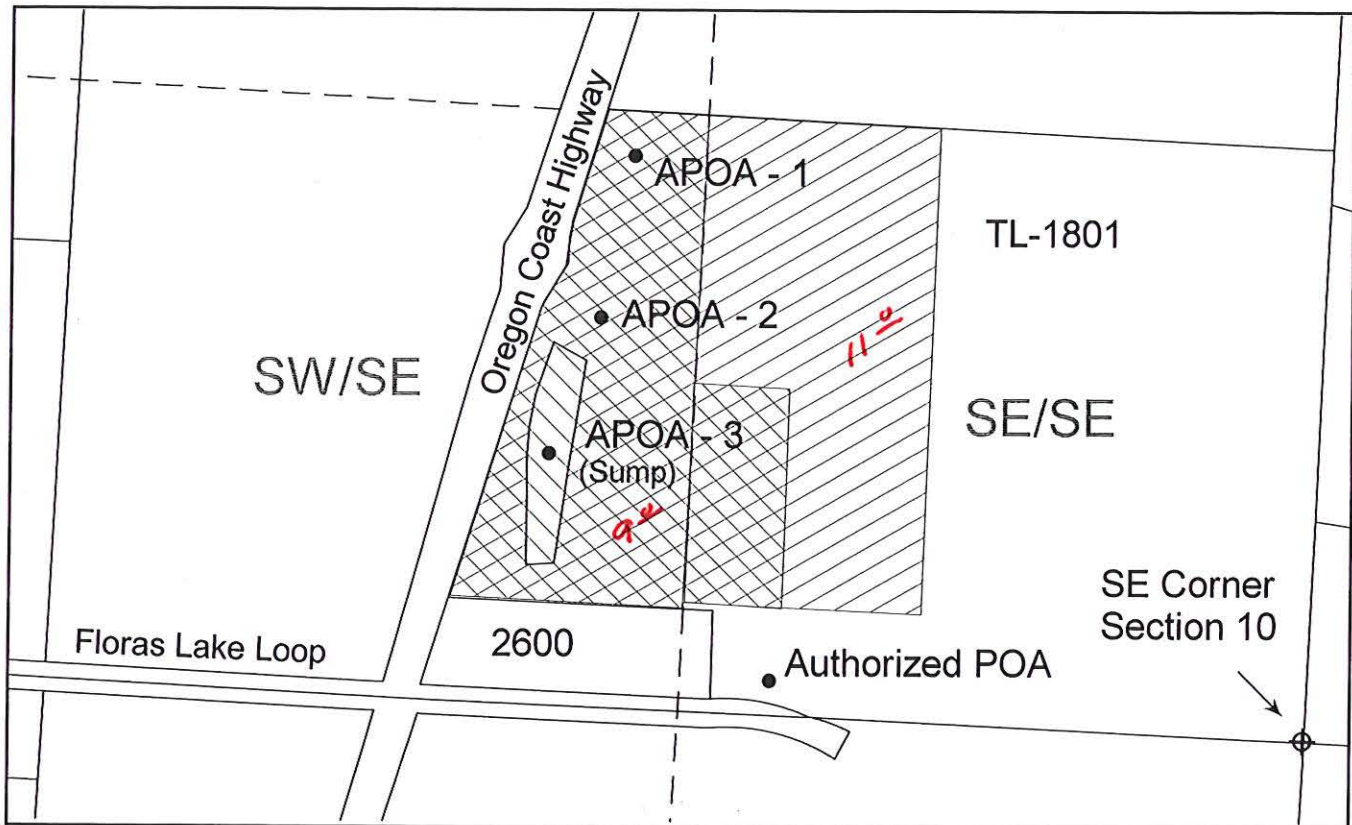

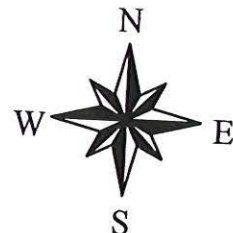

- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

Diversion and use of water under this permit must comply with the Clean Water Act and utilize best management practices as identified in the plan developed as specified in the New River Alternative Dispute Resolution Team Agreement on file with the Department.

The water user shall develop a plan to monitor and report the impact of water use under this permit on water levels within the aquifer that provides water to the permitted well(s). The plan shall be submitted to the Department within one year of the date the permit is issued and shall be subject to the approval of the Department. At a minimum, the plan shall include a program to periodically measure static water levels within the permitted well(s) or an adequate substitute such as water levels in nearby wells. The plan shall also stipulate a reference water level against which any water-level declines will be compared. If a well listed on this permit (or replacement well) displays a total static water-level decline of 10 or more feet over any period of years, as compared to the reference level, then the water user shall discontinue use of, or reduce the rate or volume of withdrawal from, the well(s). Such action shall be taken until the water level recovers to above the 10-foot decline level or until the Department determines, based on the water user's and/or the Department's data and analysis, that no action

is necessary because the aquifer in question can sustain the observed declines without adversely impacting the resource or senior water rights. The water user shall in no instance allow excessive decline, as defined in Commission rules, to occur within the aquifer as a result of use under this permit.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

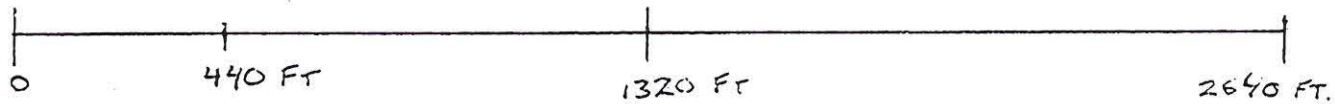

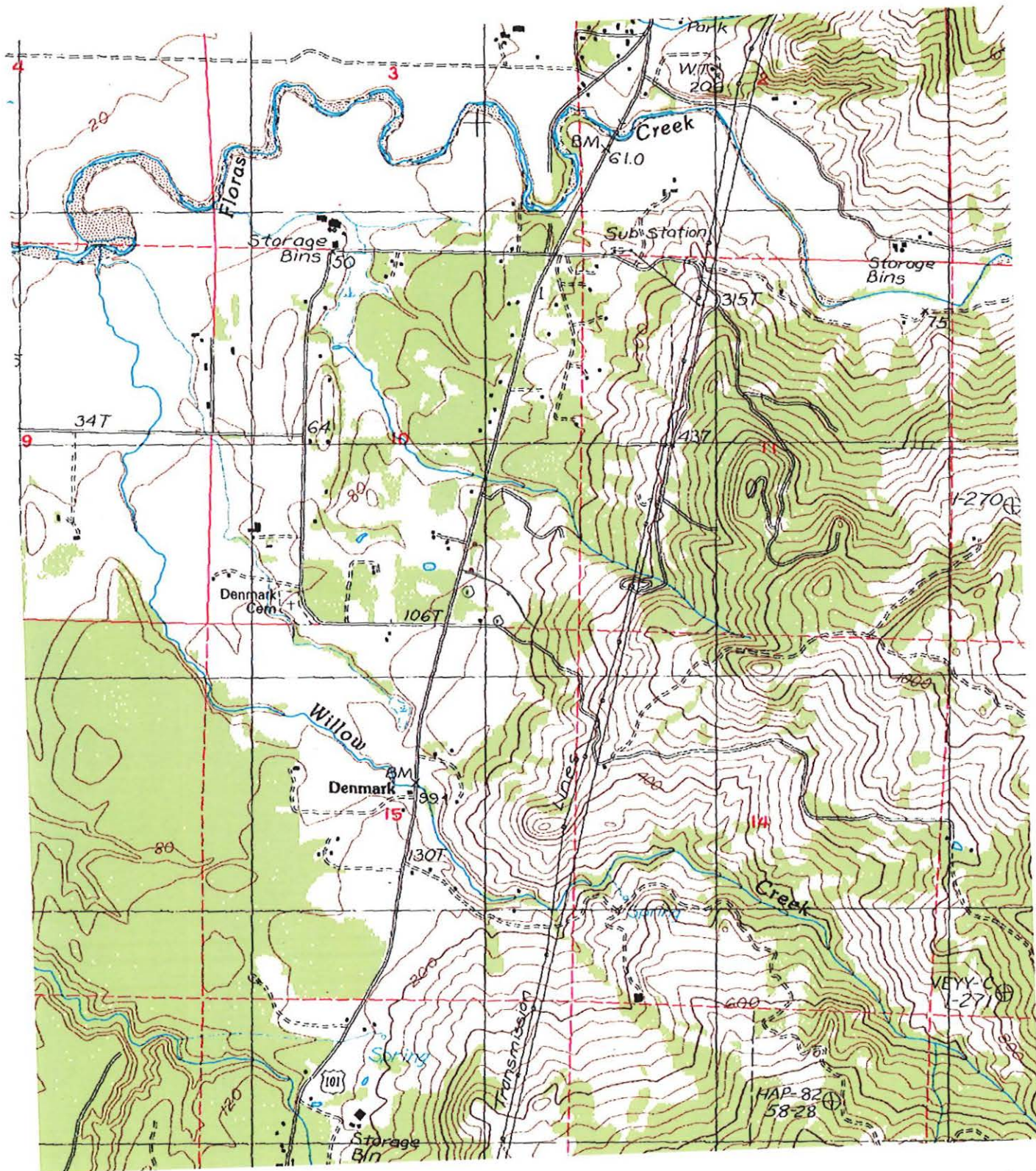

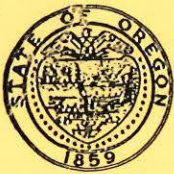

I have reviewed the base file (G-14685) and the permit amendment materials. The amendment proposes to add three additional points of appropriation (APOA) and change the place of use (POU). Only the matter of points of appropriation is germane to this ground water review. I don't see any problem with the POU change.

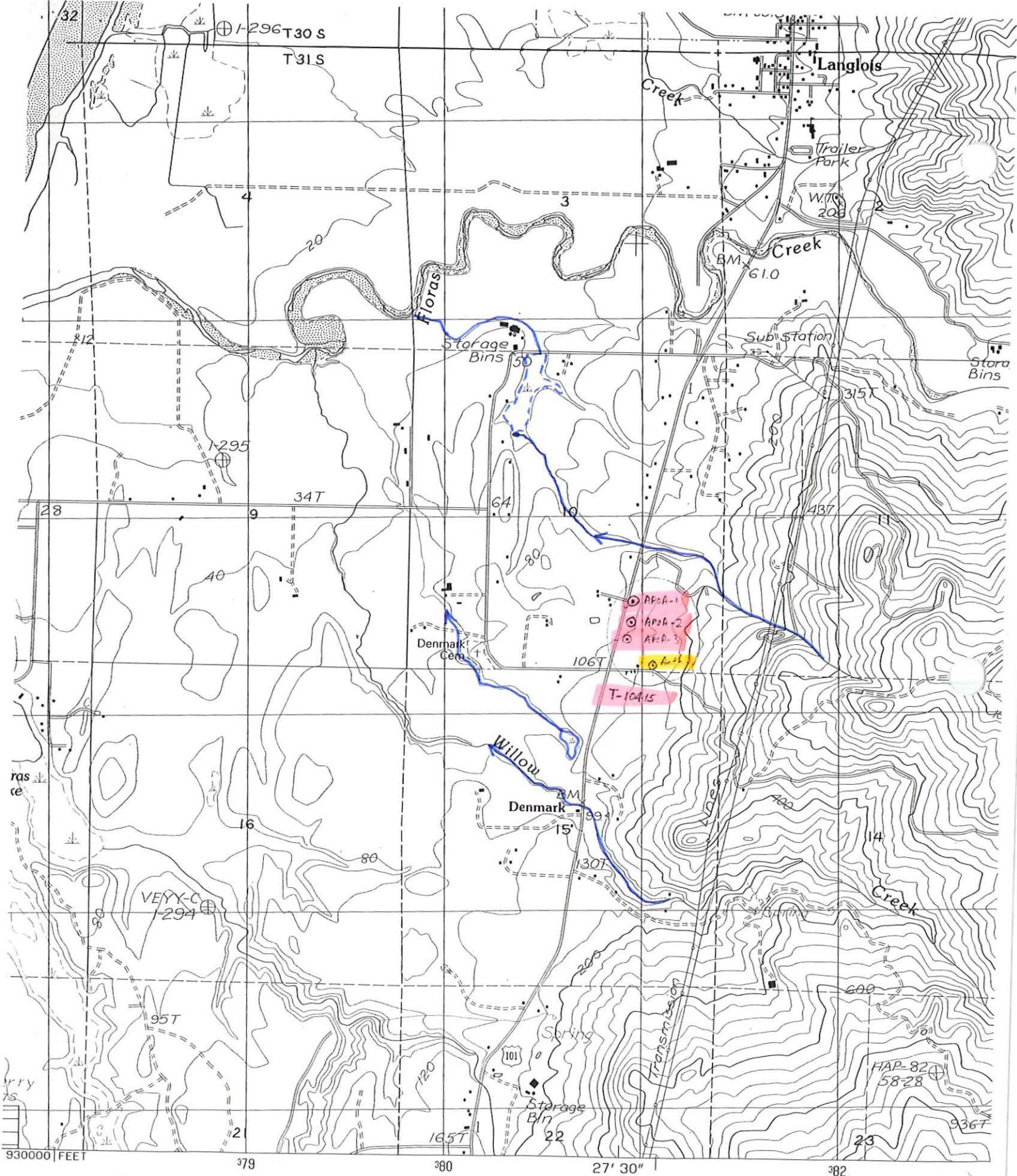
The existing, authorized POA is a sump. The proposed APOA's consist of a sump (APOA-3) and two wells (APOA-1 and APOA-2). Based on the locations and the proposed constructions of the shallow sump and wells, I conclude that the four POA's would develop the same unconfined aquifer source.

The original application was reviewed for ground water considerations in a 3/13/98 review by Doug Woodcock. Among other things, that review observed that the aquifer was unconfined and that the potential for substantial interference was low. Review methodologies in 1998 were somewhat different than they are today but the rules have not changed. In any case, the application did not have the potential for substantial interference per Division 9 rules and the permit was issued.

The APOA's pose new considerations for the evaluation of the potential for substantial interference under Division 9. APOA-3 is 1600' from an unnamed tributary of Floras Creek to the north. It does not have the potential for substantial interference. In my opinion, the proposed change for APOA-3 may be made without injury to an existing water right.

However, APOA-1 and APOA-2 are 900' and 1300' from that same tributary and have the potential for substantial interference. This poses a problem with authorizing a permit amendment to add those APOA's since the water availability tables show that the in-stream water right on Floras creek is not satisfied during nine months of the year. The right is satisfied and water is available only for December, February, and March. With this information, in my opinion the proposed changes for APOA-1 and APOA-2 will result in injury to an existing water right (IS 70891).

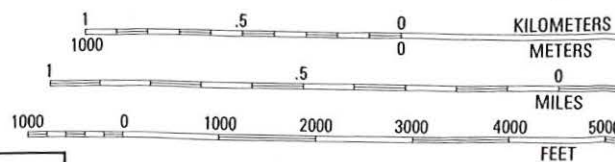
Relocating APOA-1 and APOA-2 beyond the quarter mile standard can make them favorable for permit amendment.

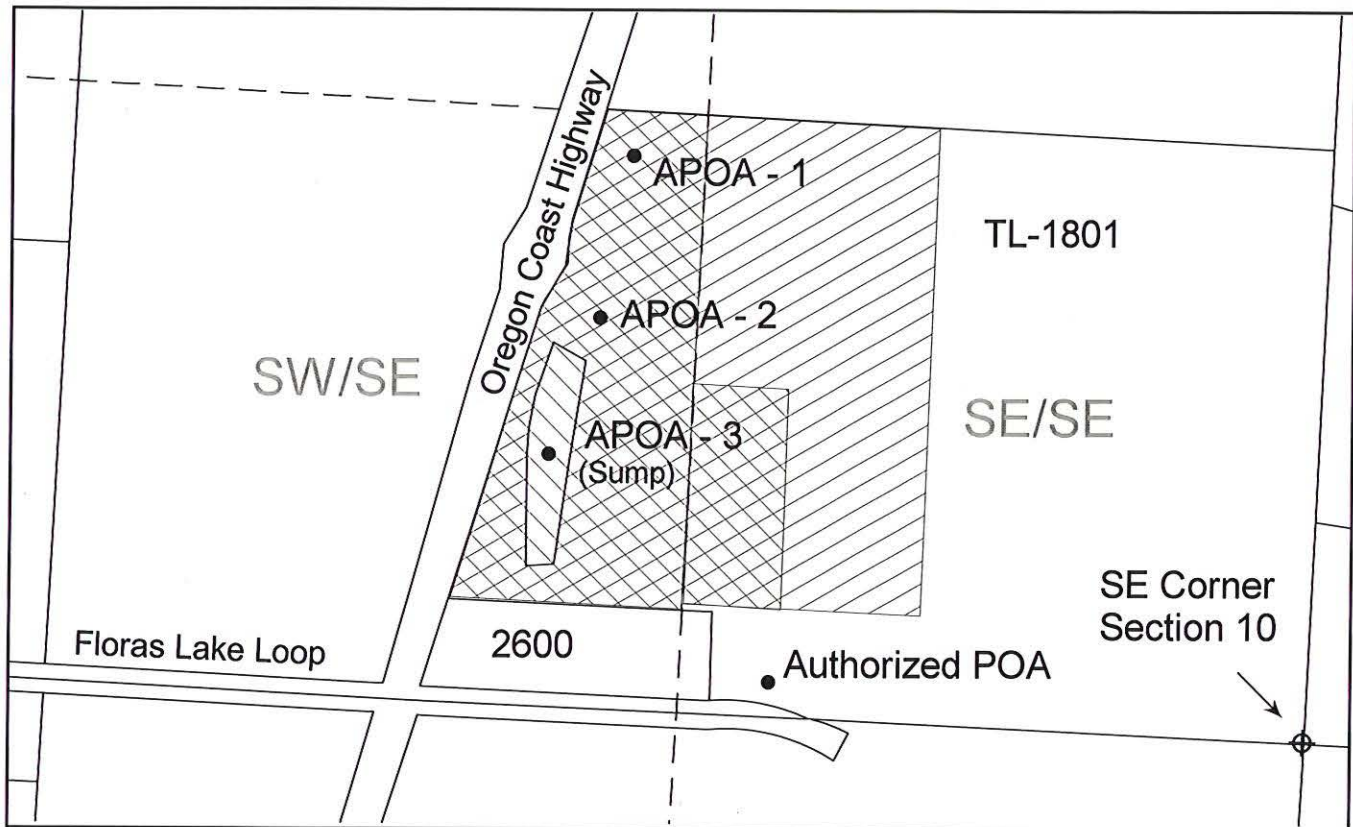

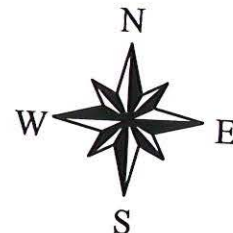

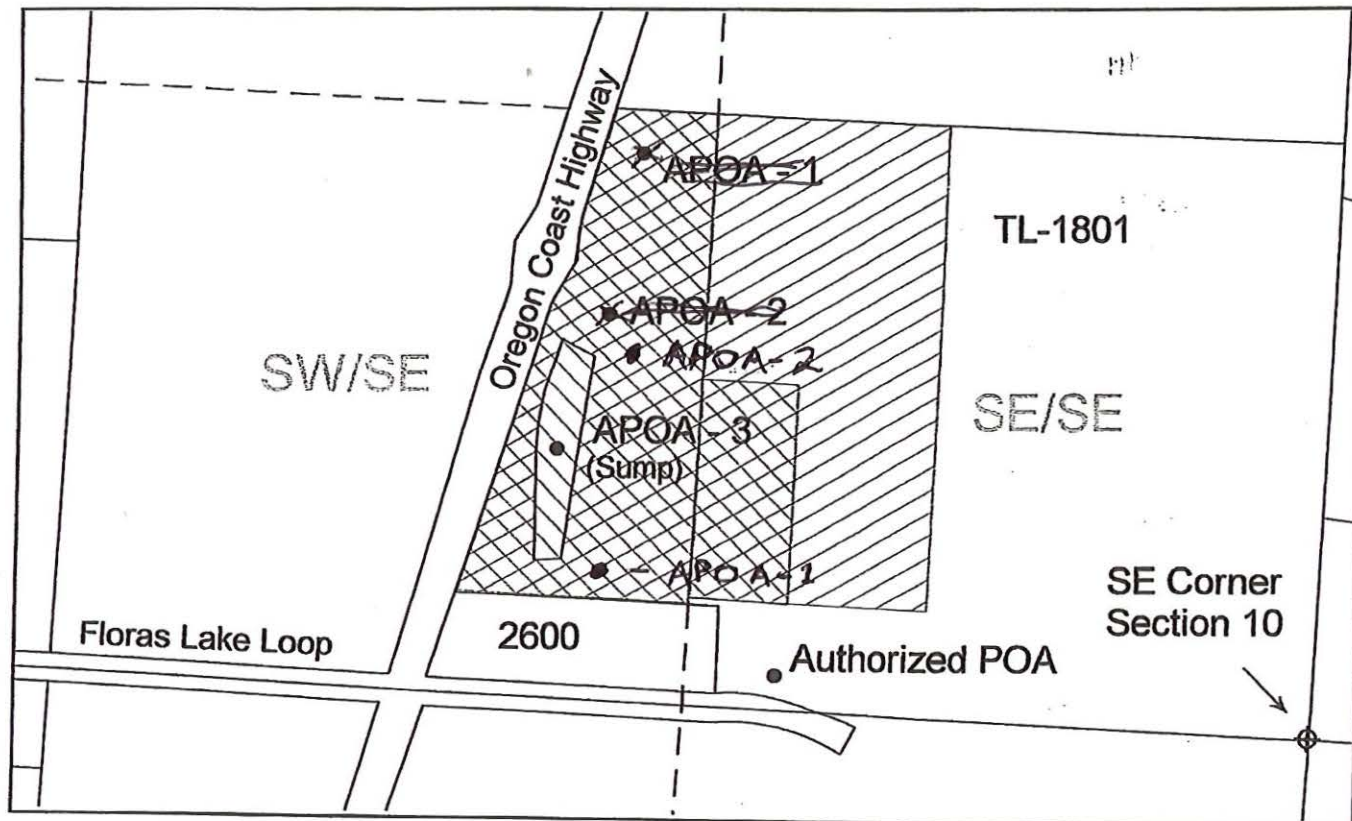
