

Findings of Fact

Background

- On December 13, 2007, the Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10416, a permanent district transfer for a change in place of use. This order is recorded at Special Order Volume 73, Pages 798 – 802. This final order also included a partial cancellation of two abandoned water rights, originally evidenced by Certificates 1668 and 3846.
- On August 18, 2009, the Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10748, another permanent district transfer for a change in place of use. This order is recorded at Special Order Volume 78, Pages 725 – 728 and also included a partial cancellation of the same original certificates cited in Finding of Fact #1 (Certificates 1668 and 3846).
- Remaining right Certificate 85741 (originally Certificate 1668) did not include both authorized partial cancellations.
- 4. Remaining right Certificate 85742 (originally Certificate 3846) also did not include both authorized partial cancellations.
- A review of the record leads the Department to conclude that new certificates are needed to correct the place of use and quantity of water authorized by the water rights.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Findings of Fact

- On December 13, 2007, the Department issued a final order, recorded in Special Order Volume 73, Pages 798 - 802, approving district permanent Transfer Application T-10416. The order established October 1, 2009, as the date for completion of the authorized change in place of use.
- 2. On August 5, 2010, the Department received a claim of beneficial use for T-10416.
- 3. The Department reviewed the claim of beneficial use and final proof maps submitted by the applicant for district permanent transfer T-10416.
- 4. The claim of beneficial use did not contain map(s) of the point(s) of diversion from the source. However, since these changes are for place of use only within an irrigation district, and do not involve changes in point of diversion, the existing map(s) on file with the Department are sufficient to identify the point(s) of diversion from the source.
- 5. Satisfactory proof of the changes were submitted with evidence showing that water was used in the location and for the purpose as authorized by the final order approving T-10416.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-385-7600, the Department may issue a certificate upon a determination that the application of water to beneficial use under the terms of the final order approving a permanent district transfer was completed to the extent authorized.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The Department has determined that the application of water to beneficial use under the terms of the final order approving district permanent transfer T-10416 was completed to the extent authorized.

Pursuant to OAR 690-385-7600, the Department will issue a water right certificate on a determination that it is necessary to produce a certificate describing the right.

- 7. Research revealed that a portion of water use Permit 43395 is appurtenant to the proposed "TO" lands. A Claim of Beneficial Use report and map have been submitted on Permit 43395 but no water right certificate has been issued. On November 23, 2007, the Department received an affidavit from Mr. Buckley, Manager for East Fork Irrigation District, stating that the District does not intend to prove up on any of the land under Permit 43395 that is situated in the same location as the place of use proposed in this transfer.
- 8. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and/or safely transport fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted and that the diversion is currently equipped with an appropriate fish screening and/or by-pass device.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10416 satisfies the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580, and the rights abandoned will be cancelled.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The proposed change in place of use to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 80929 and 81340 is approved.
- The right to the use of water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the District's water right Certificates 80929 and 81340, any related decree, and this Final Order.
- 3. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.
- 4. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

- The water user shall maintain the existing headgate and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

confirms the right to use the waters of the EAST FORK HOOD RIVER, a tributary of HOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 478.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 29617. The date of priority is MARCH 13, 1964. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 5.99 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.; 3750 FEET SOUTH AND 430 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed 1/80th of one cubic foot per second of water per acre and 4.0 acre-feet per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been corrected to 1/80th cubic foot per second per acre and 3.0 acre-feet per acre of water, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination this office setting the proper maximum limits of the right.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10416 satisfies the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580, and the rights abandoned will be cancelled.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The proposed change in place of use to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 80929 and 81340 is approved.
- The right to the use of water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the District's water right Certificates 80929 and 81340, any related decree, and this Final Order.
- 3. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.
- The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

- 5. The water user shall maintain the existing headgate and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.



2N 10E 25: Certificate 1668






2N 10E 25: Castaneda

Hi Ken.

Here are the issues I found on the "From" lands for T-10416.

Castaneda- There appear to be multiple water rights overlapping with 81340. Certificates 1668 and 3846 both appear to partially overlap with the 0.5 acres from 81340.

Cardinal IG Company- Certificate 81340 has 24 acres in the SE NW. The adjudication map shows 39 acres, which doesn't help me locate the POU. In addition to the 24 acres under 81340, there is another—water right (3846) that lists 9 acres in the SE NW. This is a total of 33 acres in this 1/4 1/4. At least 7 acres does not have water rights and the maps available don't show me which lands have no rights. I guess we have to assume that a portion of certificate 81340 is appurtenant to Cardinal IG? Also, Permit S-43395- no water rights listed on the permit in Section 25. I guess we would need to look at the Final Proof to determine if something was proved up on in this section.

Cooper- When I overlay the adjudication map with this section in ArcGIS, I do not show water rights appurtenant to this tax lot. See attached map.

Weseman-Adjudication map overlay shows east 1/2 of tax lot 2800 already has water rights under 81340, but no water rights on the west portion of the property (from lands). To further confuse things, I also overlaid the application map from permit 43395. It looks to me like the "from" lands have water rights from permit 43395, but not from 81340. The east 1/2 of the property already has water rights from 81340, so there's no need to move to this location that I can see. See attached maps.

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Castaneda- There appear to be multiple water rights overlapping with 81340. Certificates 1668 and 3846 both appear to partially overlap with the 0.5 acres from 81340.

Cardinal IG Company- Certificate 81340 has 24 acres in the SE NW. The adjudication map shows 39 acres, which doesn't help me locate the POU. In addition to the 24 acres under 81340, there is another—water right (3846) that lists 9 acres in the SE NW. This is a total of 33 acres in this 1/4 1/4. At least 7 acres does not have water rights and the maps available don't show me which lands have no rights. I guess we have to assume that a portion of certificate 81340 is appurtenant to Cardinal IG? Also, Permit S-43395- no water rights listed on the permit in Section 25. I guess we would need to look at the Final Proof to determine if something was proved up on in this section.

Cooper- When I overlay the adjudication map with this section in ArcGIS, I do not show water rights appurtenant to this tax lot. See attached map.


Weseman- Adjudication map overlay shows east 1/2 of tax lot 2800 already has water rights under 81340, but no water rights on the west portion of the property (from lands). To further confuse things, I also overlaid the application map from permit 43395. It looks to me like the "from" lands have water rights from permit 43395, but not from 81340. 

Weseman Property adjudication map overalay



Weseman Property permit 43395 overlay





I got the message that you left with John Buckley about the .30 acre of 1977 water rights on Cardinal Glass property that I included in the EFID Transfer Notice 2007-02. John's message is not really clear but I think I know what you were asking? Tax Lot 1301 was an orchard prior to Cardinal Glass building their manufacturing plant on it. The property had .40 acres of 1977 water rights along with the 1895 water rights. This .40 acre, of which I'm moving .30 acre around on the same tax lot, is now partitally under the building and parking lot. I know this is permit water but I submitted final proof of the 1977 permit to OWRD (Steve Brown) in March, 2005. Steve thought he could complete the final proof on the permit prior to his retirement but that did not happen. I contacted Gerry Clark in March, 2006 to check the status of the review on this permit. 
Since it's been over a year that I last made contact with Gerry, I'll email him again to check on the status of the review. I'll have Gerry copy his response to you.



The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 5.06 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NW% SW%, SECTION 4, T 1 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 3750 FEET SOUTH AND 430 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 4, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The holder of a water right subject to transfer may request to temporarily change the place of use of the water for up to 5 years and, if necessary to convey the water, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.

The holder of a water right permit may apply to change a point of diversion (POD) or appropriation (POA) or to change the place of use (POU).

Any person who provides comments within the comment period will receive a copy of the Department's preliminary determination of whether the application should be approved or rejected after the Department has completed a review of the application and will be provided an opportunity to protest the application and preliminary determination at that time. Comments should be sent to the Transfers Section at the Department's Salem office.
