





ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4110

On December 20, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Charles Lathrop, Agent for Sunny Brook Hop Yards, for approval of a change in point of diversion from Rogue River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 14753, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of The Estate of Ames Thomas Hillman and Elizabeth Hillman, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second from Rogue River for irrigation of a certain 3.9 acres in SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ and 0.3 acre in NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, both as projected on D. L. C. No. 37, of Section 14, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 29, 1943.

The authorized point of diversion for said right is located 1000 feet South and 550 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 14, being within the NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 14, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 725 feet South and 1830 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 14, being within the NW4 SW4 of Section 14, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Daily Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon for a period of three weeks in the issues of January 11, 18 and 25, 1979.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 14753, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.





In reviewing our records relative to your transfer application No. 4110, it appears that certificate 14753 describing the water right involved erroneously listed the number of acres covered by the right in each fractional part of the section. According to the location of the property upon which the water could be used as located in the legal description given on the certificate, not more than 3.9 acres would be covered by the right in the SE4 NW4 of Section 14, T 36S, R 6W, W.M. and the remaining acreage covered by the right would be in the NE4 SW4 of said Section 14.

Based upon the legal description in the copy of the Warranty Deed submitted with your transfer application, that part of the property owned by Sunnybrook Hop Yards to which the right is appurtenant is the 3.9 acres in SE^1_4 NW^1_4 and 0.3 acre in NE^1_4 SW^1_4 of said Section 14; therefore, it will be necessary for you to amend item No. 8 on your transfer application by listing the 4.2 acres as stated above.

I am returning your transfer application and supporting map for correction. A reduced print of a part of the Tax Assessors map showing the property involved is also enclosed.

Dear Jim:

Am enclosing an application for transfer for a portion of the above mentioned right with fees for same covered by check signed by Hugo Tafel, Jr. I think our measurements for the authorized point of diversion are off about 110' according to your records. The reason for this is that Mr. Tafel, the principal user of this right, says there is a pipeline easement for the right and this is where the water is actually diverted.

Also enclosed are affidavits signed by Chas. Lathrop and Hugo Tafel requesting cancelation of all this right except for that portion they themselves are and have been using. We are currently researching the owners and occupants of the properties and will forward it all to you when the information is complete.
