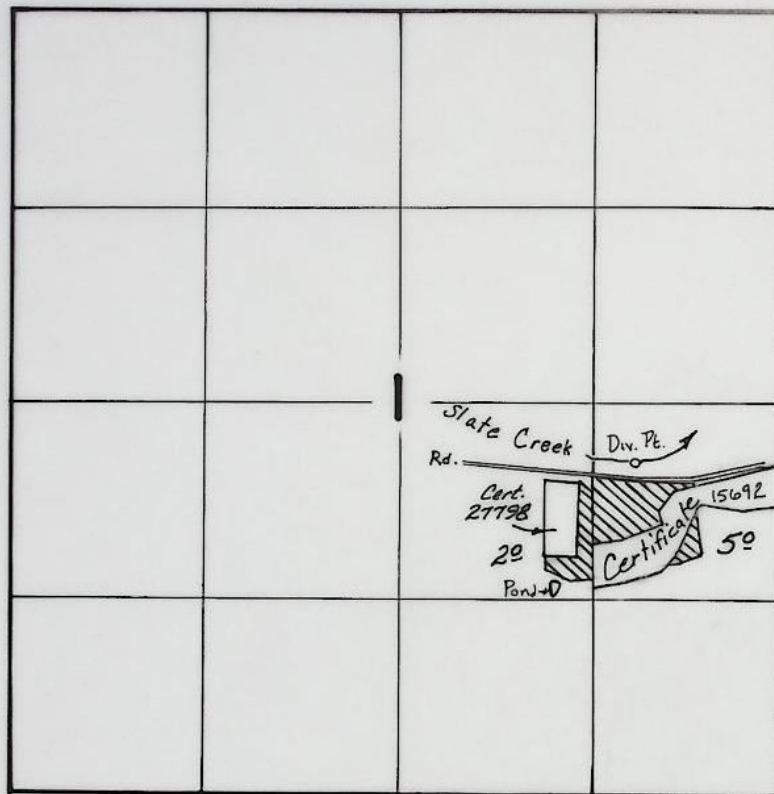

On July 19, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by William R. Gaar for approval of a change in place of use of water pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 46676, Volume 39, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Frank C. Sullivan, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second of water from Slate Creek for irrigation of a certain 10.5 acres located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 37 South, Range 7 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 19, 1945.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 300 feet South and 1200 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 1, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 37 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate a certain 7.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 3.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 37 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.


NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
