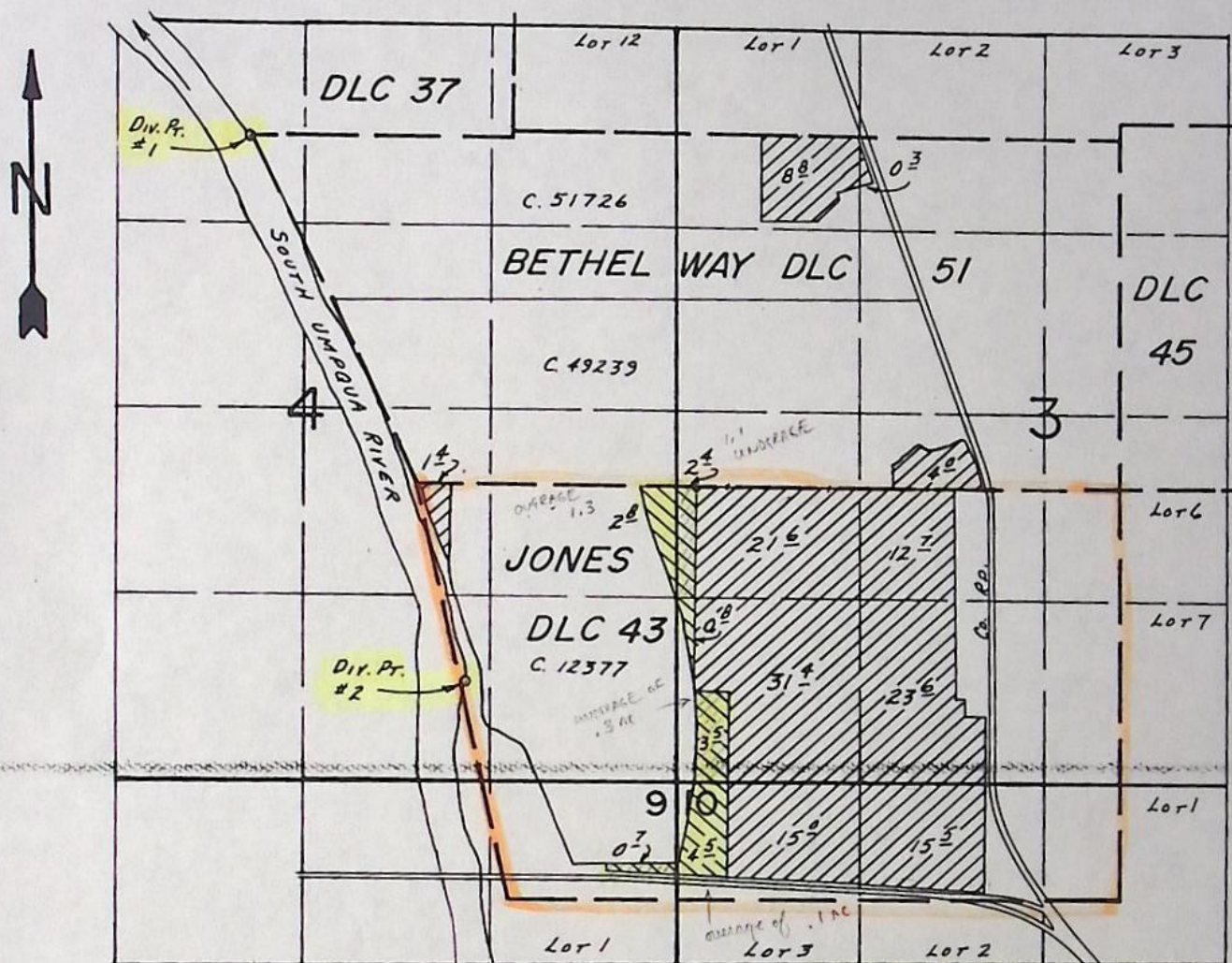

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4346

On December 14, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Fred H. Engle, Pres., Morgan and Engle, Inc., for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from South Umpqua River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The affected water right is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 43553, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Morgan and Engle, Inc., and is for the use of not to exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second from South Umpqua River, under a priority date of April 18, 1962, for irrigation of a certain 6.5 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 8.2 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The authorized point of diversion is located 1340 feet North and 680 feet West from the Southwest Corner of Way D. L. C. No. 51, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use therefrom and to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 3.5 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, 4.6 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 3; 1.5 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 4; 0.7 acre in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 9; and 4.4 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 10, as projected within Jacob Jones D. L. C. No. 43, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M., from a point of diversion located 1400 feet South and 400 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Way D. L. C. No. 51, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the News-Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of January 7, 14, 21, 1980.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

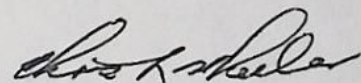
That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the changes in place of use and point of diversion are completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 43553, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 14.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 27985. The date of priority is APRIL 18, 1962. This right is limited to 0.15 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, WHEN AVAILABLE AT ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: SW 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 51, SECTION 4, T 27 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1340 FEET NORTH AND 680 FEET WEST FROM SW CORNER DLC 51.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, SECTION 4, T 27 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1400 FEET SOUTH AND 360 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF DLC 43.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 1/2 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. THE RIGHT TO THE USE OF WATER IS LIMITED TO THE PERIOD WHEN THE FLOW OF THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER IS 60 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND OR MORE AT ITS MOUTH.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

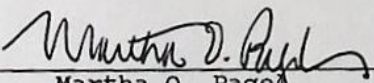

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE & POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 29, 1980, together with Certificate 49239, supersedes Certificate 43553, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

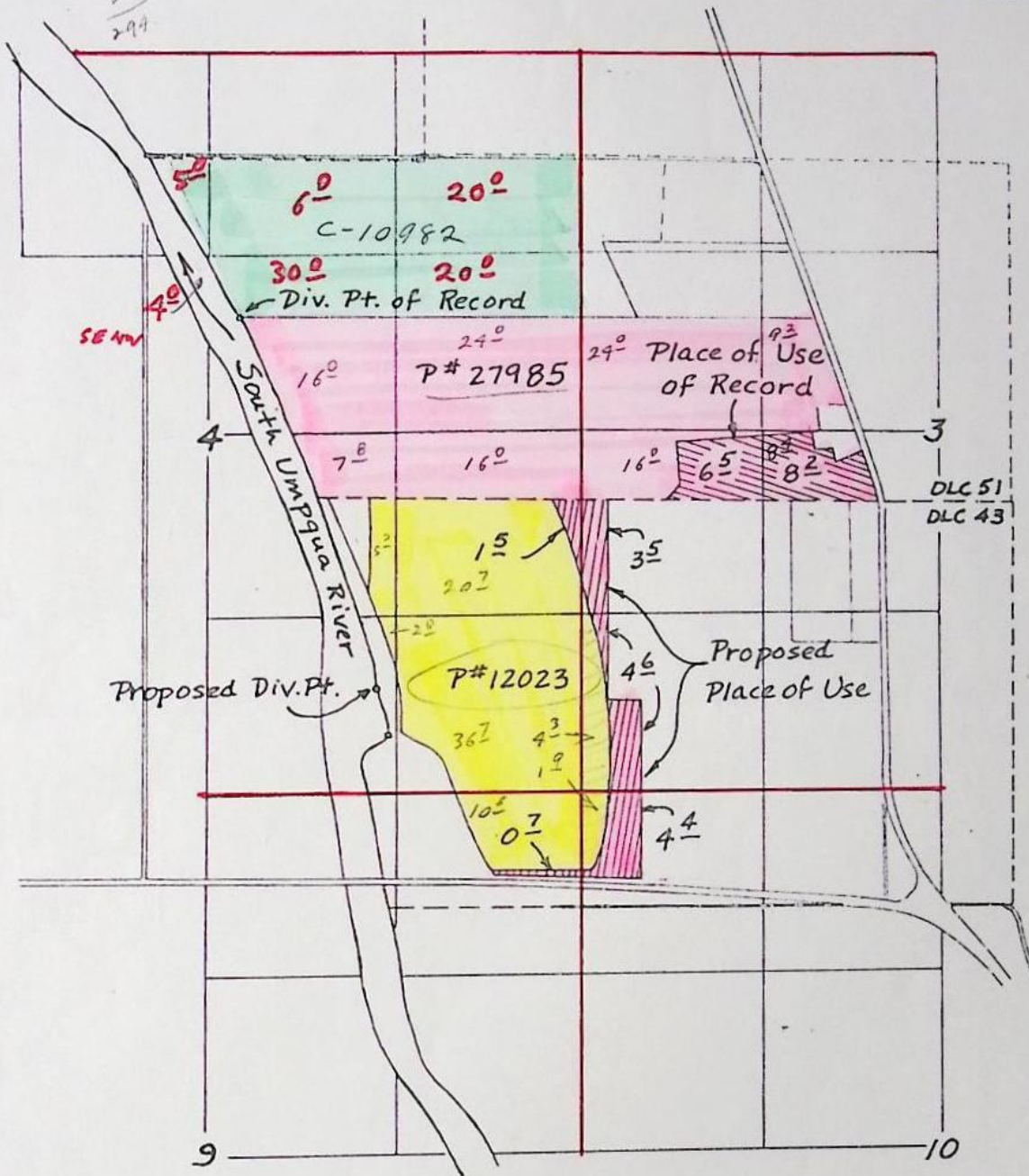

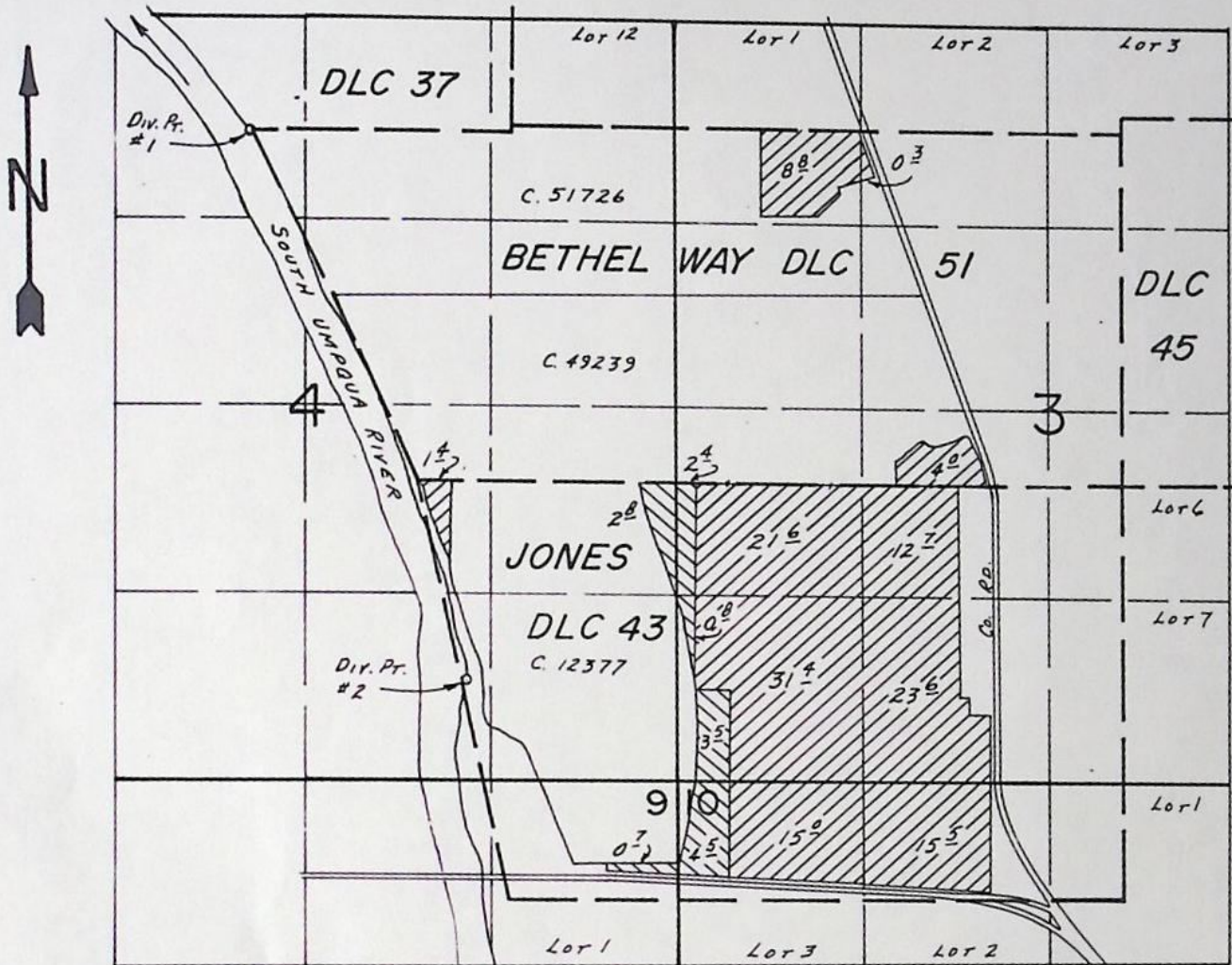

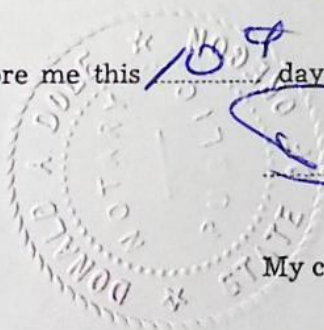

The affected water right is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 43553, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Morgan & Engle, Inc., and is for the use of not to exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second from South Umpqua River, under a priority date of April 18, 1962, for irrigation of a certain 6.5 ac in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ & 8.2 ac in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 3, T 27S, R 6W, WM.

The authorized point of diversion is located 1340 ft N and 680 ft W from the SW Corner of Way DLC #51, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 4, T 27S, R 6W, WM.

Rules for filing objections will be furnished upon request.

IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED, THE APPLICATION MAY BE APPROVED BY THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR WITHOUT A HEARING.

The water right transfer application in the name of Morgan & Engle, Inc., for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from South Umpqua River, together with supporting data and fees in the amount of \$110, was received on December 14, 1979. Our receipt No. 15373 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the watermaster for his usual report regarding the proposed change.

When examination of the application and supporting data has been completed, you will be advised of any matters requiring your further attention prior to consideration of the application for approval.

Please refer any correspondence to file No. T-4346.

Our records indicate that the South Umpqua River was west of its present location in Section 4 at the time Permit No. 9953 was issued.

It appears that the 4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, T 27S, T 6W, WM, along with parts of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ have been eliminated by lateral movement of the river. I am enclosing a copy of your map with the prior location of the river added.

Consequently, even though the 4 acres still show on the certificate, the right to irrigate the property, or an equivalent 4 acres, no longer exists.

If you wish to relocate the right from some of the other lands covered by certificate 10982 (permit No. 9953), it will be necessary for you to file an application for transfer.

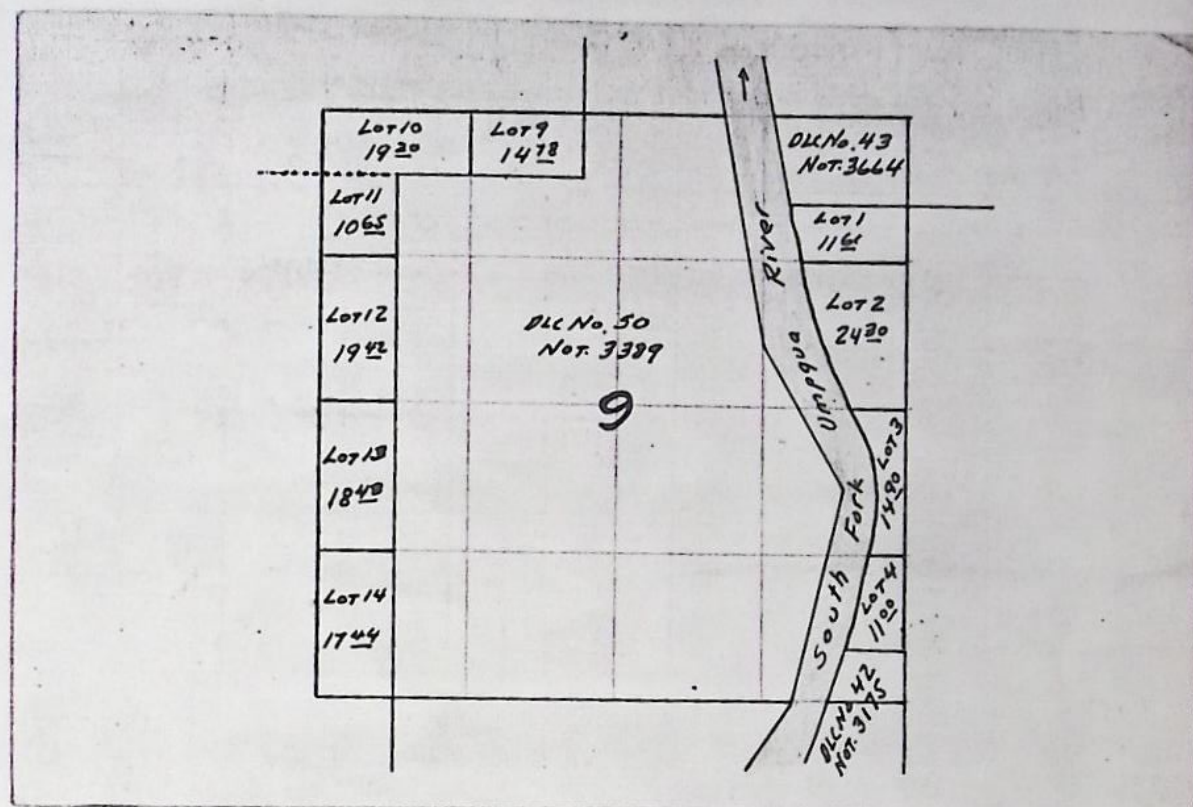
