Sec 4, T 15 S, R 10 E, W.M.





ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER 4470

On April 7, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Leonard Lundgren for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from Squaw Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered May 1, 1911, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Squaw Creek and Its Tributaries, a water right was allowed in the names of P.B. Davis and F.M. Baldwin for use of the waters of Squaw Creek for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 7.05 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 4, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM, with a date of priority of 1885, being tabulated in the names of P.B. Davis and F.M. Baldwin in Volume 1, page 122, as evidenced by the certificate recorded at page 12306, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Smith Ditch, from a point located 100 feet North and 800 feet East from the West Quarter Corner of Section 9, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 9, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 5.0 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and 2.05 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 13, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM, from a point located 998 feet North and 1,212 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 21, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 21, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM (Squaw Creek Ditch). 1211

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in The Bulletin, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Deschutes County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of October 16, 23 and 30, 1980.

Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;


That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1982.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1982.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 12306, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this and other proceedings; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.


On October 14, 1980, Leonard Lundgren submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Deschutes County, entered May 1, 1911, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Squaw Creek, tabulated at page 122, Volume I, Order record of the Water Resources Director, in the name of P.B. Davis and F.M. Baldwin, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 12306, Volume II, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of S.S. Johnson Company, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.458 cubic foot per second of water from Squaw Creek, with a date of priority of 1885, for irrigation of a certain 22.95 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 4, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."
