Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

On January 14, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Harold Crouch for approval of changes in place of use, point of diversion and use heretofore made of water from Calapooya Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The affected water right is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 20981, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Harold Crouch, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.013 cubic foot per second from Calapooya Creek, for irrigation of a certain 0.8 acre in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 28 and 0.3 acre in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 27, both as projected within J. T. Daniel DLC #44, Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M., under a priority date of January 26, 1948.

The authorized points of diversion are located 65 feet North and 875 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 27, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22 and 2620 feet South and 600 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 27, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 27, both in Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the use and place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to use said water for stock in SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and SW 1/4 SW 1/4 and irrigation of 0.1 acre in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 0.2 acre in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27, from a point of diversion located 960 feet South and 560 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 27, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 27, Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the News-Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of March 24 and 31 and April 7, 1980.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use, point of diversion and use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use, point of diversion and use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use, point of diversion and use of water, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

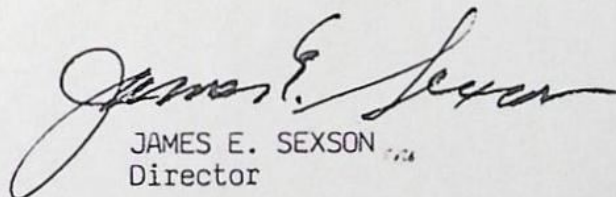
That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 20981, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

The Water Resources Director of Oregon has received and filed an application by Harold Crouch for approval, without loss of priority, of changes in place of use, point of diversion & use heretofore made of water under a certain water right.

The affected water right is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 20981, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Harold Crouch, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.003 cubic foot per second from Calapooya Creek, under a priority date of January 26, 1948, for irrigation of a certain 0.8 ac in NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Sec 28 & 0.3 ac in NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Sec 27, both as projected within J.T. Daniel DLC #44, T 25S, R 6W, WM.

The authorized points of diversion are located 65 ft N & 875 ft E from the NW Cor of Sec 27, being within the SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Sec 22 and 2620 ft S & 600 ft E from the NW¹/₄ Cor of Sec 27, being within the NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ of Sec 27, both in T 25S, R 6W, WM.

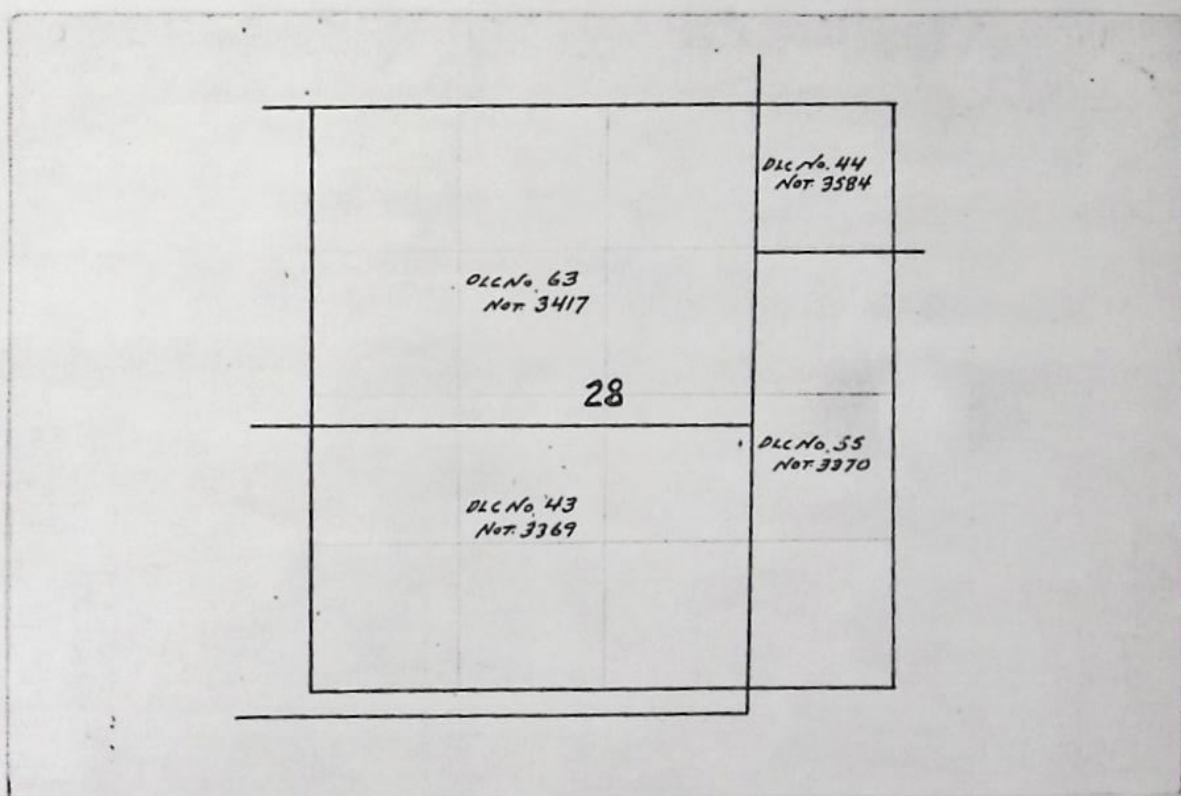
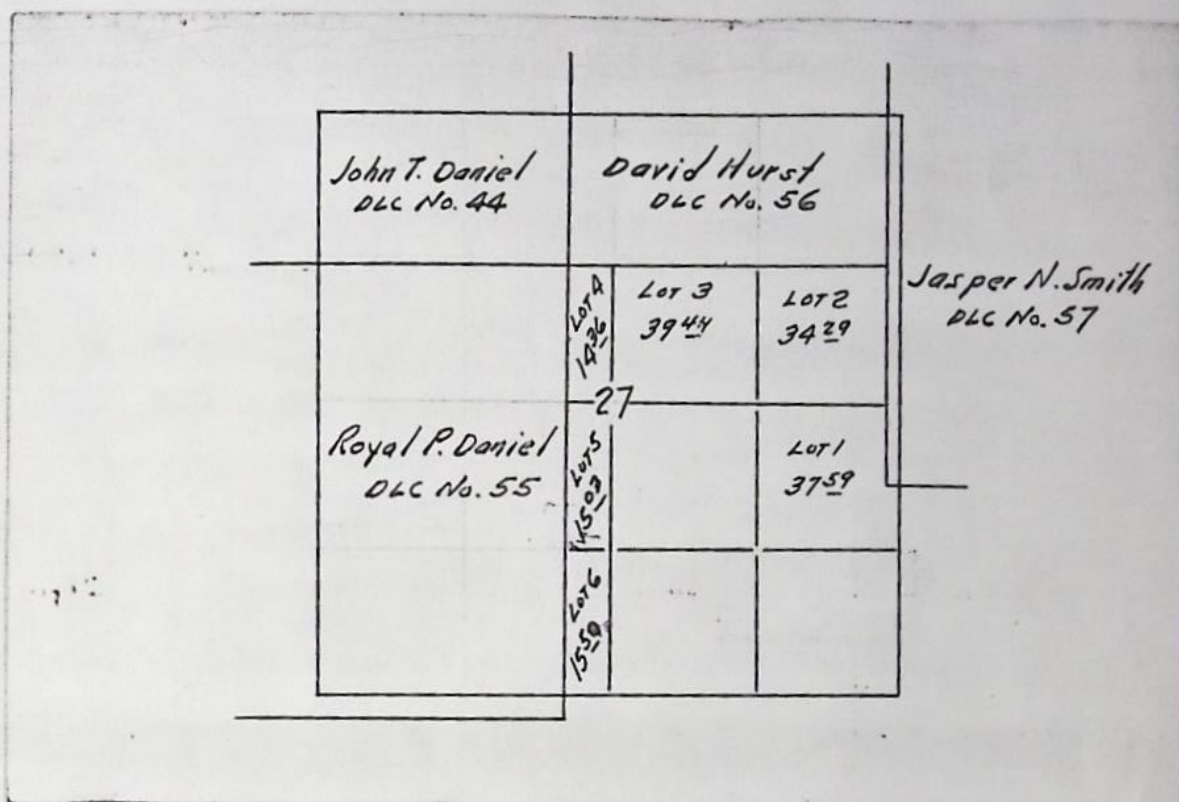
