



CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RONALD R. AND DEBRA K. SIEBERT 5734 PLEASANT CREEK ROAD ROGUE RIVER, OREGON 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of PLEASANT CREEK, a tributary of EVANS CREEK, for IRRIGATING 5.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1862.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

The point of diversion is located as follows:





ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4415

On March 3, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Ronald R. & Debra K. Siebert for approval of a change in point of diversion from Pleasant Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, Oregon, entered April 26, 1919, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and Its Tributaries, a water right was allowed in the name of Dan Cameron for the use of waters of Pleasant Creek for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 3.0 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 22, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M., tabulated at Volume 4, page 17, with a date of priority of 1862, as evidenced by certificate recorded at page 16127, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

By said Decree, a water right was allowed in the name of Lone Star Mining Co. for use of waters of Pleasant Creek for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 5.0 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of said Section 22, tabulated at Volume 4, page 17, with a date of priority of 1862, as evidenced by certificate recorded at page 16128 of said Volume 13.

The authorized point of diversion is located 325 feet North and 760 feet West from the South Quarter Corner of Section 10, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M. (Upper Wakeman Ditch).

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom to a point located 50 feet South and 750 feet West from the Center of Section 22, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 10, 17 and 24, 1980.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificates recorded at pages 16127 and 16128, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right allowed by certificate number 16127 NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, confirming certificates of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

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

By said Decree, a water right was allowed in the name of Lone Star Mining Co. for use of waters of Pleasant Creek for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 5.0 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of said Section 22, tabulated at Volume 4, page 17, with a date of priority of 1862, as evidenced by certificate recorded at page 16128 of said Volume 13.

The authorized point of diversion is located 325 feet North and 760 feet West from the South Quarter Corner of Section 10, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M. (Upper Wakeman Ditch).

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom to a point located 50 feet South and 750 feet West from the Center of Section 22, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 10, 17 and 24, 1980.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1981.


