





ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4434

On March 21, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Homer Nelson Sheets for approval of a change in use heretofore made of water from Wonder Mountain Gulch, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 20253, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of R. Glenn and Pearl E. Rees, describes a right established under the terms of Permit No. 15375 for the use of water from Wonder Mountain Gulch for irrigation of a certain 8.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 37 South, Range 7 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 31, 1942.

It is noted that the said certificate contains a clerical error in that it describes the quantity of water appropriated for said lands as 0.01 cubic foot per second. The correct quantity, as established in the taking of proof of performance under said permit, is 0.10 cubic foot per second.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 60 feet South and 400 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 15, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 37 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

The applicant herein proposes to sever the right from 0.5 acre of said 8.0 acres, without loss of priority, and to change the use heretofore made from irrigation to domestic use during the irrigation season only.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Daily Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 22, 29 and June 5, 1980.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in use heretofore made of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in use heretofore made of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in use heretofore made of water, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in use heretofore made of water is completed.

The order of the Water Resources Director entered May 9, 1980, approving transfer application No. 4321, provided for cancellation of the certificate recorded at page 20253, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and issuance of a new certificate covering the balance of the right NOT involved in the transfer proceedings.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of the right involved in the change authorized herein NOT be included in the new certificate to be issued as provided by said order; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.



The water Resources Director of Oregon has received and filed an application by Homer Nelson Sheets for approval, without loss of priority, of a change in use hereto-fore made of water under a certain water right.

The affected water right is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 20253, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of R. Glenn & Pearl E. Rees, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second from Wonder Mountain Gulch, under a priority date of Oct. 31, 1942, for irrigation of a certain 0.5 ac in SW1/4 SW1/4, Sec 10, T 375, R 7W, WM.

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into in multiple originals this //th day of June, 1977, by and between FRANK F. PAULI and RUTH ELIZABETH PAULI, also known as RUTH E. PAULI, husband and wife, hereinafter referred to as Vendor, and H. NELSON SHEETS and VIOLA M. SHEETS, husband and wife or survivor, hereinafter referred to as Vendee,

WITNESSETH:

1. The Vendor hereby sells to the Vendee and the Vendee hereby purchases from the Vendor, upon the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract and for the purchase price of \$45,000.00, payable as set forth in this Contract, the following real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereof, and any improvements thereon, situated in Josephine County, Oregon, to-wit:

VPARCEL I:

A parcel of land in the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 37 South, Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian, Josephine County, Oregon: Beginning at a point 1307.39 feet South and 632.44 feet East of the Quarter corner between Sections 9 and 10; thence South 70°00' East 743.12 feet along the center line of a roadway 30 feet in width to the East line of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 10 and the true point of beginning; thance North 70°00' West along the center line of said roadway 350 feet; thence South 390 feet, more or less, to the center line of U.S. Highway #199; thence Easterly along said center line to a point due South of the true point of beginning; thence North 180 feet, more or less, to the true point of beginning.
