ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4342

On December 4, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Daniel Hayman for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from an unnamed spring, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 23465, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Edwin J. Lyons, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second from an unnamed spring for domestic use in a trailer court within Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 16, Township 18 South, Range 11 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 13, 1956.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 900 feet North and 75 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 16, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 18 South, Range 11 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion, without loss of priority, to a point located 1386 feet North and 1263 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 16, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 18 South, Range 11 West, W.M.

Mr. L. Gene McGinnis, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

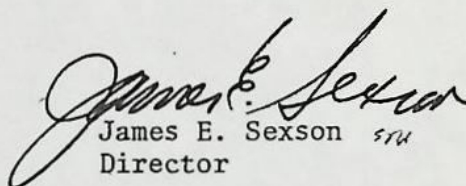
That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of diversion is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 24365, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

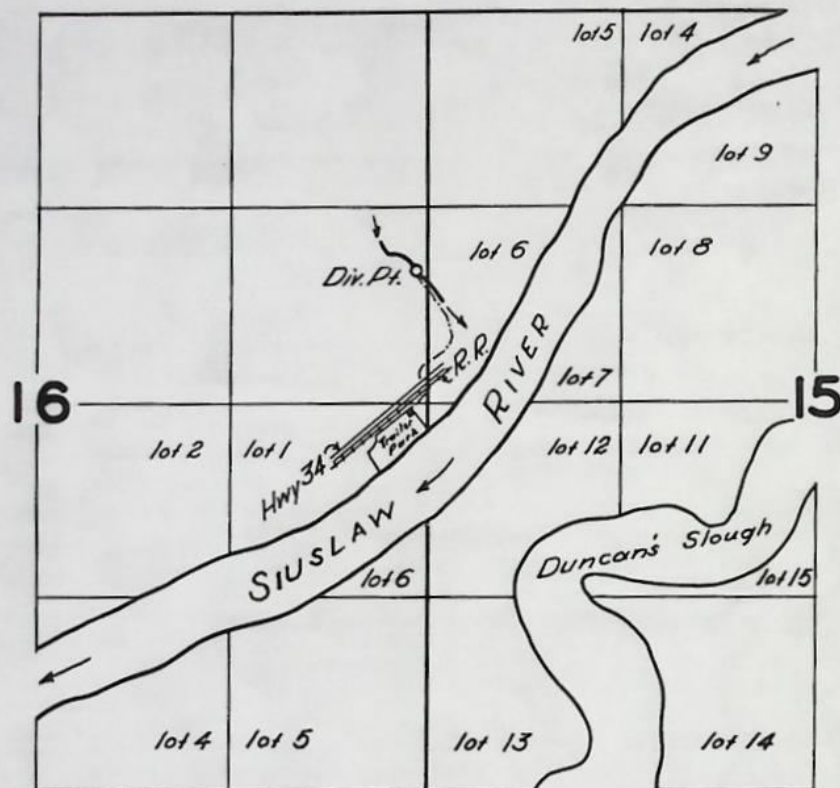

1. This license, together with the cash payment made by Licensor to Licensee on August 24, 1972, constitutes full compensation for damage to Licensee's water line.

2. Licensee will use and maintain said water line of the Licensor until such time as Licensor begins to use it, at which time Licensor will assume the maintenance of said line.

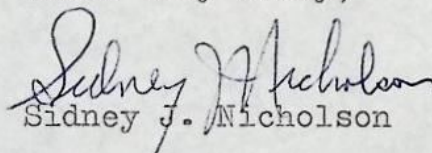
Pursuant to your letter of September 14, 1979, I herewith enclose the new application of Daniel Hayman to transfer his existing water right together with my check in the sum of \$35.00 for processing the application.

The diversion on the unnamed stream was necessitated by the construction of a Bonneville Power line access road that tore out the old point of diversion. Hayman received compensation for this as well as consent to the new point of diversion on the Bonneville right of way and an easement from Bonneville and International Paper Co. for the water line down the hill. The point of diversion moved only approximately 600 feet on up the same stream from the information I have received and this would not require a subsequent publication.

Will you please examine the present application and if you find it to be in good order commence the processing of it as soon as possible. If you have any further questions please call upon me.

WATER PIPELINE EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That INTERNATIONAL PAPER COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, herein called "Grantor," in consideration of One Dollar (\$1) and other good and valuable consideration, does hereby GRANT unto DANIEL H. HAYMAN and ALICE F. HAYMAN, husband and wife, herein called "Grantees," for a period of Twenty-five (25) years, an easement upon, over and across the following described lands situated in the County of Lane, State of Oregon:

A portion of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Sixteen (16) in Township Eighteen (18) South of Range Eleven (11) West of the Willamette Meridian, said easement being Five (5) feet in width, the center line of which is described as follows and shown on the plat hereto attached marked Exhibit "A" and by this reference made a part hereof:

1. Grantees shall have the right to enter upon the land above described and to construct, install, repair, maintain and use thereon, and to remove therefrom, a water pipeline for the purpose of transporting water for domestic uses.
2. Grantees agree to reimburse Grantor for any damage to Grantor's property caused by or arising out of the exercise by Grantees of any of their rights hereunder.
3. Grantees agree to indemnify and save harmless the Grantor against all claims and liabilities asserted by third parties, including all costs and expenses incurred in connection therewith, resulting directly or indirectly

4. By acceptance of this easement Grantees agree that Grantor shall not be liable for any damage to Grantees' pipeline or other installations caused by logging operations on or other use of Grantor's land. Grantees shall take all precautions to avoid injury to growing trees on Grantor's land and shall be liable for any such injury.

5. All rights of Grantees hereunder shall cease upon nonuse of said pipeline for a period of one year, and in case of such nonuse Grantees shall deliver to Grantor a recordable instrument releasing all Grantees' rights hereunder and shall, at Grantor's request, remove said pipeline and other installations.

6. The provisions hereof shall be binding upon and shall enure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors, heirs and assigns.

HAYMAN, husband and wife, herein called "Grantees," for a period of Twenty-five (25) years, an easement upon, over and across the following described lands situated in the County of Lane, State of Oregon:

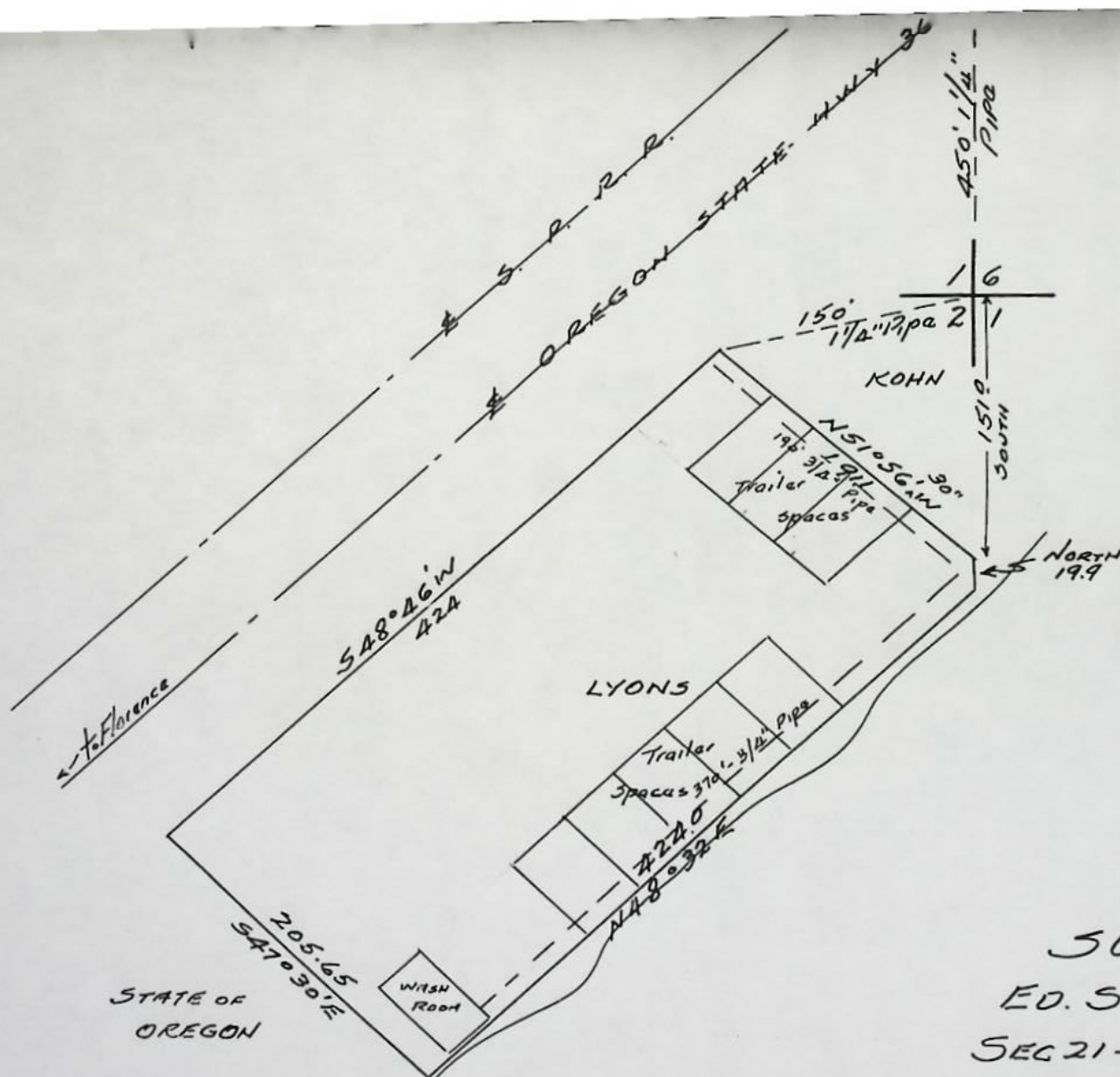
