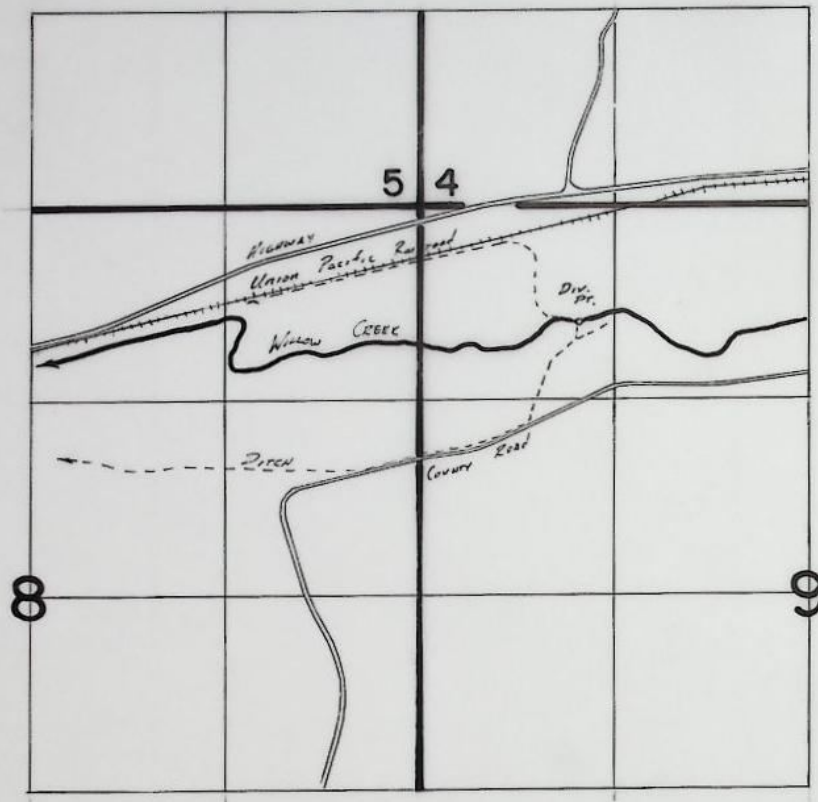

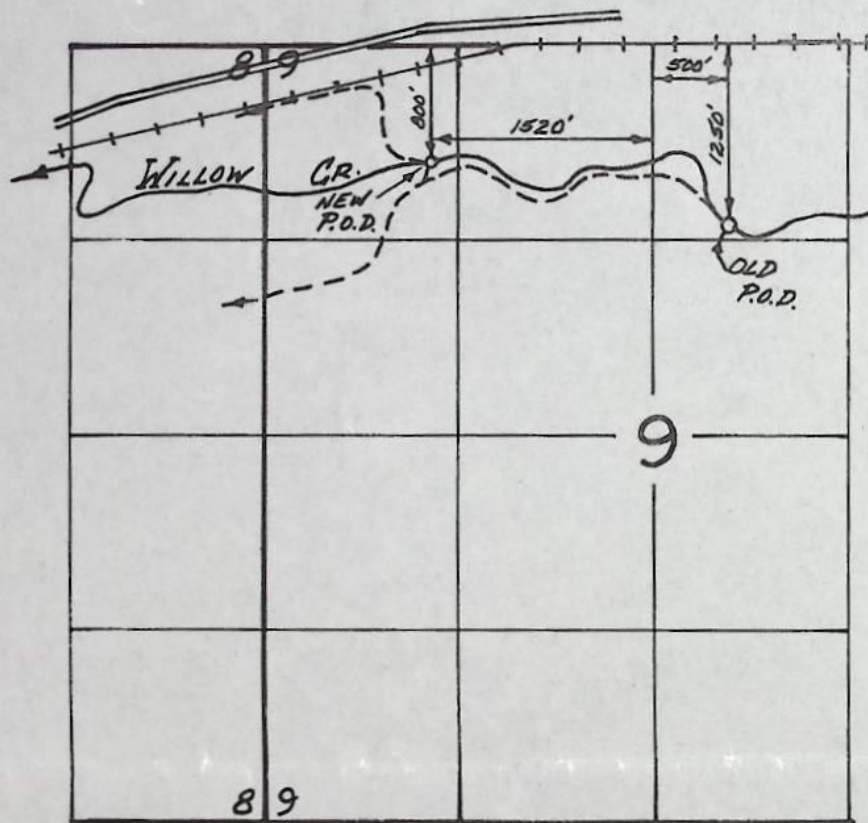

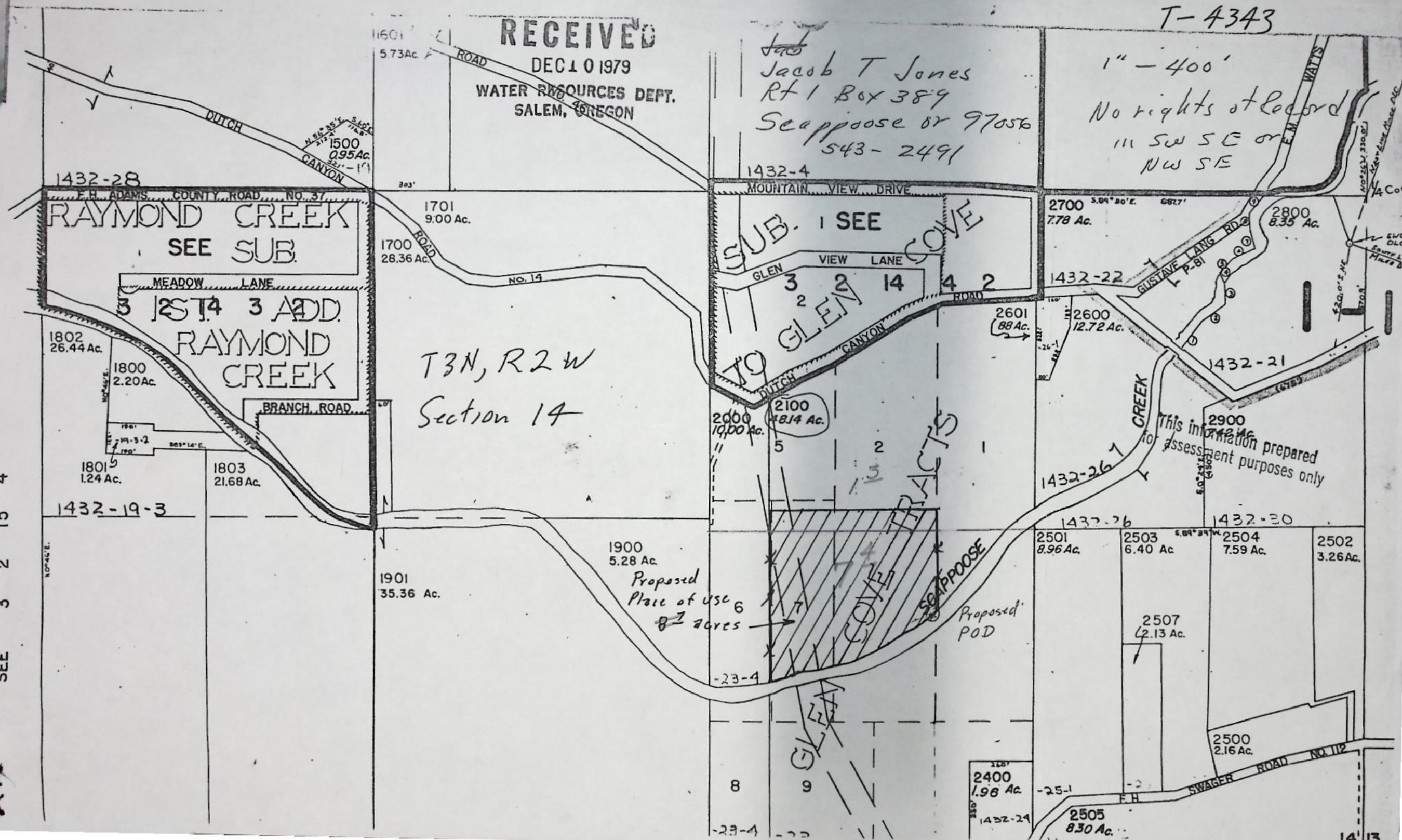

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4344

On December 10, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Elmer S. and Lorraine M. Ladd for approval of a change in point of diversion from Willow Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 148, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of D.H. Grabill, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second from Willow Creek for irrigation of a certain 5.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 15.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 1 South, Range 24 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1909.

The certificate recorded at page 159 of said Volume 1, in the name of Helen V. Woolery Knappenburg, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 1.31 cubic feet per second from Willow Creek for irrigation of a certain 22.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 9.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 13.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 16.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 18.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 24 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1905.

The certificate recorded at page 160 of said Volume 1, in the name of J.D. Land, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second from Willow Creek for irrigation of a certain 5.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 24 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1908.

The certificate recorded at page 186 of said Volume 1, in the name of Archie Rice, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second from Willow Creek for irrigation of a certain 4.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 24 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1905.

The certificate recorded at page 172 of said Volume 1, in the name of M.R. Morgan, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.59 cubic foot per second from Willow Creek for irrigation of a certain 31.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 4.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, Township 1 South, Range 24 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1889.

The authorized point of diversion for the said rights is located 1250 feet South and 500 feet East from the North Quarter Corner of Section 9, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 1 South, Range 24 East, W.M. (Woolery Ditch).

The applicants propose to change the point of diversion therefrom to a point located 800 feet South and 1520 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of Section 9, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 1 South, Range 24 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Gazette-Times, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Morrow County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of December 20 and 27, 1979, and January 3, 1980.

Mr. Steven P. Applegate, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

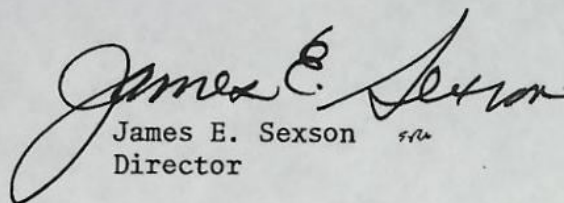
That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificates of water right recorded at pages 148, 159, 160, 172 and 186, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates,

are canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.

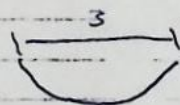

In my opinion the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Willow Creek
MAY BE MADE WITHOUT INJURY WOULD RESULT IN INJURY* to an existing water right.
