

Inclosed find supporting documentation associated with the Transfer No. 4360. As per our phone conversations, subsequent research and review of the tax lot 900/801 common property line and the 1950's surveyed water rights map description of the "pipe line" appears to be both the same. It is worth noting that older described water rights viewed with today's available technology of descriptions, the so noted "pipe line" associated with non-tied corners with section lines is of interest. Please note the water right Permit No. 19130 on tax lot 900 and Permit No. 21982 application maps were drafted at the same time by the same surveyor, Mr. Wilford N. Haines and clearly they both abut each other irregardless of their locations.

It appears that permit 19130 is on tax lot 900 west of the 1/4 line of section 29. Also that permit 21982 is east of the 1/4 line of section 29 and in part west of the "pipe line" now assumed common property line.

It is also evident the approved transfer 4360 transferring in part permit 21982, then Certificate 49003, transferred water rights overlaying on tax lot 900. This is that area between the 1/4 line of section 29 and the common property line assumed "pipe line" map description.

The inclosed copies of deed records appear to indicate the transfer 4360 that was applied for by Mr. Paddon and approved in 1980 while still under land contract with the owner, Mr. Baird for tax lot 801. This water right transfer 4360 was approved 8 plus years before Joseph and Janice Martin purchased the land tax lot 900 with its remaining rights as described in the approved transfer 4360. At this time it is unknown whether Mr. Paddon had written or verbal permission from Mr. Fosbrink, the owner of tax lot 900 in 1980, to transfer that portion between the 1/4 line and common property line between tax lot 900 and 801. In perspective, all was to be notified in the Department's notices, Mr. John Youngquist, then Watermaster filed a statement in effect of "..without injury..." and with no dissent or further objections having been filed, the transfer was approved in 1980. This was all before the land, tax lot 900, was purchased by the Martins.

As it is understood now, Joseph and Janice Martin purchased the land in 1989, tax lot 900, in

good faith with the understanding of the water rights as used and approved for such use. This would include the transfer 4360 as described and approved. Therefore in order to proceed with the Claim of Beneficial Use for the Transfer No. 4360, consent to proceed will need to be authorized by all involved.
