
ORDER AMENDING
ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4361

On January 7, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Glenn L. Rohde for approval of a change in point of appropriation of water from a well, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 5, 1980, at pages 177 and 178, Volume 33, Special Order Record, approving said change in point of appropriation, omitted 2.0 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 30 East, W.M., which should have been included in said order.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that paragraph 2 on page 177, Volume 33, Special Order Record, be amended to read: "...0.2 acre in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, 2.0 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 28.4 acres...".

TRANSFER NO. 4361

On January 7, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Glenn L. Rohde for approval of a change in point of appropriation of water from a well, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 40898, Volume 32, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Glen L. Rohde, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second from a well for irrigation of a certain 3.5 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, 33.6 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, 3.0 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 16; 11.4 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, 0.2 acre in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, 28.4 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and 2.6 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 30 East W.M., with a date of priority of October 4, 1966.

Water for the said right is appropriated from a well located 2650 feet South and 330 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 17, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 30 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of appropriation therefrom, without loss of priority, to a well located 140 feet North and 310 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 17, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 30 East, W. M.

Mr. Steven P. Applegate, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of appropriation, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of appropriation under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of appropriation as herein confirmed:


That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of appropriation is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 40890, Volume 32, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

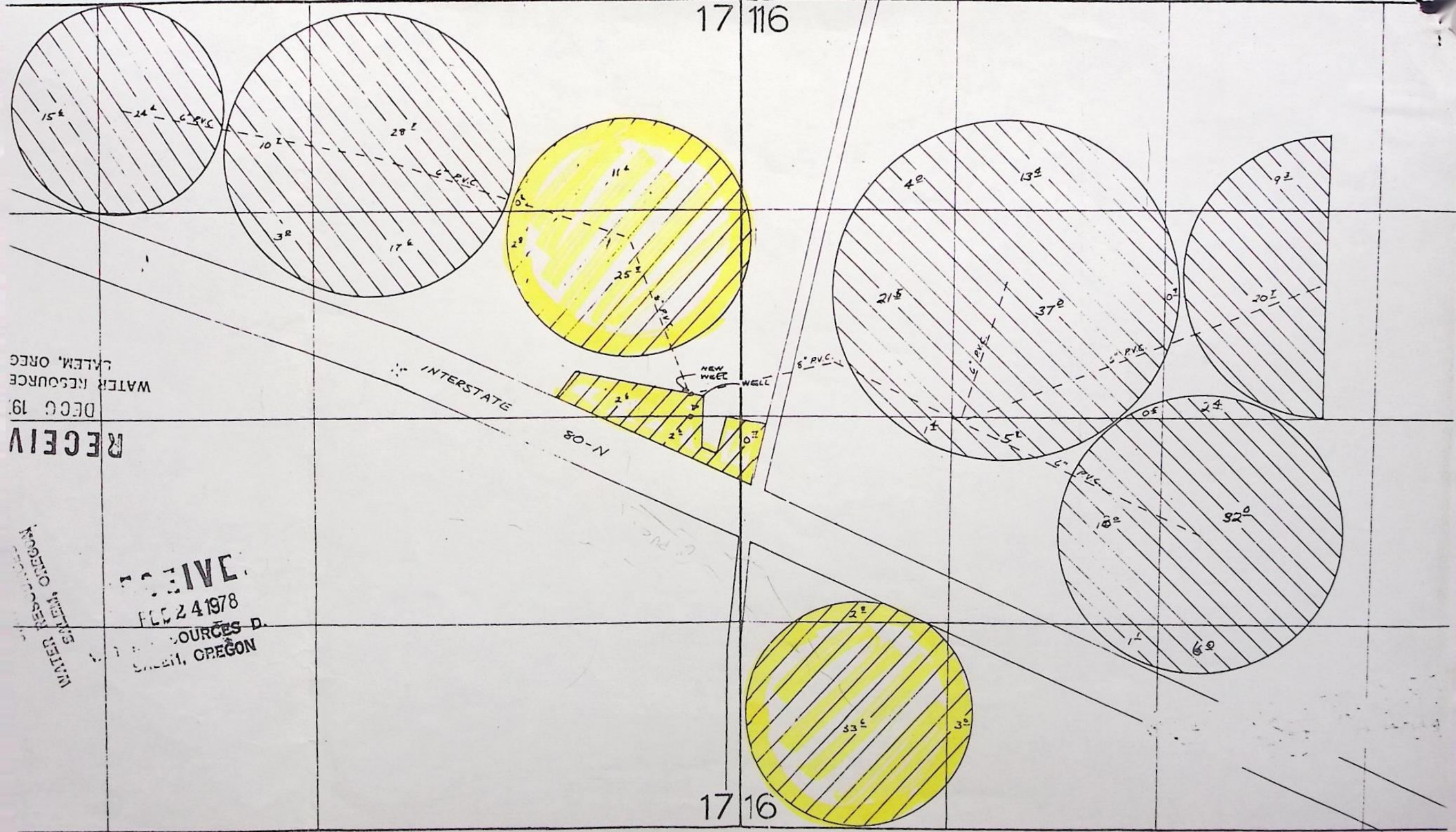
