confirms the right to use the waters of TROUT CREEK, tributary to DESCHUTES RIVER for DOMESTIC, STOCK USE, and IRRIGATION of 72.25 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jefferson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 57. The date of priority is 1879. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre-feet per acre during any period of 30 days or 6 acre-feet per acre during any irrigation season, measured at the points of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point(s) of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:



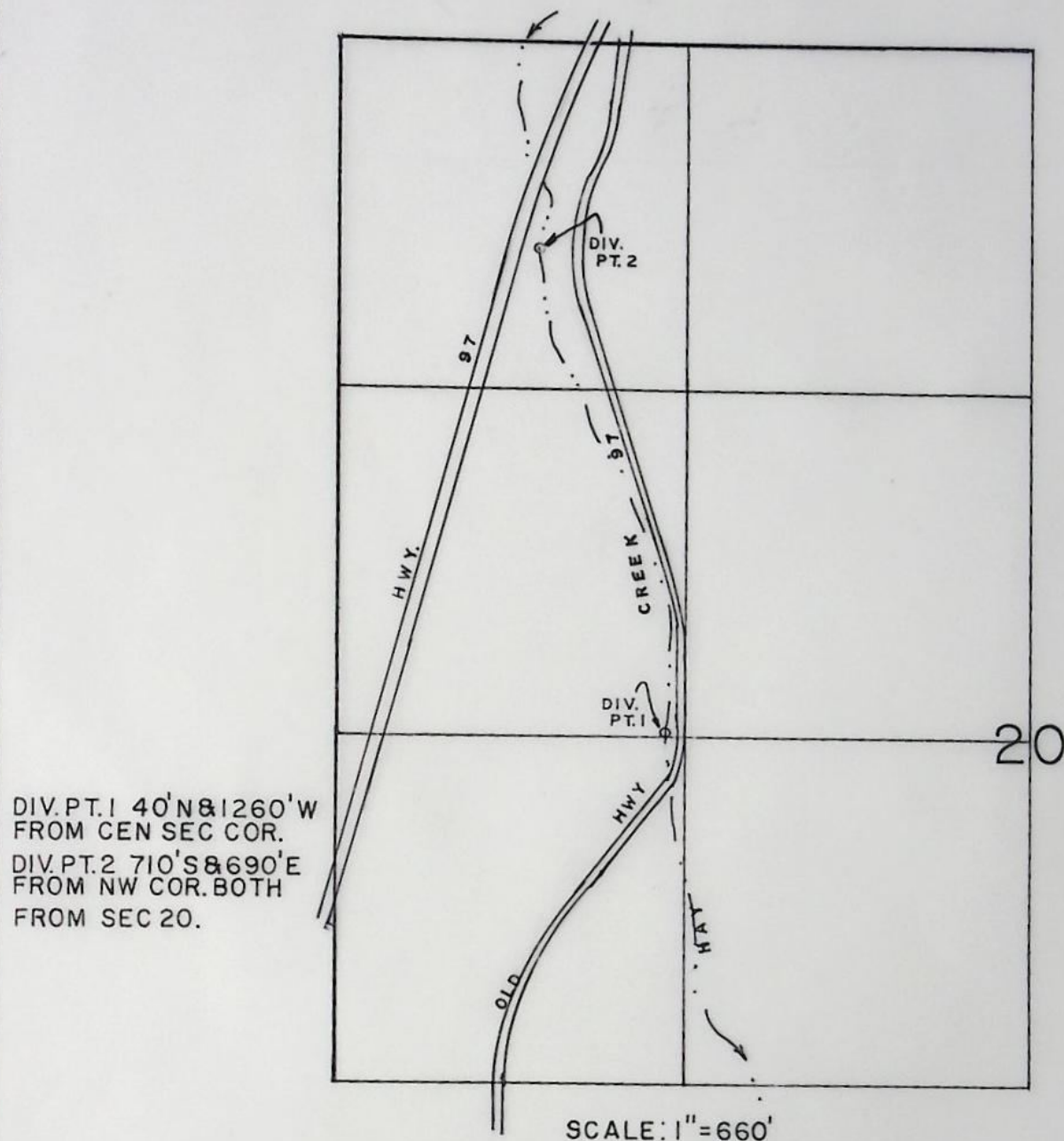

O R D E R

On March 20, 1968, Ronald B. Ochs submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of that portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, W.M., lying northwesterly of County Road No. 509, and the water rights appurtenant thereto; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water rights and requests the same to be canceled.

The water rights in question are:

(a) as established by Decree of the Circuit Court for Jefferson County, entered August 10, 1918, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Trout Creek and its Tributaries, in the name of Bidwell Cram, for the use of not to exceed one acre foot per acre during any period of thirty days or three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season of the waters of Hay Creek and its tributaries, for irrigation of, among other lands, 8.75 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, W.M., with dates of priority of 1885 from Hay Creek and 1886 from Wilson Creek, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 2230, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates;

(b) as established by Decree of the Circuit Court for Jefferson County, entered August 10, 1918, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Trout Creek and its Tributaries, in the name of H. L. and Mary Friday, for the use of not to exceed one acre foot per acre during any period of thirty days or three acre feet per acre

during any irrigation season of the waters of Hay Creek for irrigation of, among other lands, 8.75 acres in NW¼ SW¼, Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1902, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 2256, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates;

(c) for the use of not to exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second, including the amount secured under any other right, of the waters of Trout Creek for supplemental irrigation of, among other lands, 9.3 acres in NW¼ SW¼, Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, W.M., with a date of priority of November 12, 1915, and is evidenced by certificate of water right issued in the name of Bidwell Cram, as Trustee, and recorded at page 3490, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates;

(d) for the use of not to exceed one-eightieth of a cubic foot per second per acre, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, of the waters of Lyle Ditch and Reservoir, for supplemental irrigation of, among other lands, 8.75 acres in NW¼ SW¼, Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, W.M., with a date of priority of May 6, 1911, and is evidenced by certificate of water right issued in the name of Chester M. Kennedy and recorded at page 9690, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the right for the use of not to exceed one acre foot per acre during any period of thirty days or three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season of the waters of Hay Creek and its tributaries, for irrigation of 8.75 acres in NW¼ SW¼, Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, W.M., with dates of priority of 1885



It is FURTHER ORDERED that the right for the use of not to exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second, including the amount secured under any other right, of the waters of Trout Creek for supplemental irrigation of 9.3 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, W.M., with a date of priority of November 12, 1915, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 3490, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and;

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the right for the use of not to exceed one eightieth of a cubic foot per second, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, of the waters of Lyle Ditch and Reservoir, for supplemental irrigation of 8.75 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, W.M., with a date of priority of May 6, 1911, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 9690, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

On January 14, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Floyd Bauer for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Hay Creek and Wilson Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.


By Decree of the Circuit Court for Jefferson County, Oregon, entered August 10, 1981, In The Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Trout Creek and Its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Bidwell Cram for the use of waters of Hay Creek and Wilson Creek, for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 7.5 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 17; 27.5 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 18; 11.5 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, 13.5 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, 6.1 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 1.0 acre in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 19; 18.95 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, 30.8 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, 36.1 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 26.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 20, all in Township 9 South, Range 15 East, WM, with a date of priority of 1885 for Hay Creek and 1886 for Wilson Creek, being tabulated in the name of Bidwell Cram at Volume 5, page 72, as evidenced by the Certificate recorded at page 45511, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

On April 23, 1981, Certificate 45511 was superceded by the Certificate recorded at page 49923, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates, prior to approval of said proposed change in point of diversion.

The lands described above, for which a change in point of diversion is requested, should be deleted from Certificate 49923.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 49923, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

ORDER CORRECTING DECREE

Ronald Ochs having petitioned the court for a correction of the decree dated August 10, 1918, entered in the above matter, and

It appearing from the petition and exhibits attached thereto that:

a. the original adjudication survey showed ten and three-quarter acres of water rights as appearing in the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 15, East of the Willamette Meridian, and

b. Based upon the adjudication survey, Bidwell Cram, who was owner of the land in question in 1916, prepared and filed a statement and proof of claim before the State Water Board and that in the statement and proof of claim his answers to the questions propounded therein were required to conform to the adjudication survey. It appears that instead of entering the ten and three quarter acres in the square denoting the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter, he entered it instead in the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Township and Range. It further appears from the statement and proof of claim, that he did not own the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter but he did own the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter.

c. It further appears that the error was then copied into the final decree and that based upon the final decree the State Water Board made and entered a certificate of water right which is recorded in the water right certificates Volume III at page 2230, showing the ten and three-quarter acres of water right to Trout Creek being in the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter.

d. It further appears from the affidavit of the watermaster for District 11 that he has examined the records and the land and is of the opinion that the ten and three-quarter acre water right properly belongs in the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of the said Section 18.

e. It further appears from the affidavit of Ronald Ochs that he has leased the land in question for the past three years and in his opinion the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section 18 does not appear to have ever been irrigated from the waters of Trout Creek.

Based upon the foregoing, the Court finds that a mistake appears in the decree on page 72 of the order record thereof wherein it appears that ten and three-quarter acres of water right allocated in the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 15 East of the Willamette Meridian should be corrected so that the ten and three-quarter acres of water right appear as being allocated in the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 15 East of the Willamette Meridian, and

GOOD CAUSE Appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That page 72 of the order record of the decree entered in the above matter dated August 10, 1918, whereby the ten and three-quarter acres of water right formerly appearing as being allocated to the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 15 East of the Willamette Meridian be and the same is hereby corrected to read as being allocated to the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 15 East of the Willamette Meridian.

Dear Mr. Bauer:

I have discussed your application for a change in point of diversion of water from Hay Creek for irrigation of 187.25 acres in Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, WM, with the Water Rights Division Administrator.

Since the time the original water right was allowed, State Highway 97 was built, removing about 8.3 acres of land under that right in Sections 19 and 20. The lost acreage cannot be reinstated in another location, even within property you own.

Consequently, the acreage shown on your application must be reduced by the number of acres lost to the highway. I am returning your application and map so you can make the adjustments.

If you wish, you can make a new filing for a water right for the lands along the outside edges.

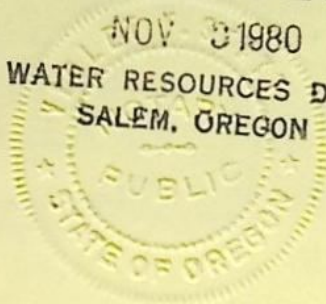
