A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

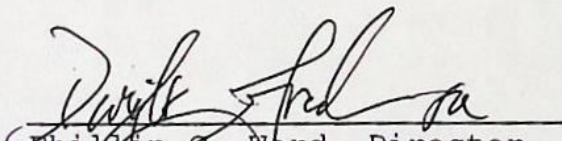

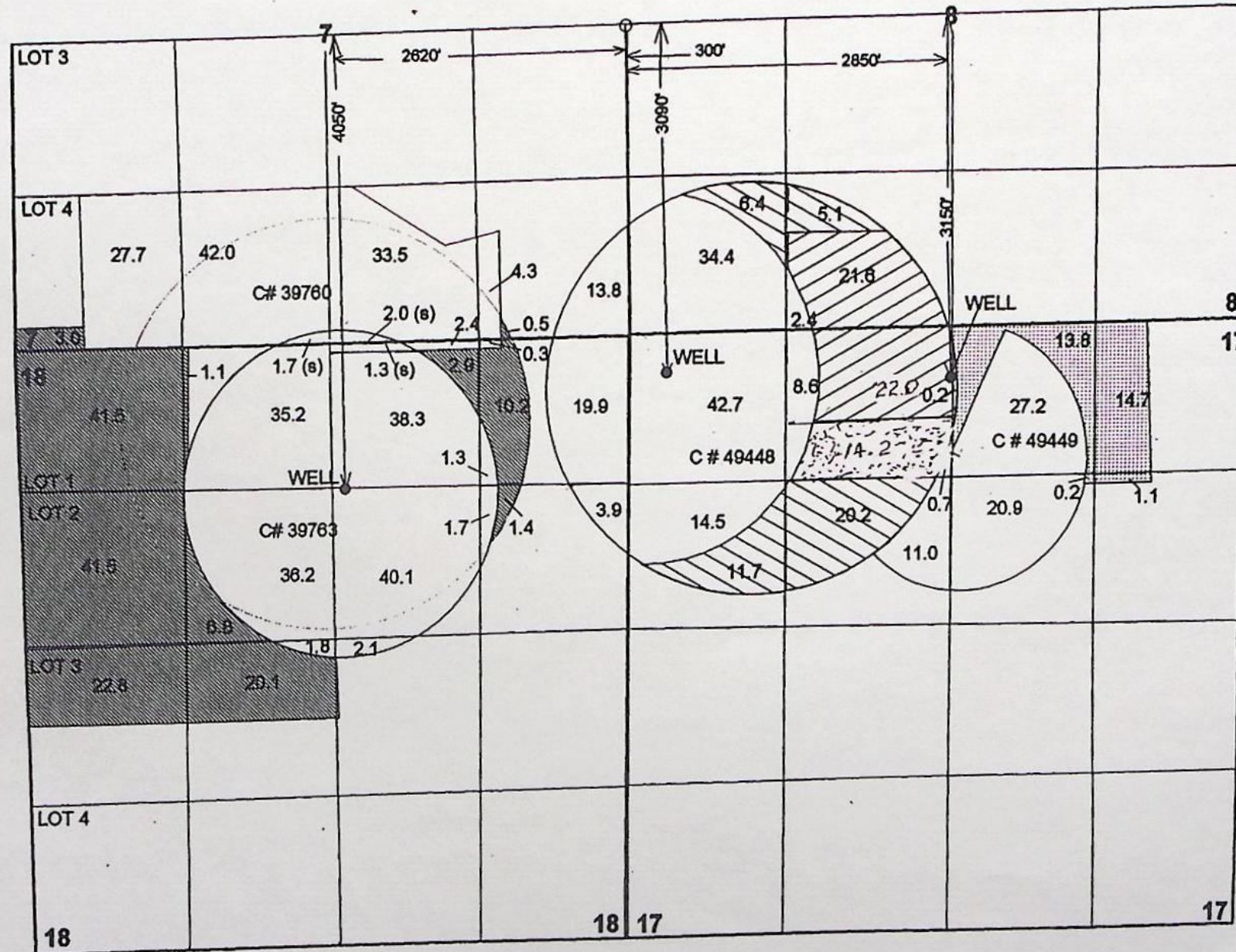

On January 22, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by J.J. Praggastis for approval of a change in place of use of water from a well, pursuant to the provisions of 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 39764, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Adolf J. Kisle, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 1.30 cubic feet per second from a well for irrigation of 5.0 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, 28.0 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and 11.0 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 17, Township 24 South, Range 30 East, W.M., with a date of priority of September 27, 1968.

Water for the said right is appropriated from a well located 3150 feet South and 2850 feet East from the West Quarter Corner of Section 8, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 24 South, Range 30 East, W.M.

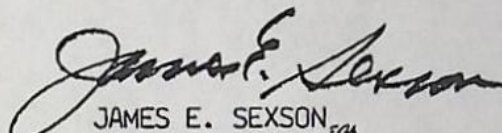

Subject: Changes to Shepard Transfers and Permits

I am proposing to change the allowed acres on T-4375 and Permit G-9382. You may remember that the transfer changed the POU to lands outside the smaller ½ circle, to form a squared off field. This is in Section 17, T 24 S, R 30 E. The permit was to fill in part of the larger circle to the west.

According to your survey, they did not irrigate the southern portion of the squared field, outside the smaller ½ circle. You proposed the loss of 14.0 acres under the transfer. You placed the permit lands in the applied for location on the east side of the larger circle.

According to the applicant, he was replacing an old pivot with a newer larger one, and squaring up the eastern field for wheel lines. It is not clear why he distributed the rights as he did.

Unless you, as Watermaster, object, I am going to reduce the permitted acres and replace them with what would be the lost transfer acres. I realize this will be covering some of the "from" lands with the same right again. The transferred right has a 1968 priority. The permit has a 1980 priority. A 12 year priority difference could, perhaps, be important down the line. I am trying to preserve as much of the older priority as possible.

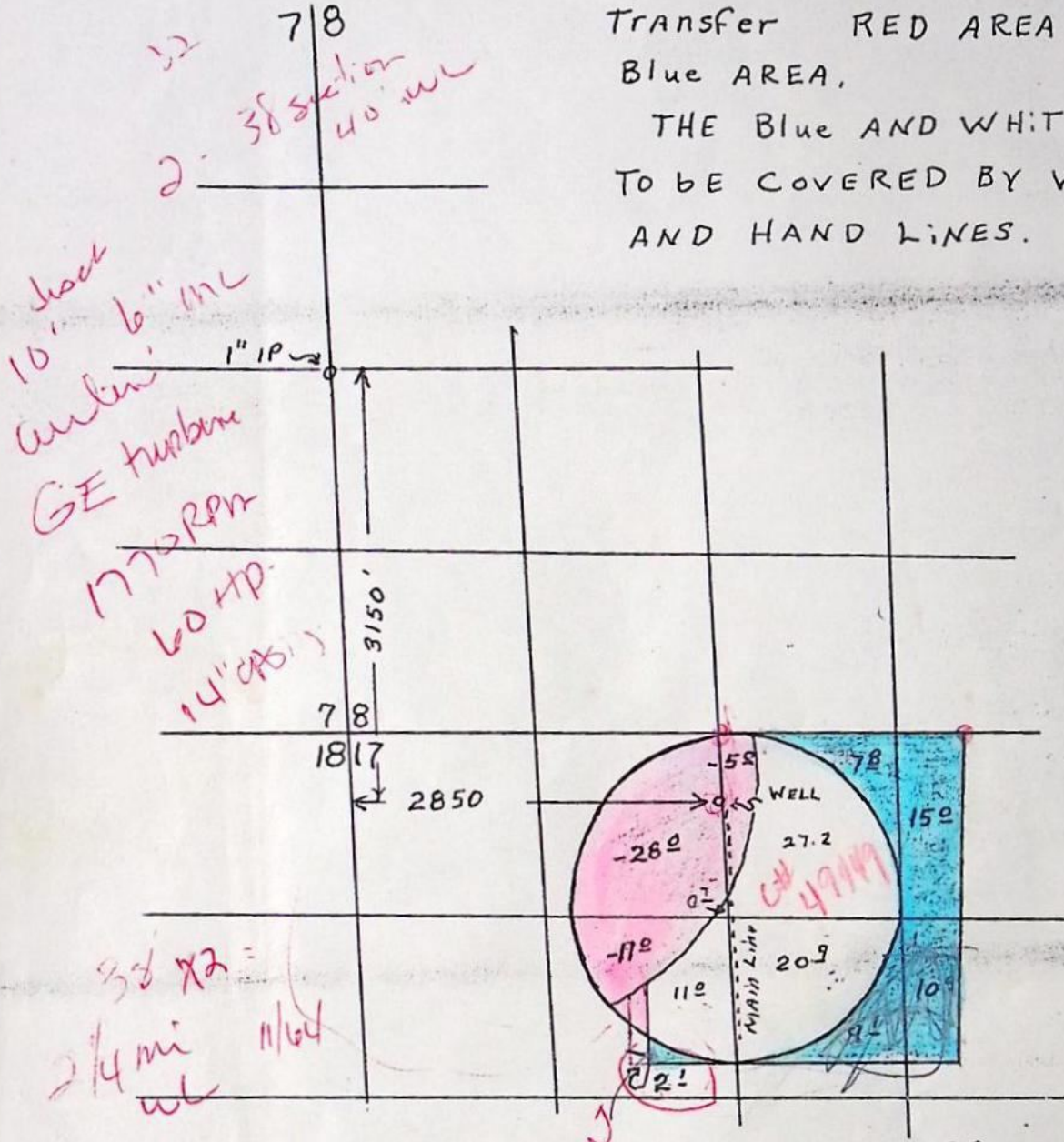

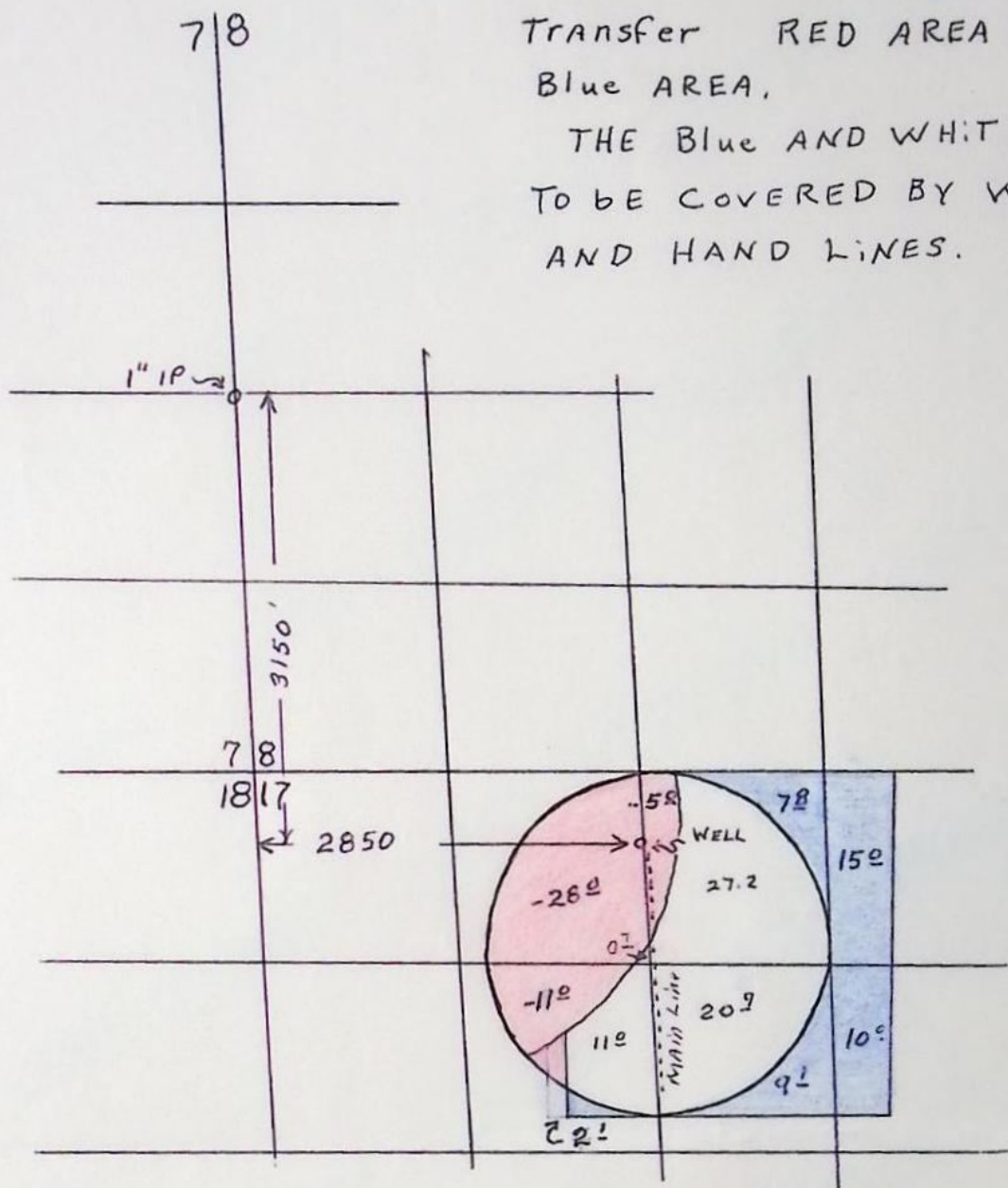
