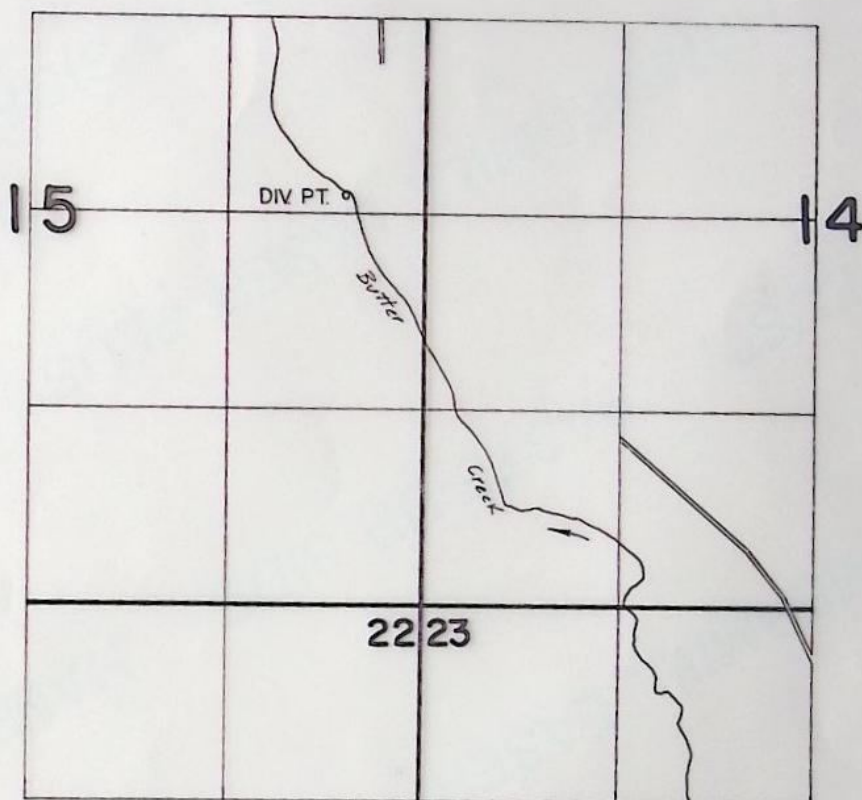

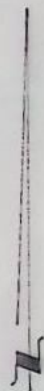

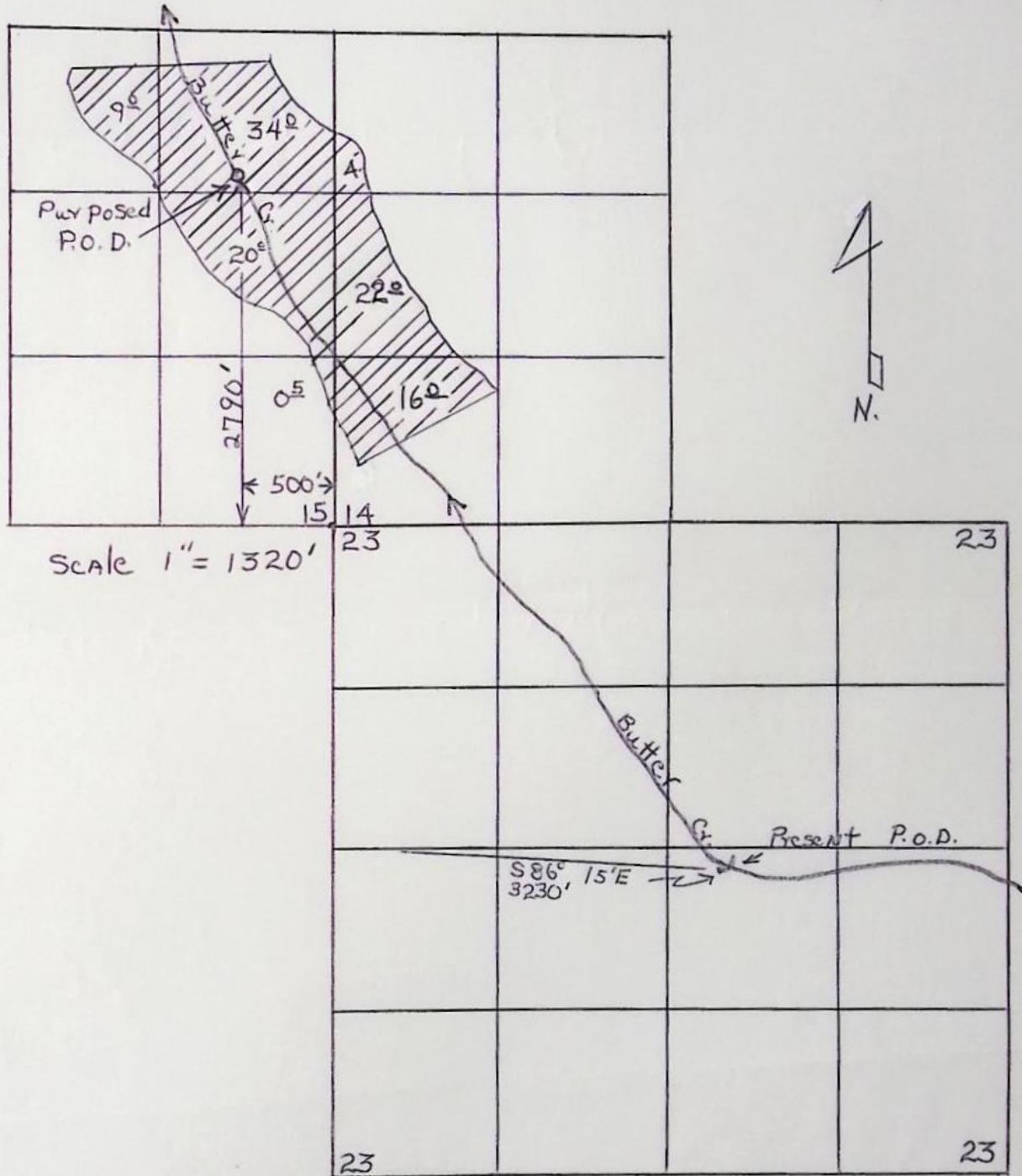

Info: John B Correa Mr Correa claims only one dam, one ditch goes to the east side and he also has two pumping points. The pumping points are under T-4301 for add'l P.O.D. First let us start with the dam. The dam is concrete builded it is twelve feet across about five high, this a guess do to the fact there is water in the creek here. From the dam we go about 50' upstream to the point of diversion. There is no measurement or control device. The look like it is in very bad shape, with holes and weeds. Mr Correa, he can sprinkle from one or the other ^{pump} ~~dam~~ stations, which mean he can pump to any part of the land one of the pump. Mr Correa claim he uses the pumps between Sept 2-Dec 30. The ditch has a dirt base and looks like $2\frac{1}{2}$ $1\frac{1}{2}$ $2\frac{1}{2}$ This dam is located roughly at the center of Sec 23 It goes along the county road for about $1\frac{1}{2}$ mile before cutting toward the creek, then along it for the last $\frac{1}{4}$ of mile. The only way to irrigate land on the west side is by way of the pumps. The first pump in the stream is downstream from the dam approx 4500' by the ranch house. This pump irrigates from the ranch house back toward the dam and also some land on the west side. We have a GE. 40HP @ 3540 RPM Cornell Serial 20160 $8\frac{3}{8}$ $3" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ CDD Mr Correa claim ^(max) 90 heads which would be both handline and wheelie. The Flow meter is McCrometer 74-6-418 1539.35 ac-ft. We have buried mainline for 1500' 6" PVC then goes to the portable mainline. We found 1500' of $5\frac{1}{4}"$ 6" Alum portable mainline along with 3"- 5920' Alum handline with Nelson $5/32" \times 0"$. Together with 2-4" quarter mile wheelies with Nelson $3/16"$ We seen some along fence here and there also. Go downstream approx 2400' to the other pump. Which they pull every year for it was not flood away. This is a Marathon 40HP @ 3510 RPM Cornell Serial 22632 $8\frac{3}{8}$ $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3"$ CDD Mr Correa also claims 90 heads max from this pump. We have approx 2400' of buried mainline 6" and 5" PVC. This pump would irrigate the land from ranch house to the ashbeck dam. and some land on the west side of the Creek. There is one wheelie for each pump.

On October 5, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by John B. Correa for approval of an additional point of diversion of water from Butter Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The affected water right is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 48569, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of John B. Correa, and is for the use of not to exceed 1.74 cubic feet per second from Butter Creek, under a priority date of 1877, for irrigation of a certain 4.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 22.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 16.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14; 9.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 34.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 20.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 0.5 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 27 East, W.M.

The authorized point of diversion is located South 86 degrees 15 minutes East, 3230 feet from the West Quarter Corner of Section 23, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, Township 1 North, Range 27 East, W.M.

The applicant proposes to establish an additional point of diversion at a point located 2790 feet North and 500 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 15, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 27 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Gazette-Times, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Morrow County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of November 15, 22 and 29, 1979.

Mr. Steven P. Applegate, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed additional point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed additional point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested additional point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed:

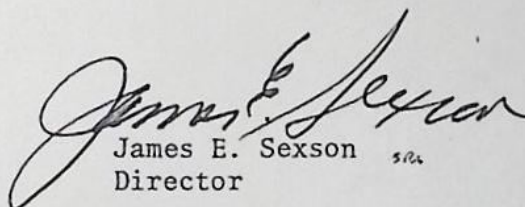
That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the additional point of diversion is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 48569, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
