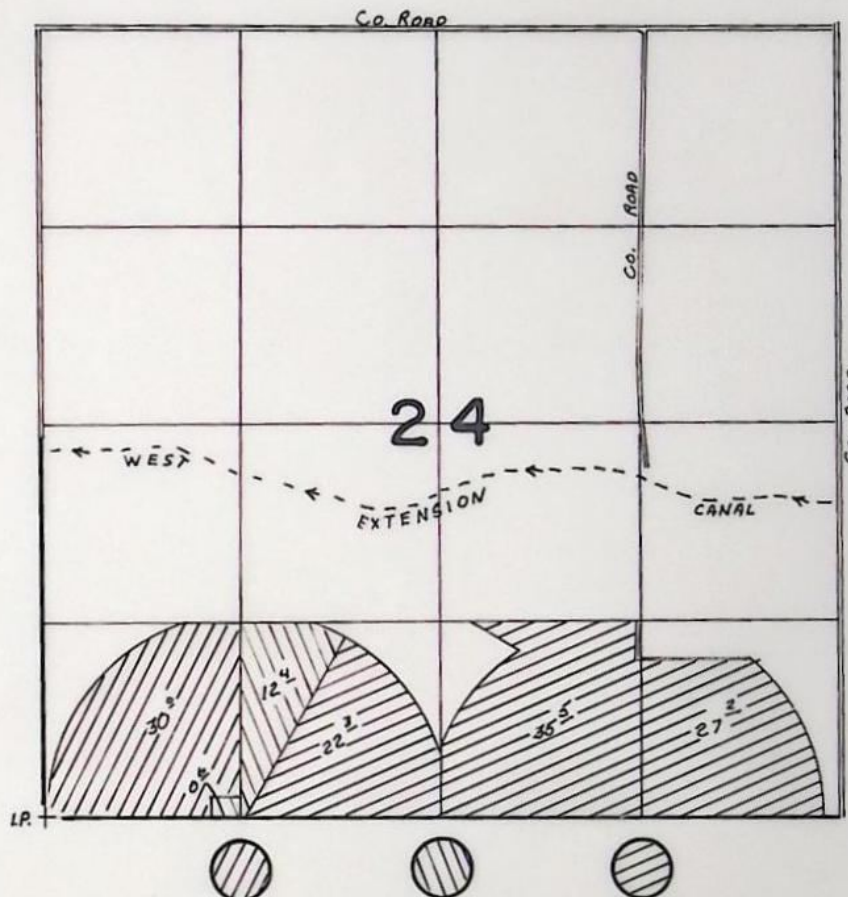

Now they have two half center pivots one in each 80 acres. ~~They~~ The east center pivot has alfalfa which up until two weeks ago had cattle on it. There is a little in the ~~SW $\frac{1}{4}$~~ ^{NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$} SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 24 that is outside the center pivot. Which is not being irrigated this last year.

The west center pivot last year was in corn, this year it will be pea and turnup they are going to double crop the field. The south line of the field borders the Navy Bombing Range. The center pivots intersect each other by a tower or overlay each other. Last year they went over to low pressure on the center pivots they figure 650 gpm each at 35 psi at the center. On the ~~SW~~ ^{corn} center pivot they only got $1\frac{1}{2}$ ton to the acre, because they had some problems with the center pivot.

On October 10, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Archie Reikkola, President, Lewis and Clark Seed Company, for approval of a change in place of use of water from Umatilla River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 10142, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of U.S. Reclamation Service, describes a right which includes the use of water from Umatilla River for irrigation of a certain 30.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 4 North, Range 24 East, W.M., with a date of priority of March 28, 1909.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the West Extension Ditch, from a point located 1000 feet North and 500 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 28, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 5 North, Range 28 East, W.M.

The applicant herein proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 30.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 4 North, Range 24 East, W.M.

Mr. Steven P. Applegate, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

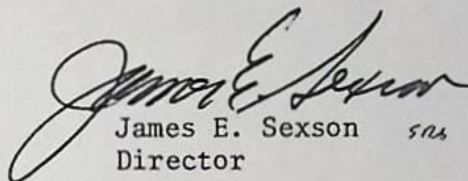
NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

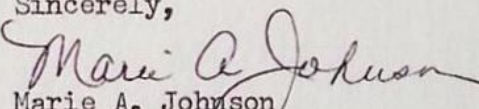

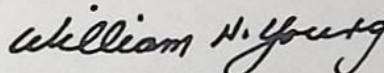

The order of the Water Resources Director entered January 28, 1980, in Volume 32, pages 680 and 681, approving Transfer 4302, did not include a change in place of use of the supplemental right under Permit 33883.

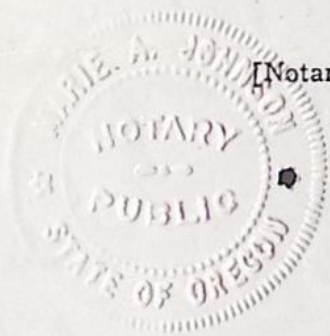

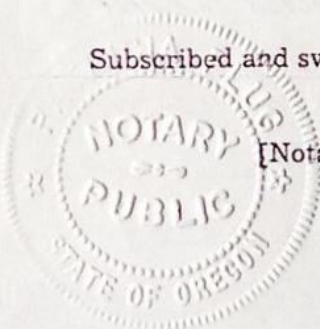
