





ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4321

On October 31, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Daniel James Jessee for approval of a change in use heretofore made of water from Wonder Mountain Gulch, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 20253, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of R. Glenn & Pearl E. Rees, describes a right established under the terms of permit No. 15375 for the use of water from Wonder Mountain Gulch for irrigation of a certain 8.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 37 South, Range 7 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 31, 1942.

It is noted that said certificate contains a clerical error in that it describes the quantity of water appropriated for said lands as 0.01 cubic foot per second. The correct quantity as established in the taking of proof of performance under said permit, is 0.10 cubic foot per second.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 60 feet South and 400 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 15, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 37 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

The applicant herein proposes to sever the right from 0.5 acre of said 8.0 acres and, without loss of priority, to change the use heretofore made from irrigation to domestic use, during the irrigation season only, within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of said Section 10.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Daily Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of November 19 and 26 and December 3, 1979.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in use of water, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in use of water is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 20253, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

In processing permit number 15375 toward issuance of a certificate a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the rate of application to 0.01 cubic foot per second instead of 0.1 c.f.s. which should have been permitted by applying the rate of one-eightieth c.f.s. per acre to the 8 acres allowed in the proof. It should also be noted that Tom Pierce the Watermaster at that time upon an inspection approved 8 acres and 0.1 c.f.s. in his recommendation. It was further noted on the approval that the point of diversion was 60 feet South and 400 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 15. This was shown on the blue line map which accompanied the signed proof and also delineated the location of the 8 acres. The proof was received by this office November 9, 1953, and certificate 20253 was issued February 26, 1954.

They are presently awaiting two transfers numbers 4321 and 4303 orders to allow changes in points of diversion involving the subject right. Evidently there are three other potential POD transfers to be forth coming involving this water right and therefore wording of the transfers should allow the appropriate amount of water for each under the change orders along with allowing the appropriate amount under a remaining right if any lands are left in tact.

WATER RESOURCES DEPT SUBJECT: Correction of Certificate #20253, Transfers 4321 and 4303

In accordance with the Watermaster's Manual 3.32 (3) I submit the following:

It appears the amount of water allowed at the time proof of certificate #20253 was made was in error--.01 being allowed for 8 acres rather than .1.

There are presently five property owners. During the last of October or the first of November, 1979 one of the present owners, Daniel J. Jessee, made a transfer of a ½ acre portion of this right. He changed the character of use to domestic including $\frac{1}{2}$ acre of irrigation. This appears to me to be an enlargement of this right and should not be allowed unless more of the original right is sacrificed. On October 12, 1979 Michael Larson, Transfer #4303, asked for a change of use of 1.05 acres of the original 8 acres to domestic including ½ acre of irrigation.

It appears to me that a correction of the certificate is necessary because we have less than I gpm for each of the five property owners if divided evenly. I would appreciate your concurrence before I proceed to spend the time necessary in contacting and explaining this to the people involved.
