



Guthrie of Portland, Oregon, was duly appointed Receiver of the Oregon-Washington Joint Stock Land Bank of Portland, by order of the Farm Credit Administration acting by and through the Land Bank Commissioner under and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 29 of the Federal Farm Loan Act (U.S. Code, Title 12, Section 963), and said Geo. B. Guthrie duly qualified as such Receiver on said date, and has been, and now is, duly qualified and acting as such Receiver; and

WHEREAS prior to the appointment of said Geo. B. Guthrie as Receiver of said Oregon-Washington Joint Stock Land Bank of Portland, the said bank entered into a written agreement to sell and convey the real property hereinafter described to said Ernest D. Elrod and May E. Elrod, the Grantees herein named, said agreement being dated January 1, 1933; and whereas the said Ernest D. Elrod and May E. Elrod have fully performed all of the terms and conditions of said agreement and are now entitled to a conveyance of all the right, title and interest of said bank and of said Geo. B. On November 19, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Ernest M. and Frances R. Rawlins for approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered September 30, 1958, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the use of the waters of Deschutes River and Its Tributaries, a water right was allowed in the name of Central Oregon Irrigation District for the use of the waters of Deschutes River for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 2.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 14 South, Range 13 East, W.M., being tabulated in the name of E. E. Elrod at Volume 16, page 88, with dates of priority of October 31, 1900 and December 2, 1907, as evidenced by certificate recorded at page 29052, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands also have a supplemental right under permit No. 23256 to the use of water stored in Crane Prairie Reservoir with a date of priority of February 28, 1913. These lands are irrigated by means of the Pilot Butte Canal.

The applicants herein, contract purchasers of the lands above described, propose to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to a certain other 2.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 25.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Central Oregon Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use at a regular meeting held August 14, 1979.

Mr. Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should


be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Central Oregon Irrigation District confirming this and prior changes within the District.




