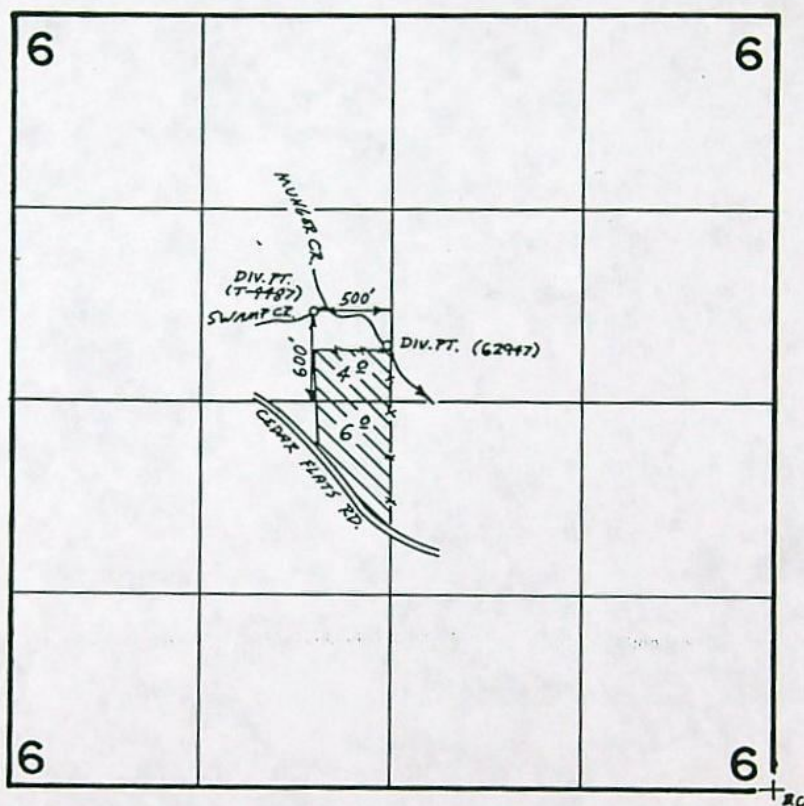

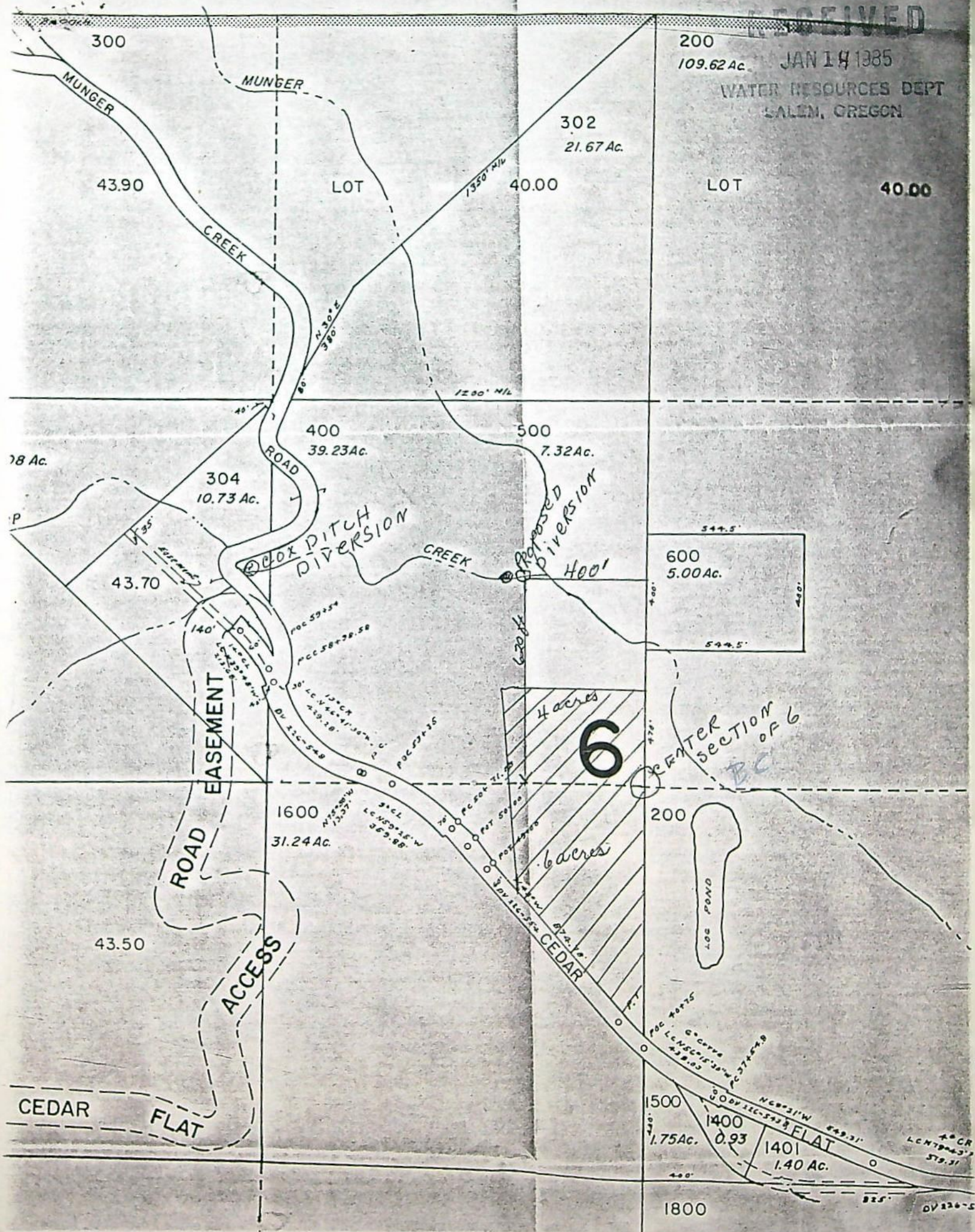

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4487

On April 25, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Mrs. Henry R. Hart (Pearl) for approval of a change in point of diversion from Swamp Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 16360, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Edward Cox, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second from Swamp Creek for irrigation of a certain 4.0 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and 6.0 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 6, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1890.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Cox Ditch, from a point in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 6, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion, without loss of priority, to a point located 620 feet North and 400 feet West from the Center of Section 6, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 6, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

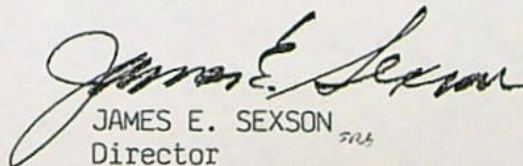
That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 16360, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

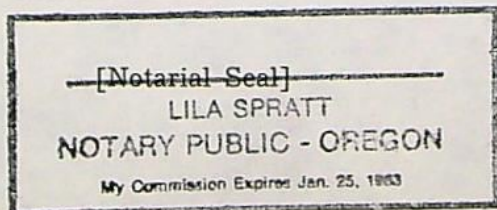

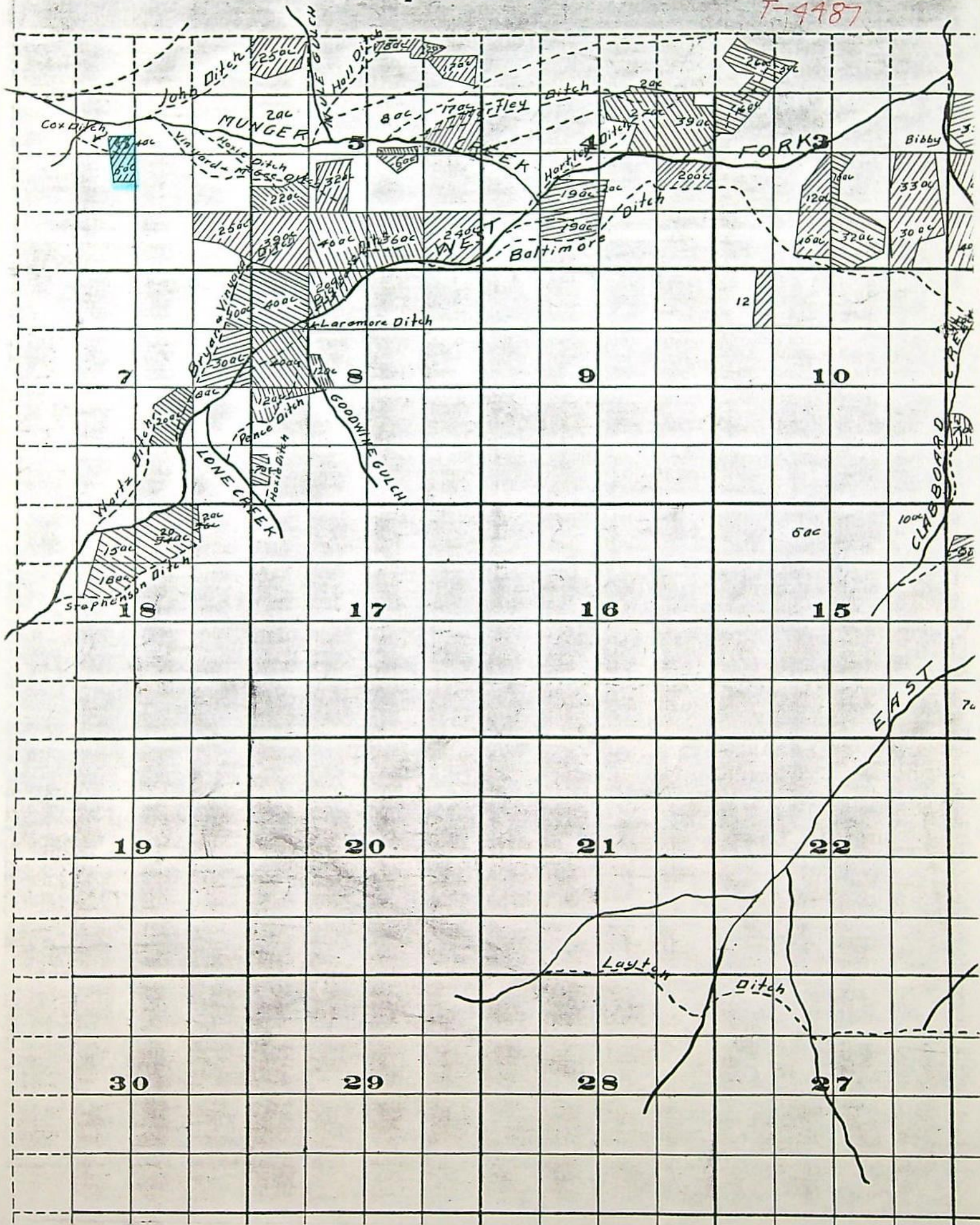
