The Department has been reviewing the Claim of Beneficial Use (Claim) report and map for the above referenced transfer application. The Department issued a transfer final order on December 10, 2008 for T-10394. A copy of the transfer final order and transfer application map are attached.

The Department has discovered that there are deficiencies in the Claim. In order for the Department to complete the review of the Claim, the following issue must be resolved:

The map shows that a total of 212.0 acres were irrigated; however, the transfer final order only authorized irrigation of 211.3 acres. As noted in the transfer final order, the Department determined that proof to the satisfaction of the Director for Permit G-13078 was made based on a Claim map received October 5, 1998, referenced in Special Order Volume 56, Page 800; the Claim map shows irrigation of 211.3 acres. A copy of the October 5, 1998 map and a copy of Special Order Volume 56, Page 800 are attached. Please provide a revised map identifying the location of the authorized place of use limited to no more than 211.3 acres total. Please provide the number of acres per quarter-quarter section on the revised map.

The map failed to provide sufficient information for the Department to determine the extent of beneficial use developed within the conditions or limits of the transfer final order.

Please submit the requested information by April 29, 2014, or the Department may begin the process to cancel transfer T-10394.

- 6. Notice of the application for transfer was published on June 5, 2007, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 7. On September 17, 2008, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10394 to the applicant. The cover letter draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline of September 30, 2008, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 8. On October 29, 2008, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10394 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on November 11, 2008 pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

## Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 9. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 10. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application T-10394.
- 11. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 12. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

#### Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10394 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380.

## Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10394 is approved.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Permit G-13078 and any related decree.
- 3. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 4. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 5. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2010**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 6. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

Carrie informed me that the T-10394 transfer application was accepted even though it appears to be a "proof needed" right because it does not have a certificate.

The water users submitted their COBU for Permit G-13078, and on September 17, 2001 Steve Brown acknowledged receipt of the COBU, but indicated it would be reviewed later. Then, August 5, 2002 Bernie Williams issued a memo that "proof to the satisfaction" was made, but there is no documentation of that determination by the certificate section.
