
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



A pressure of 25 psi was obtained at the highest elevation sprinkler faucet. The sprinklers are a mixture of household garden sprinklers, no two alike. The permittee sets each sprinkler by hand using varying amounts of 5/8-inch diameter garden hose. The CWRE made measurements and landed on an average of 3/16-inch diameter, but such measurements were mostly estimates because the diameters varied and were difficult to determine (none of the sprinklers were "Rainbird" or such as might be used by a farmer in production of a crop for market).

This draft is intended to provide you with an opportunity to comment on our findings and conclusions should you wish to do so. Please review the draft carefully to evaluate whether the document is consistent with your intent in seeking the transfer, and whether you agree with the proposed action.

At this time, you must submit a report of ownership and lien information prepared within the last three months by a title company. If there are additional lienholders identified in the report that have not previously been notified of the transfer, you must send notice of the transfer to them, and submit copies of each such notice to the Department to document that each lienholder has been informed of the transfer.

Issuance of the Preliminary Determination will occur shortly after we receive both your written response and the report of ownership and lien information. If we do not receive your response and the report by October 26, 2007, a Preliminary Determination may be issued denying the application as incomplete.

4. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 14, 2007, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 5. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 6. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application T-10441.
- 7. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 8. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Determination and Proposed Action

The change in place of use proposed in application T-10441 appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If application T-10441 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The change in place of use proposed in application T-10441 is approved.
- 2. Water Right Certificate 33886 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of the right not affected by this transfer.

- 5. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 2009. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 6. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.
