Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-0100(14), 690-380-4010(2) and 690-380-2200]

- 13. Water has been used within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14065 according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 14. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14065.
- 15. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
- 16. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the rights.

Conclusions of Law

Protests
