SUBJECT:

This transfer application is to change the location of the re-diversion point from North Powder River, through the Blumen-Zilkey ditch.

The waters of Dutch Flat Creek are diverted to the channel of the North Powder River through an unnamed ditch. Thereafter the rediversion point was from the North Powder River, by means of the Dutch Flat Creek Ditch.

Under Transfer No. U-5, the change in the re-diversion point was approved January 24, 1940, by State Engineer's Special Order, Volume 3, Page 413, for conveying the water through the Bulger ditch for irrigation of, among other lands, 17.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 17 and 10.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 20, Township 7 South, Range 38 East, W.M., with a priority of July 1, 1910.

Perhaps we should question the existence of the ditch which was used to convey water from Dutch Flat Creek to the North Powder River.

Mr. Swann has not submitted a map showing the lands to be irrigated from this proposed diversion point, nor has he submitted a map indicating the present and proposed points of diversion, as was requested in our letter dated December 18, 1967.
