Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to temporarily transfer the place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the temporary place of use, the point of diversion authorized under an existing water right.

Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On May 23, 2025, Farmland Reserve, Inc., filed an application to temporarily change the places of use and to add additional points of diversion to serve the proposed places of used under Certificates 36427, 37470, 39185, 44888, 47648, 57711, and 58749 for a period of 3 years. The Department assigned the application number T-14659.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on June 3, 2025, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. On July 16, 2025, the Department met with the applicant's agent regarding deficiencies in the application, specifically the potential for injury of another right if approved as proposed.
4. On July 18, 2025, the applicant's agent provided amended pages and maps satisfying the deficiency and allowing Temporary Transfer Application T-14659 to be approved.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Temporary Transfer Review Criteria

26. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
27. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
28. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
29. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(5) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

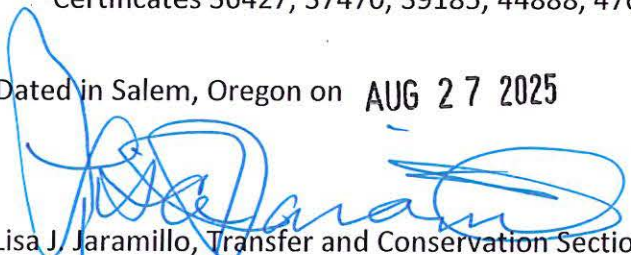
The temporary changes in places of use and additional points of diversion to convey water to the temporary places of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14659 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The temporary changes in places of use and additional points of diversion to convey water to the temporary places of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14659 are approved.
2. The former place of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2025, 2026, and 2027, irrigation seasons.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized places of use at the end of the 2027 irrigation season. The authorization to use the additional points of diversion shall be terminated concurrently.
4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.
5. The quantity of water diverted under Certificate 36427 at the proposed temporary point of diversion (POD 3) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 2).
6. The quantity of water diverted under Certificate 37470 at the proposed temporary point of diversion (POD 3) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 2).
7. The quantity of water diverted under Certificate 39185 at the proposed temporary point of diversion (POD 4) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 2 and POD 3).

8. The quantity of water diverted under Certificate 44888 at the proposed temporary point of diversion (POD 3 and POD 4) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 2).
9. The quantity of water diverted under Certificate 47648 at the proposed temporary point of diversion (POD 2 and POD 3) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 1).
10. The quantity of water diverted under Certificate 57711 at the proposed temporary point of diversion (POD 3) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 2).
11. The quantity of water diverted under Certificate 58749 at the proposed temporary point of diversion (POD 1 and POD 3) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 2 and POD 1B).
12. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificates 36427, 37470, 39185, 44888, 47648, 57711, and 58749 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
13. The use of water at the temporary places of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 36427, 37470, 39185, 44888, 47648, 57711, and 58749.
14. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
15. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 36427, 37470, 39185, 44888, 47648, 57711, and 58749 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 36427, 37470, 39185, 44888, 47648, 57711, and 58749.

((CONDITION FOR TEMPORARY APOD)) The quantity of water diverted at the proposed temporary additional point(s) of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point(s) of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point(s) of diversion.

Since there are multiple water rights involved, each certificate will need its own separate above condition to prevent enlargement.

Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to temporarily transfer the place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the temporary place of use, the point of diversion authorized under an existing water right.

Temporary Transfer Review Criteria

24. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
25. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
26. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
27. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(5) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary changes in places of use and additional points of diversion to convey water to the temporary places of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14659 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The temporary changes in places of use and additional points of diversion to convey water to the temporary places of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14659 are approved.
2. The former place of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2025, 2026, and 2027, irrigation seasons.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2027 irrigation season. The authorization to use the additional point of diversion shall be terminated concurrently.
4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.
5. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificates 36427, 37470, 39185, 44888, 47648, 57711, and 58749 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
6. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 36427, 39185, 47648, 57711 and 58749.
7. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
8. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 36427, 39185, 47648, 57711 and 58749 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 36427, 39185, 47648, 57711 and 58749.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not **temporarily** use water at the new place of use or from the new point of diversion until a final order approving the temporary transfer application has been issued by the Department. Additionally, pursuant to OAR 690-380-8010, the lands from which an irrigation water right is to be temporarily transferred and the land to which the right is to be temporarily transferred may not both receive water during the same season. If the temporary transfer is approved during an irrigation season and water has already been used at the currently authorized location during that season, then the temporary transfer will not take effect until the following season.
