- Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 8, 2013, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- There is any underlying permit S-29882 within the proposed place of use. The place of use and type of use of this permit will be clarified when the claim of beneficial use is submitted, resolving any conflicts with T-11669.
- 4. The proposed place of use is within Vale and Warm Springs Irrigation District boundaries. Vale Irrigation District requested a condition that the new proposed place of use under C-7049 (1884 priority date) be subordinate to the priority dates for the district rights under C-74080 (January 11, 1927 priority date) and C-74081 (November 29, 1945 priority date). If the place of use changes in the future it will retain its original priority status and will be reevaluated if necessary. The applicant consented to this condition.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of notice of this preliminary determination.

- 13. The applicant also proposes to diminish a portion of the transferred right to supplemental irrigation which is identified in the table above.
- 14. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife has determined that the diversion is not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screen, but a fish screen may be required in the future at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 15. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 7049 and any related decree.
- 3. The new proposed place of use under Certificate 7049 (1884 priority date) shall be subordinate to the priority dates for the district rights under Certificates 74080 (January 11, 1927) and 74081 (November 29, 1945). If the place of use changes in the future it will retain its original priority status and will be re-evaluated if necessary.
- 4. Water right Certificate 7049 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of the right not affected by this transfer.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
- 6. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each new point of diversion.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 7. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) may require the water user to install an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion within one year after receiving written notification that a fish screen is required. The only reason I ask is because Ron thought because the 44 acres have district water from WSID, and they have live flow rights from Bully Creek, irrigation use under 7049 may not be considered forfeited due to non-use; the water right has continued to be exercised by means of the WDID system. However, as you pointed out, the source is/was Harris Ditch, not Bully Creek. Also, WSID may not be as cooperative as VOID. I know you want to clean up Department pou records for the 65 acres, but I'm not sure what you recommend for the remaining 44 acres? Leave be or include?

Is Form D required for VOID? For WSID?

Which box should Galen check under Item 2 of the Evidence of Use Affidavit? I guess it depends on your recommendation for guestion 1 above.

Which pod should we show as the current/authorized pod now that Harris Ditch is gone? Is the blue dot on Bully Creek acceptable?

I calculated our filing fee at \$830. Please let me know if this is correct.

If we do not change the 44 acres in WSID, do we need to list them on page 5?

On page 5, I listed Malheur County Planning and Zoning as a local government. Is this sufficient?

On page 7, I described the current water delivery system as follows: "The original Harris Ditch diversion system changed when VOID was formed. Water under this certificate is now exercised through the 196 VOID Canal." Is this an accurate statement? I will add more diversion detail after I talk to Galen.

Is there anything special you recommend I list under additional remarks on page 8?

Per the results of your overlap analysis, could you please provide me with a list of other associated water rights requested on page 9?







Thanks for clarifying your email in our telephone conversation. As shown on map #2 below, during use of the temporary transfer, Greg's water right will be supplemental to Vale Canal water on the pink acres west of Bully Creek and primary on the remaining acres that we proposed for irrigation. We understand during short water years, that we cannot force Vale Oregon Irrigation Co. to allow Bully Creek water to flow by their diversion in order to fulfill Greg's water right, however, Bully Creek water will still be available to the property through the District's diversion under their Bully Creek Reservoir Permit No. 29882. We understand that prior to approval of the permanent transfer, Vale Oregon Irrigation Co. plans to transfer their canal water off the pink acres because it is not, and has not been used on those acres. 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

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

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

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change. A review form will also be sent to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to determine if a fish screen is needed.

Your application will be examined to determine whether additional information is needed. We will notify you if further information or corrections to the application or map are required.

This application <u>may</u> require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not use water in the new place of use or from the new point of diversion until a final order approving the transfer application has been issued by the Department.

In order to avoid any possible forfeiture of the water right, you should continue to use the water as described by your existing water right.

If the land is sold before the application is approved, the buyer's consent to the application will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the water right was not conveyed in the sale.
