The authorized well (Cook Well #4: UMAT 2514) and the proposed new well (Hale Farms Seible Well: UMAT 54154) are both within the same subarea (A) of the Stage Gulch Critical Ground Water Area and develop the same basalt ground-water source.





Conclusions of Law


The proposed TEMPORARY changes in application T-10424 satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.570.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The proposed changes to the water right evidenced by Certificate 79889 are approved.
- The temporary transfer is effective for the 2007 irrigation season.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 79889 and any related decree.

4. The use of water on the lands from which the water right is transferred and at the new temporary place of use during the same irrigation season or calendar year is prohibited and may subject the district and landowner to civil penalties.
5. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
6. The use of water under this temporary transfer may be conditioned or revoked at any time to the extent necessary to avoid injury if the Department finds the transfer causes injury to any existing water right.
7. At the end of the 2007 irrigation season all uses of water under this temporary transfer revert automatically to the terms and conditions of the original water right permit, certificate, or adjudication as evidenced by a court decree.
