

The 1.0 acre ON lands in the NWNE is layered with 1909 priority Trout Creek Decree rights. The OFF lands in Government Lot 1 (NWNW) is layered with C-61993 (1913 priority Trout Creek Decree rights), and 1909 Trout Creek Decree rights. The OFF lands in the NENW are layered with C-61993 (1913 priority Trout Creek Decree rights), and 1909 Trout Creek Decree rights. The OFF lands in NWNE is layered with C-61993 (1913 priority Trout Creek Decree rights), and 1909 Trout Creek Decree rights. The proposed changes to the place of use for the supplemental groundwater C-34027 moves to equal or more senior priority surface water rights, so no enlargement of C-34027 will occur as a result of the transfer. Note: The OWRD platcard and available mapping does not depict the water rights perfectly, we have included a paper copy of Certificate C-1430 that is missing from the platcard. We conducted a thorough analysis of all water rights in Section 31.




