1. Basic description of the changes proposed in this transfer: The authorized Point of Appropriation (POA) on Claim GR-630 is MARI 14343, a large hand dug well. The applicant proposes to replace the POA with one or two new wells (PROP 528 and 529 on map included below).
 2. Will the proposed POA develop the same aquifer (source) as the existing authorized POA?
 Yes No Comments: The existing POA is only 12 feet deep, and the two new POA are proposed to be drilled and cased to 150 feet below ground surface (bgs) with seals to 25 feet bgs. However, regional thickness mapping of the Willamette Silt and Willamette Aquifer layers indicate that the existing and proposed POAs will be in the same aquifer source, the Willamette Aquifer (>220' thick, see location map). The Willamette Silt layer is not present at the locations of the POA (Gannett and Caldwell, 1988, USGS PP1424-A).

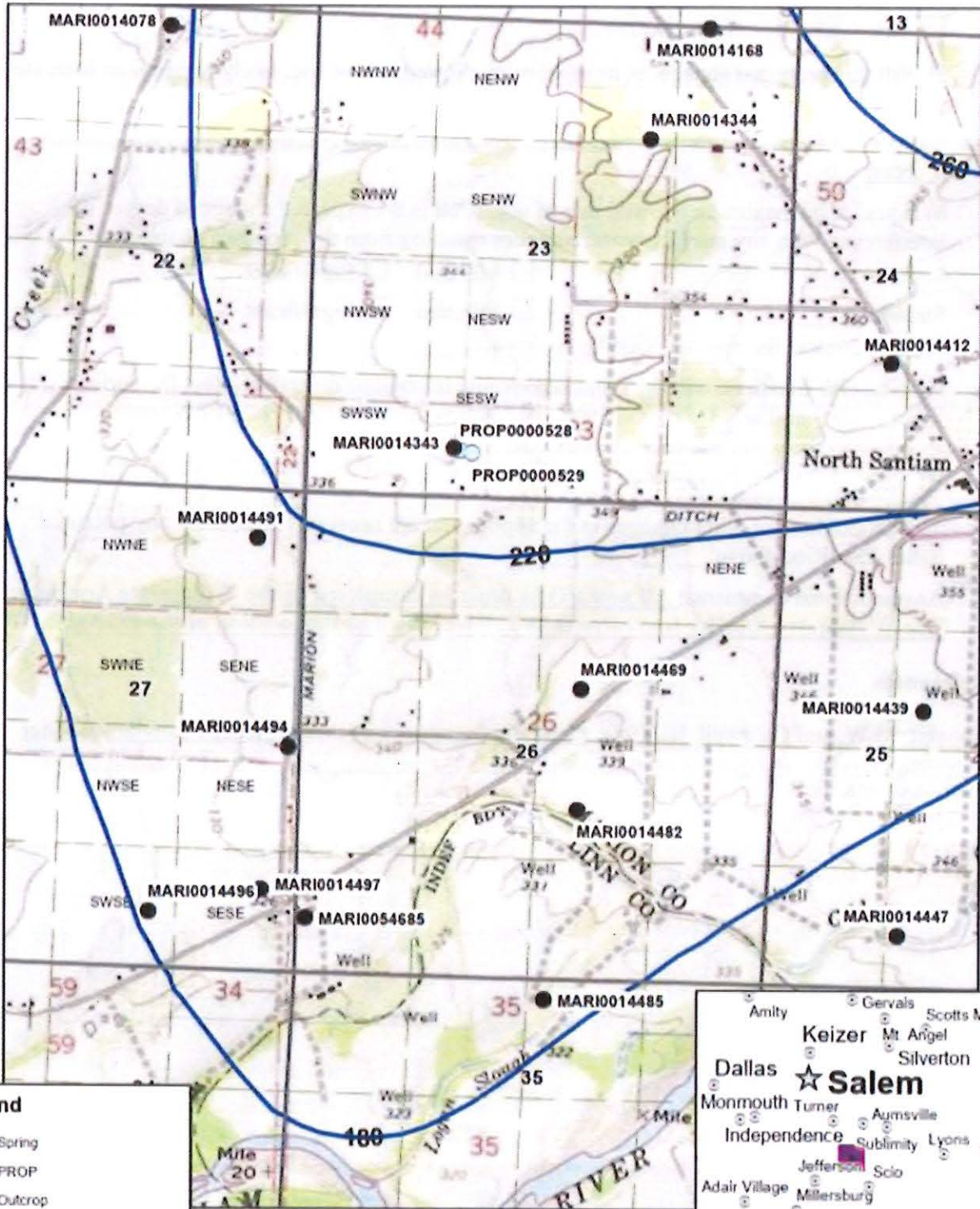

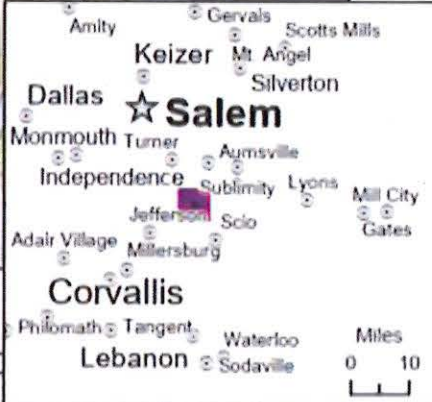
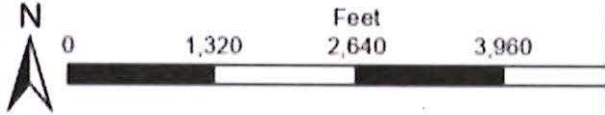

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change. A review form will also be sent to our groundwater staff to determine whether the proposed well accesses the same source of water as the original well.

This application may require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

You may not use water for from the new point of appropriation until a final order approving recognition of the groundwater registration modification application has been issued by the Department. If the land is sold before the modification is approved, the buyer's consent to the modification will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the groundwater registration was not conveyed in the sale.

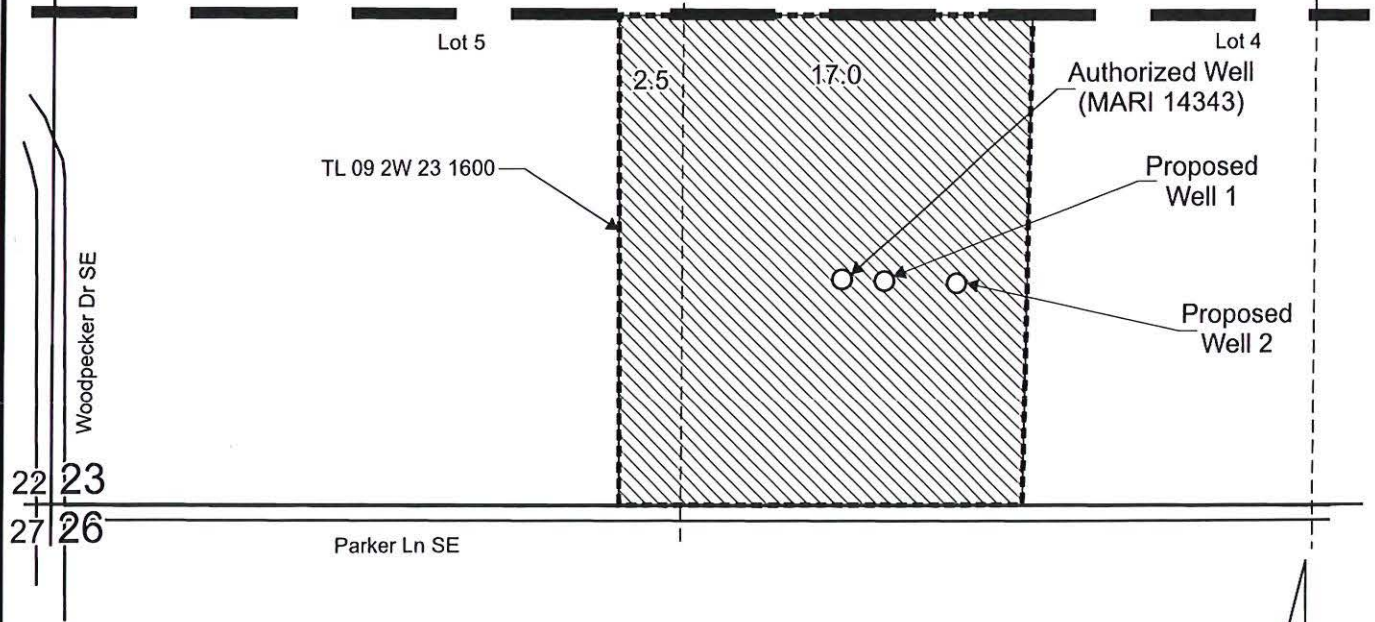

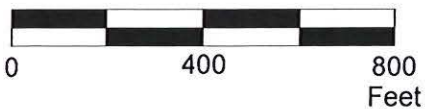
