Temporary Transfer Review Criteria

8. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
9. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
10. The proposed changes would prevent the lands from which the water right is removed during the period of the temporary transfer from receiving water under the transferred rights, as required by ORS 540.523(7).
11. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(5) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary changes in places of use and point of appropriation to serve the temporary place of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14555 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The temporary changes in places of use and change in point of appropriation to serve the temporary place of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14555 are approved.
2. The former place of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028, and 2029 irrigation seasons.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2029 irrigation season. The authorization to use the temporary point of appropriation shall be terminated concurrently.
4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.

5. The quantity of water diverted at the proposed temporary point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
6. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificates 48022 and 74458 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
7. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 48022 and 74458.
8. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
9. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
10. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 48022 and 74458 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 48022 and 74458.

The information provided in the application is insufficient to evaluate whether the proposed transfer may be approved because:

- The water well reports provided with the application do not correspond to the water rights affected by the transfer.
- The application does not include water well reports or a description of the well construction details sufficient to establish the ground water body developed or proposed to be developed.
- Other _____

1. Basic description of the changes proposed in this transfer: This temporary transfer is intended to serve as a "bridge" while permanent transfer T-14550 is under review by the Department. This application, T-14555, proposes slightly different changes than T-14550. Those changes are summarized below.

Temporary transfer T-14555 proposes the following:

- Transfer 130 acres of primary irrigation POU associated with Certificate 48022 to lands currently irrigated under Certificate 74458 while retaining Well #2 (KLAM 14789) as the authorized POA.
- Transfer 130 acres (1.625 cfs) of primary irrigation POU associated with Certificate 74458 to lands currently irrigated under Certificate 48022 and changing the POA for these transferred acres to Well #2 (KLAM 14789).

Permanent transfer T-14550 proposes the following:

- The applicant proposes to add an APOA Well #2(KLAM 14789) to Certificate 74458. No changes in POU are proposed. Well #2 (KLAM 14789) is an authorized POA on Certificate 48022 and located 1.7 miles to the south-southwest of Well #1 (KLAM 14754), the currently authorized POA on Certificate 74458.

The changes proposed under T-14550 will result in additional rate 1.625 and volume being pumped from Well #2 and less rate and volume pumped from Well #2.

Note: The application notes that the authorized POU on 74458 is KLAM 17754 and deepening log KLAM 54796. The well log number KLAM 17754 does not exist in the OWRD well log database. The correlated well log to the authorized POA is KLAM 14754 on GWIS and is the well log attached to the application. This review assumes that the correct authorized POA is KLAM 14754 and the well log noted for Well #1 on the application and map is a typo.

 Yes No Comments: Both the authorized and proposed POA source water from the predominantly volcanic units at depth. Both wells showed very similar water level elevations (within 5 feet) and trend prior to measurements at KLAM 14789 were ceased in 2013, see attached hydrograph.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not *temporarily* use water at the new place of use until a final order approving the temporary transfer application has been issued by the Department. Additionally, pursuant to OAR 690-380-8010, the lands from which an irrigation water right is to be temporarily transferred and the land to which the right is to be temporarily transferred may not both receive water during the same season. If the temporary transfer is approved during an irrigation season and water has already been used at the currently authorized location during that season, then the temporary transfer will not take effect until the following season.

If the land is sold before the temporary transfer is approved, the buyer's consent to the temporary transfer will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the water right was not conveyed in the sale.



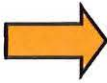

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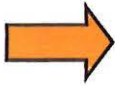
