The additional well shall be limited to 0.27 cfs and the well identified as E1-PA Well 1 shall be limited to 1.28 cfs.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recoding the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. The water user shall maintain and operate the measuring device as required by the department.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 23, 2009, at Special Order Volume 78, Page 958, approving Transfer Application T-10501, and together with Certificate 94898, supersedes Certificate 47725, State record of Water Right Certificates.

Background

1. On December 17, 2007, Kenneth and Tina Grassman filed an application to change the place of use and additional point of appropriation under Certificate 47725. The Department assigned the application number T-10501.

2. On April 10, 2008, an amended map and application were submitted to the Department.

3. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 47725 in the name of MELVIN D HALL; RAMONA HALL (perfected under Permit G-6583)

Use: IRRIGATION of 26.5 ACRES

Priority Date: OCTOBER 8, 1975

6. A well (See Finding of Fact #4) will be limited to 0.27 cfs and E1 PA Well 1 will be limited to 1.28 cfs.
7. Notice of the application for transfer was published on December 25, 2007, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
8. On April 3, 2009, the Department issued a draft Preliminary Determination. However, this document was not based on the amended application and map previous submitted to the Department (See Finding of Fact #2).
9. To rectify the error identified in Finding of Fact #8, the Department issued a revised draft Preliminary Determination on April 6, 2009. The revised draft Preliminary Determination proposed to approve Transfer Application T-10501 and a copy was mailed to the applicants. The cover letter that accompanied the revised draft Preliminary Determination set for a deadline of May 6, 2009, for the applicant to respond. The applicants requested that the

Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

10. On July 24, 2009, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10501 and mailed a copy to the applicants. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on July 28, 2009, and in the Lake County Examiner newspaper on August 5, 12 and 19, 2009, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
11. Temporary Transfer T-10546 affects the same place of use and additional point of appropriation as the proposal contained in Transfer Application T-10501. At the applicants' request, Temporary Transfer T-10546 (recorded in Special Order Volume 74 Pages 477 – 479) will be terminated upon issuance of the final order for Transfer Application T-10501.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

12. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
13. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application T-10501.
14. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
15. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

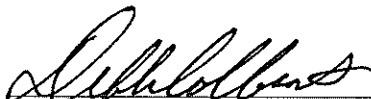
The changes in place of use and additional point of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-10501 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. Temporary Transfer T-10546 is terminated. The final order entered at Special Order Volume 74, pages 477-479 is of no further force or effect.
2. The changes in place of use and additional point of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-10501 are approved.
3. Water right certificate 47725 is cancelled.
4. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 47725 and any related decree.

5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
6. The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
7. The well identified in Finding of Fact #4 shall be limited to 0.27 cfs and the well identified as E1-PA Well 1 shall be limited to 1.28 cfs.
8. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
9. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. The water user shall maintain and operate the measuring device as required by the Department.
10. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2010**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
11. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

Because the new point of appropriation is more than ¼ mile from the authorized point of appropriation, the applicant is responsible for publishing notice of the transfer in a local newspaper having a general circulation in the area of the water right. The notice must be published at least once a week for three consecutive weeks. We will provide a copy of the required notice to you upon issuance of the Preliminary Determination.

Issuance of the Preliminary Determination will occur shortly after we receive both your written response and the report of ownership and lien information. If we do not receive your response and the report by May 4, 2009, a Preliminary Determination may be issued denying the application as incomplete.

Findings of Fact

Background

1. On December 17, 2007, Kenneth and Tina Grassman filed an application to change the place of use and additional point of appropriation under Certificate 47725. The Department assigned the application number T-10501.
2. On March 31, 2008, temporary transfer T-10546 was approved (Special Order Volume 74, pages 477-479). That temporary transfer covered the same place of use and point of appropriation described in this application and is in effect for five years, ending in 2012, or until terminated by order of the Department.
3. On April 1, 2009, received an email withdrawing temporary transfer 10546 when transfer 10520 is approved.
4. The right to be transferred is as follows:

3. A well would be limited to 0.27 cfs and E1 PA Well 1 would be limited to 1.28 cfs.
4. Before T-10501 can be approved, temporary transfer T-10546 must expire or be terminated by order of the Department.

5. Notice of the application for transfer was published on December 25, 2007, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

6. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
7. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application T-10501.
8. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
9. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Determination and Proposed Action

The changes in place of use and additional point of appropriation proposed in application T-10501 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If application T-10501 is approved, the final order will include the following:

1. *Temporary transfer T-10546 is terminated. The final order entered at Special Order Volume 74, pages 477-479 is of no further force or effect.*
2. *The changes in place of use and additional point of appropriation proposed in application T-10501 are approved.*
3. *Water right certificate 47725 is cancelled.*
4. *The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 47725 and any related decree.*
5. *Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.*
6. *The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.*
7. *The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.*

8. *Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. The water user shall maintain and operate the measuring device as required by the Department.*
9. *The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2010**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.*
10. *When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.*

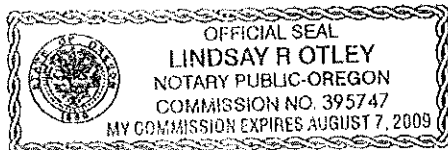

The applicant seeks a change in place of use and an additional point of appropriation to accommodate a change from wheel line irrigation to center pivot irrigation.

The existing well (LAKE 930) and the additional well (LAKE 4316) both develop the main ground water reservoir of the Fort Rock Basin. **The same source requirement is satisfied.**

The additional well is about ½ mile from an existing well and **should not cause injury** in this highly transmissive environment.

For what it's worth, my use of the WRD interactive mapping program is not confirming the existing water rights in section 5 that the application materials present.

5. On March 4, 2008 notice of the application for temporary transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to that notice
6. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. No evidence is available that would demonstrate the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
7. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
8. The proposed change will not result in enlargement of the right.
9. The proposed change will not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(6) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary changes in proposed in application T-10546 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

10. The changes in place of use and the additional point of appropriation proposed in application T-10546 are approved.
11. The former place of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2012 irrigation seasons.
12. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2012 irrigation season. The authorization to use the additional point of diversion shall be terminated concurrently.
13. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
14. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificate 47725 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
15. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 47725.
16. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
17. Prior to diverting of water at the new point of diversion, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department
18. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 47725 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 47725 and any related decree.

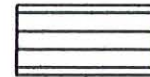
EXISTING CONFIGURATION OF WATER RIGHTS PER
