Findings of Fact

Background

1. On April 9, 2013, Jeff Zeeb filed a ground water registration modification application to modify the point of appropriation, place of use, and character of use under Registration Application GR-1455 (Certificate of Registration GR-1404). The Department assigned the application number T-11568.
2. On April 9, 2013, Registration Application GR-1455 (Certificate of Registration GR-1404) was assigned from Adrian A. Withers and Pearl F. Withers to Jeff Zeeb.
3. Notice of the application for ground water registration modification was published on April 23, 2013, pursuant to OAR 690-382-0600. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
4. The original application map had an error in the number of acres requested to be changed. A deficiency letter was sent to the applicant on July 11, 2013. On July 26, 2013, the Department received an amended map correcting the error.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

5. On August 21, 2013, the Department sent a copy of the Preliminary Determination to the applicant, proposing to deny Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-11568 because of potential enlargement of the registration. The Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of September 23, 2013, for the applicant to respond. The applicant's agent, on behalf of the applicant, revised the annual volume requested for transfer, which resolved the enlargement issue. The applicant's agent requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the Groundwater Registration Modification.
6. On September 11, 2013, the Department issued a preliminary determination proposing to approve Transfer application T-11568 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the preliminary determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on September 17, 2013, and in the Itemizer-Observer newspaper on September 18, and 25, 2013 pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Review Criteria for Ground Water Registration Modification Applications [OAR 690-382-0700(2)]

9. The application proposes to transfer 2.4 acre feet per acre for 8 acres (19.2 acre feet). This is proportional to what is allowed under the groundwater registration (90 acre feet per year for 37.91 acres.)
10. The proposed modifications would not result in enlargement of the ground water registration (OAR 690-382-0100(2)).
11. The proposed modifications would not result in a state Scenic Waterway not receiving previously available water during periods in which streamflows are less than the quantities determined by the Department to be necessary to meet the requirements of ORS 390.835.
12. The proposed modifications would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law


The modifications in point of appropriation, place of use, and character of use proposed in Ground Water Registration Modification application T-11568 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.610, 537.705, 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-382-1000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The modifications to Registration Application GR-1455 (Certificate of Registration GR-1404) proposed in Ground Water Registration Modification Application T-11568 are recognized. Recognition of the modifications shall not be construed as a final determination of the right to appropriate ground water under the certificate of registration or modification. Such a determination will occur in an adjudication proceeding under ORS 537.670 to 537.695.
2. The use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Registration Application GR-1455 (Certificate of Registration GR-1404) and any related decree.
3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
4. Water shall no longer be appropriated from the original point of appropriation as part of this modified portion of the ground water certificate of registration.
5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

6. Water shall no longer be appropriated for the former character of use as part of this portion of the ground water certificate of registration.
7. The former place of use of the modified portion of the ground water registration shall no longer receive water as part of the ground water certificate of registration.
8. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at the new point of appropriation.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Your water Ground Water Registration Modification is in one of three phases of processing. Enclosed is a draft of our Preliminary Determination regarding Ground Water Registration (GR) Modification Application T-11568. The document reflects the Department's conclusion that, based on the information currently available, the modification will be DENIED.

This draft is intended to provide you with an opportunity to comment on our findings and conclusions should you wish to do so, and to withdraw or modify your application to resolve the issues that are prompting our decision to deny the application.

1. The draft Preliminary Determination proposes to deny the groundwater modification because the annual duty requested of 20 acre feet for 8 acres exceeds the duty per acre when portioned out with the entire right. This produced the finding of enlargement of the right. The issues that we have identified could be resolved by one of the following alternatives:
 - a) Increase the number of acres to match the 20.0 acre feet (8.3 acres), or
 - b) Decrease the acre feet to match 8.0 acres (19.2 acre feet).
2. Please review the draft carefully to see if it accurately reflects the changes you intend to make, and to become familiar with all proposed conditions. **You will need to respond in writing** by the deadline provided below, whether you agree with the proposed action and conditions. Also we will appreciate having you let us know if there are typographical errors that need to be corrected.

If you resolve the reason for denial and wish to continue processing see the following:

Items needed before the next phase of processing...

3. A report of land ownership for the lands to which the Ground Water Registration is appurtenant (the FROM lands) is required. **The report must be prepared by a title company and meet the criteria below.** (Reports may be called by various names, such as Customer Service Report, Property Analysis Report (PAR), List Pack, Lot Book Report, etc.)
 - a) The title company's report must either be:
 - i) prepared within 3 months of the draft Preliminary Determination showing current ownership, or
 - ii) prepared within 3 months of recording of a water right conveyance agreement, or
 - iii) prepared at any time, but showing ownership at the time a water right conveyance agreement was recorded.
 - b) The ownership report shall include:
 - i) Date reflected by the ownership information
 - ii) List of owners at that time
 - iii) Legal description of the property where the water right to be modified is currently located.
 - c) You will need to submit a notarized statement of consent from any landowner listed in the ownership report who is not already included in the application, or other information such as a water right conveyance agreement, if applicable.

4. Notice of this GR Modification will need to be published in a local newspaper with general circulation in the area where the registrations are currently located. You will be responsible for the charges. Please indicate the local paper you prefer to publish in so we can get an accurate estimate of the cost.

Conditions to your GR registration modification...

The Watermaster has required a water measurement device at the new point of appropriation prior to appropriation of water. Enclosed is a contact information sheet to assist you in pursuing additional information or approval of the required (or alternate) device.

What happens next...

Once the Preliminary Determination is issued a publication period is required. Because there is more than ¼ mile between the new and the authorized point of appropriation and because of a change in character of use, the Department will publish notice of the modification in a local newspaper having a general circulation in the area of the water right at least once per week for two consecutive weeks. You are responsible for sending a check to cover the cost of publication prior to the issuance of the Preliminary Determination and publication of notice (see below).



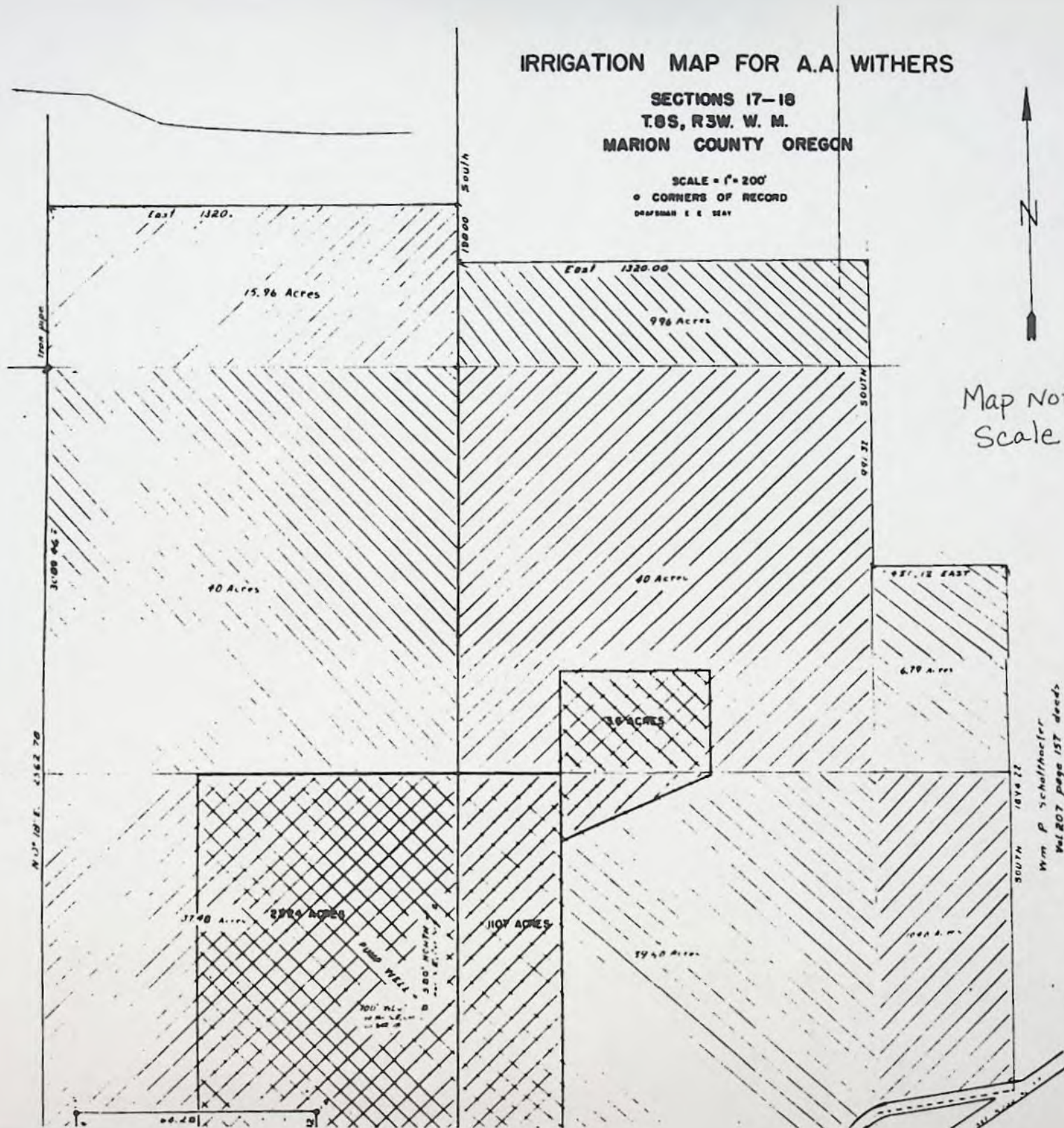
IRRIGATION MAP FOR A.A. WITHERS

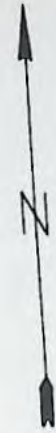

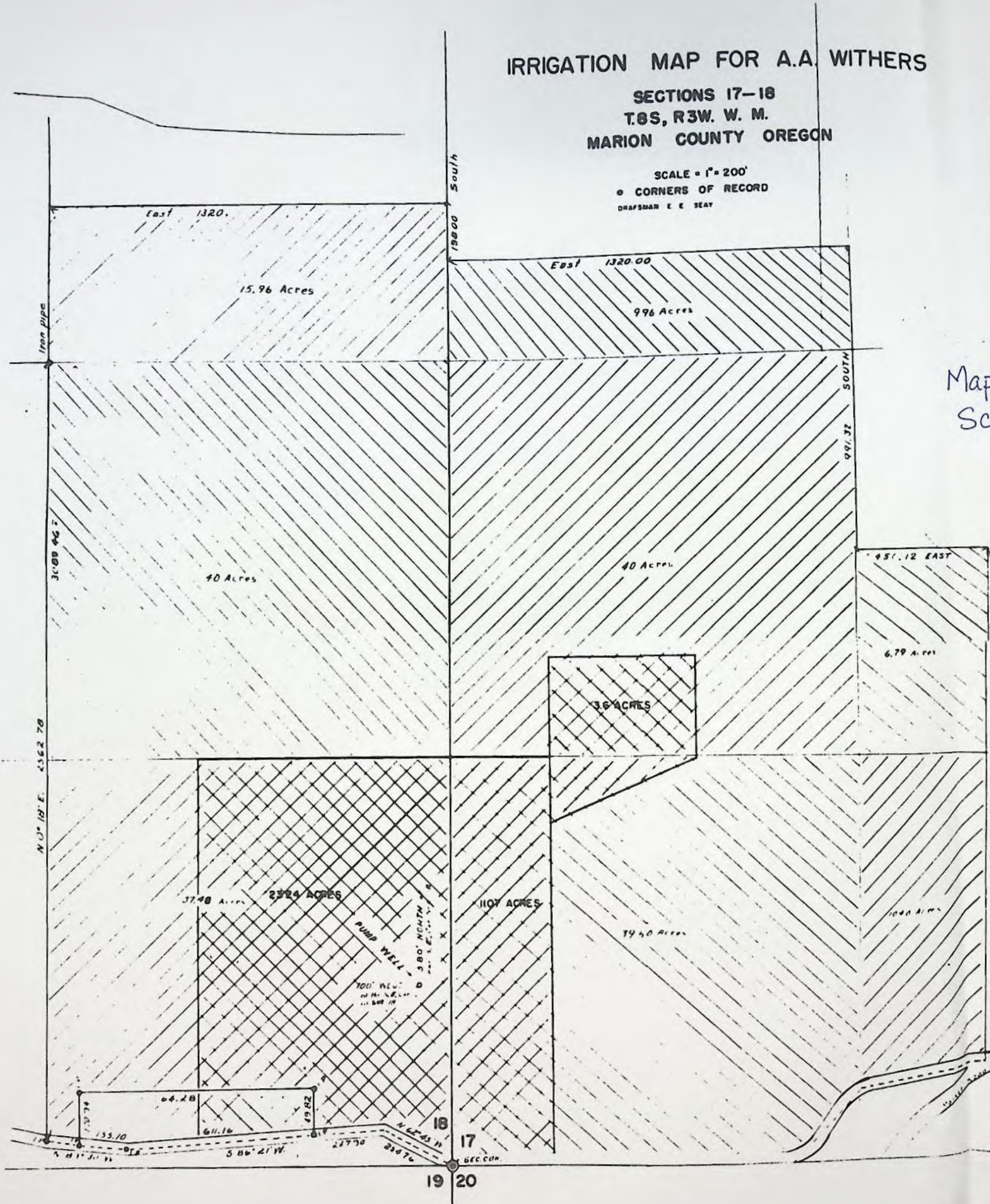
IRRIGATION MAP FOR A.A. WITHERS

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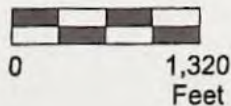
