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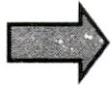

The ground that we are transferring has not been irrigated this year. We want to transfer the water right to ground in Klamath Drainage District for the purpose of irrigating crops. Klamath Drainage District has been given minimal amount of stored water from Upper Klamath Lake from the Bureau of Reclamation. The current allocation is 0.15 acre ft A/C, this reduction occurred May 22nd 2026. We intend to use this transfer to allow us to grow the crops we had planned for.

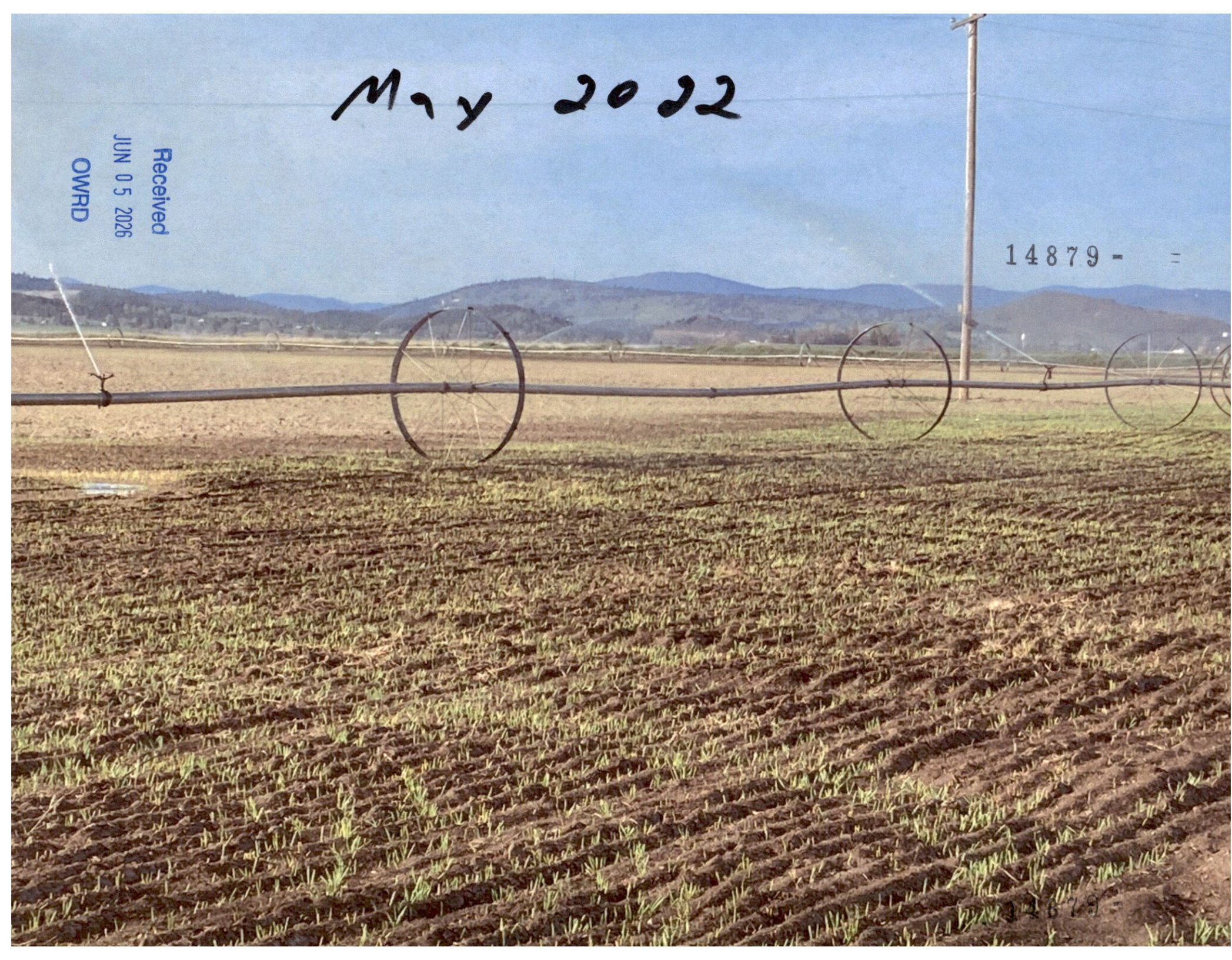
