<p><b>Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why:</b>  <b>Pine Grove Water District seeks to add a new point of appropriation and places of use (POU) to Certificate No. 65577. The District’s certificate allows the appropriation of 125 gallons per minute (gpm) from its existing Well 2. The District has seen a gradual decline in Well 2’s yield from an initial 89 gpm when it was constructed in 1989 to a current yield of less than 40 gpm. The current water level in Well 2 is near the pump intake level, which is set near the bottom of the well, leaving little option to sustain a yield sufficient to serve the District. The District is seeking to construct a new well (Well 3), with appropriation from the same aquifer source but with deeper construction and more operational flexibility than Well 2. The District also seeks to add POU once a more reliable water supply is secured to allow the annexing of adjacent properties into the water service area boundary. If you need additional space, continue on separate piece of paper and attach to application as “Attachment 1”.</b></p>

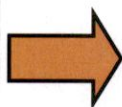
