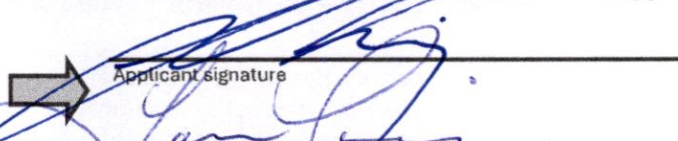
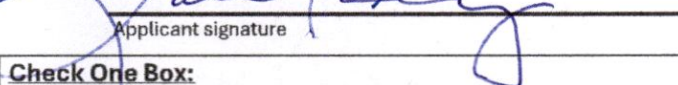

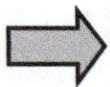

Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why:

This permanent transfer is related to a temporary transfer being submitted at the same time by the same Applicant. That temporary transfer proposes moving about 11 acres of irrigation under surface water rights to areas that currently include the groundwater rights in this permanent transfer application (Certs. 93672 and 93673). The overlapping acres are being moved in this transfer application to areas where they can be beneficially used by the Applicant for irrigation of crops, grass buffer strips, and animal pastures.

The Applicant understands that the groundwater rights included in this transfer application are regulated based on flow conditions in the Umatilla River, and that regulation typically takes affect by early June. The areas the Applicant is proposing to move acreage to are locations where the application of water in the early season will be beneficial, either to establish specific crops or buffer strips to protect other crops or provide dust control.

The source well has recently been refurbished (UMAT-56538/59424). The well likely has a capacity exceeding 1 cfs, so it can provide the total rate allowed under Cert. 93672 and 93673, which is 0.427 cfs (192 gpm). The well is plumbed into the main distribution system on site, which can carry water throughout the place of use. Portable irrigation systems can also be connected to risers.

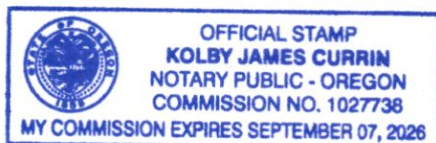

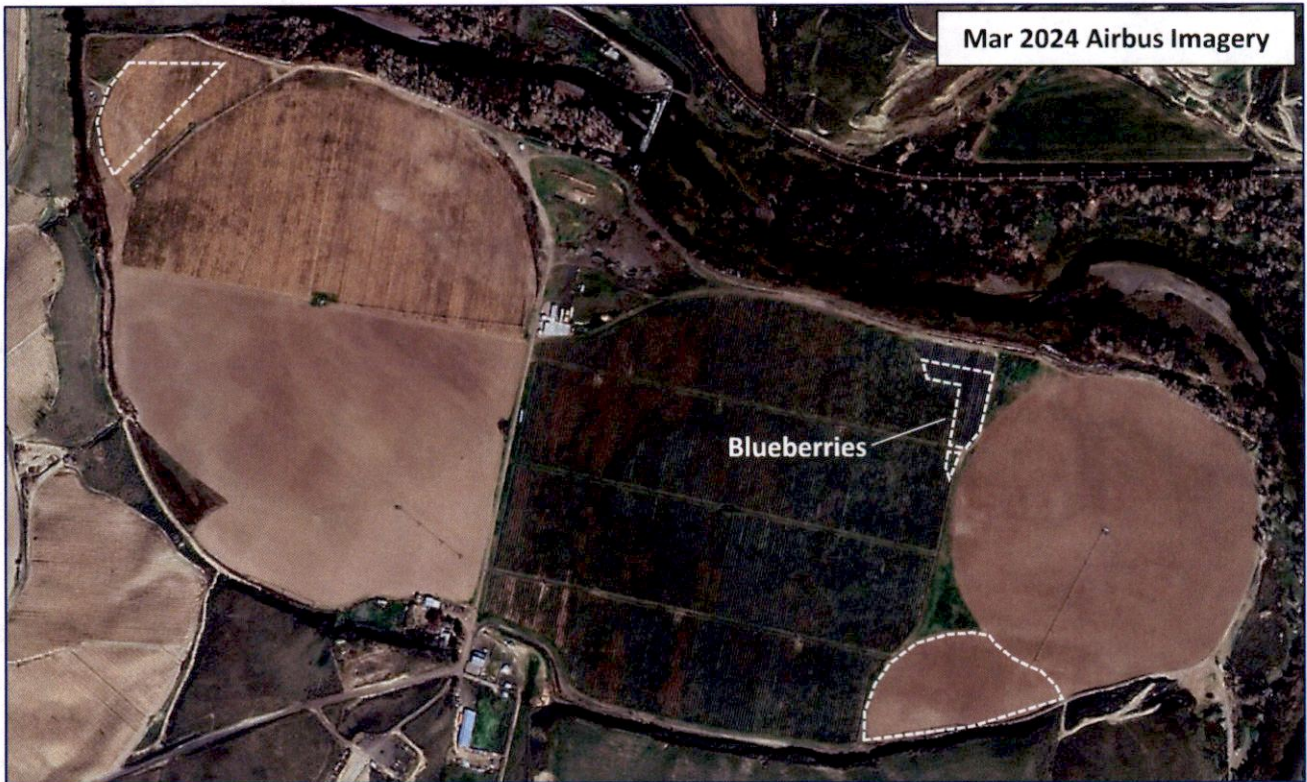
