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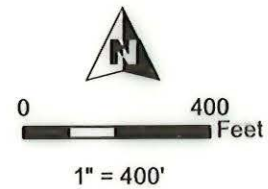

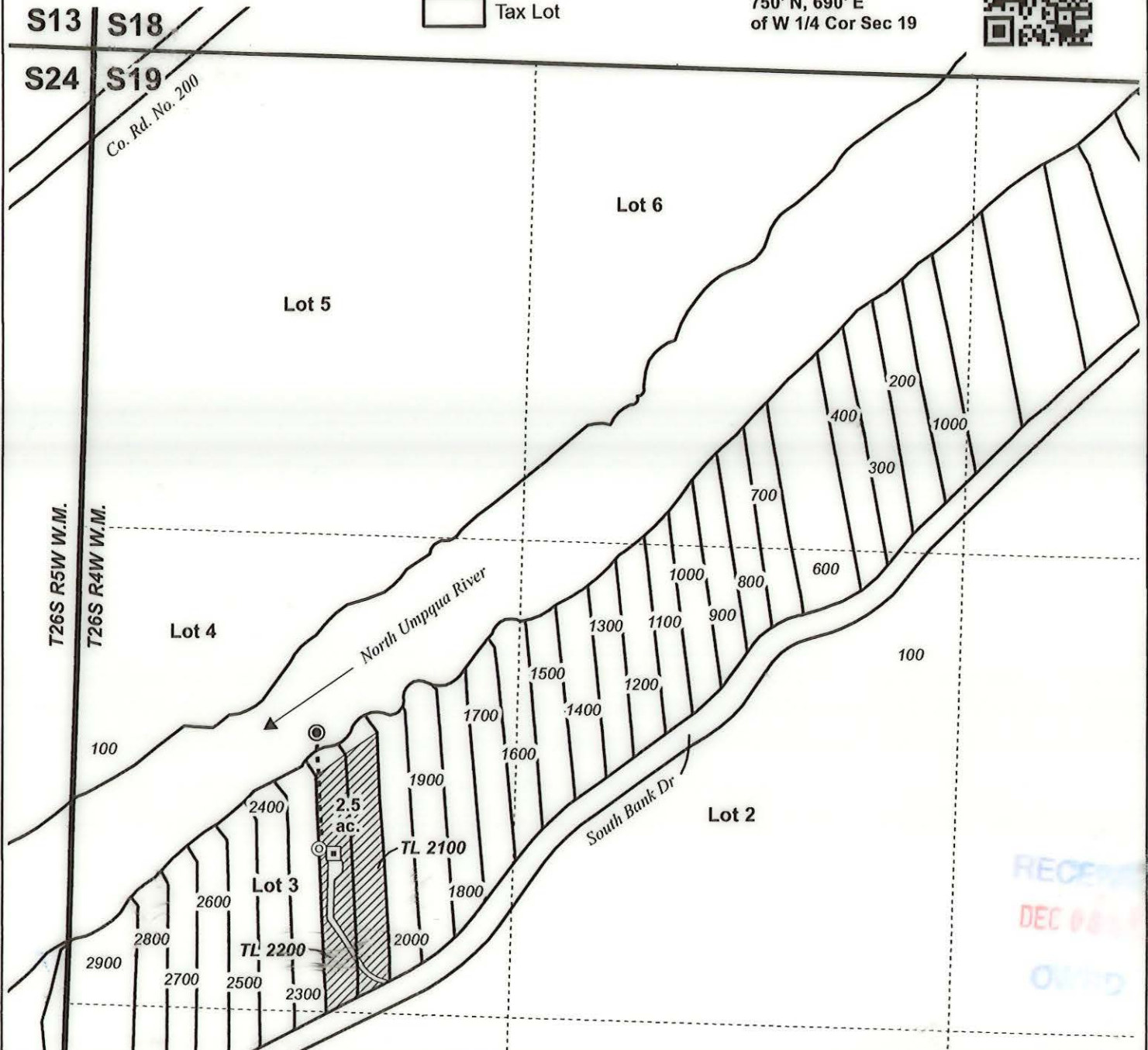

Findings of Fact

1. On September 15, 2020, STEPHEN AND EMMA JEAN PITTMAN filed an application to change the point of diversion under Certificate 54145. The Department assigned the application number T-13516.
2. LOUIS P. PARIS is the receiving landowner who will be responsible for completion of the changes.
3. Notice of the application for transfer was published on September 15, 2020, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
4. On February 1, 2021, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13516 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of March 5, 2021, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

5. On April 1, 2021, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13516 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on April 6, 2021, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
6. The right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 54145 in the name of BERT A. STIMSON (perfected under Permit S-37914)

Use: IRRIGATION of 2.5 ACRES and DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY

7. Transfer Application T-13516 proposes to move the authorized point of diversion approximately 175 feet downstream to:

8. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and/or safely transport fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted and that the diversion is not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screening and/or by-pass device. This diversion may be eligible for screening cost share funds.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

9. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
10. A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13516.
11. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
12. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
13. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The change in point of diversion proposed in Transfer Application T-13516 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

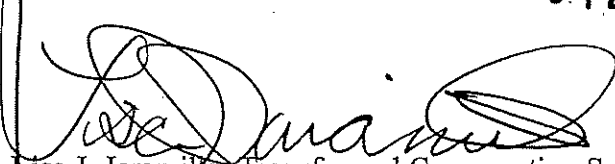
Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in point of diversion proposed in Transfer Application T-13516 is approved.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 54145 and any related decree.
3. Water right Certificate 54145 is cancelled.
4. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (POD 1), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
5. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.

- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
6. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) design and construction standards. Prior to installation, the water user shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screen and/or by-pass device meets ODFW's criteria. Prior to submitting a Claim of Beneficial Use, the water user must obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screening and/or by-pass device was installed to the state's criteria. The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.
7. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2022**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
8. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

1. On September 15, 2020, STEPHEN and EMMA JEAN PITTMAN filed an application to change the point of diversion under Certificate 54145. The Department assigned the application number T-13516.
2. LOUIS P. PARIS is the receiving landowner who will be responsible for completion of the changes.
3. Notice of the application for transfer was published on September 15, 2020, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
4. On February 1, 2021, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13516 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of March 5, 2021, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

6. Transfer Application T-13516 proposes to move the authorized point of diversion approximately 175 feet downstream to:

7. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and/or safely transport fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted and that the diversion is not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screening and/or by-pass device. This diversion may be eligible for screening cost share funds.

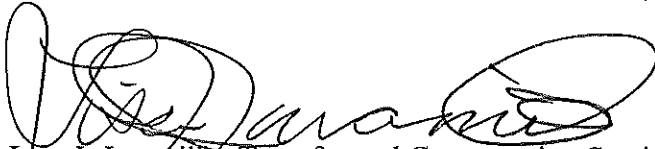
If Transfer Application T-13516 is approved, the final order will include the following:

1. *The change in point of diversion proposed in Transfer Application T-13516 is approved.*
2. *The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 54145 and any related decree.*
3. *Water right Certificate 54145 is cancelled.*
4. *The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (POD 1), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.*
5. *Water use measurement conditions:*
 - a. *Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.*
 - b. *The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.*
 - c. *The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.*
6. *Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) design and construction standards. Prior to installation, the water user shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screen and/or by-pass device meets ODFW's criteria. Prior to submitting a Claim of Beneficial Use, the water user must obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screening and/or by-pass device was installed to the state's criteria. The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.*

7. *Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2022**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.*
8. *After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.*

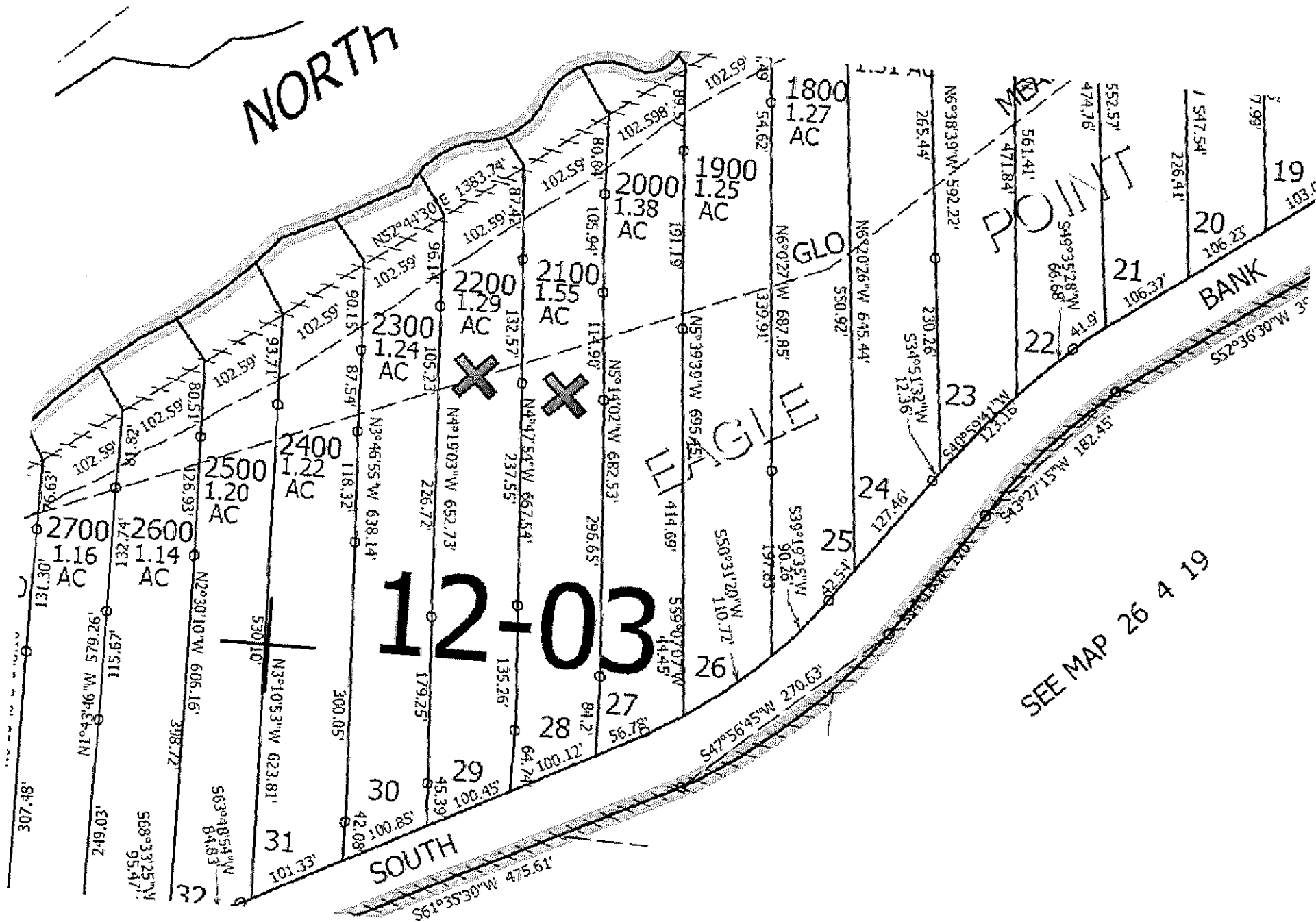

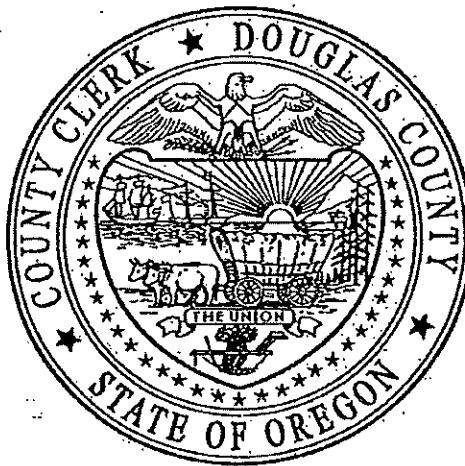

6. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and/or safely transport fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted and that the diversion is not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screening and/or by-pass device. This diversion may be eligible for screening cost share funds.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.*
- 7. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2022**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.*

8. *After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.*

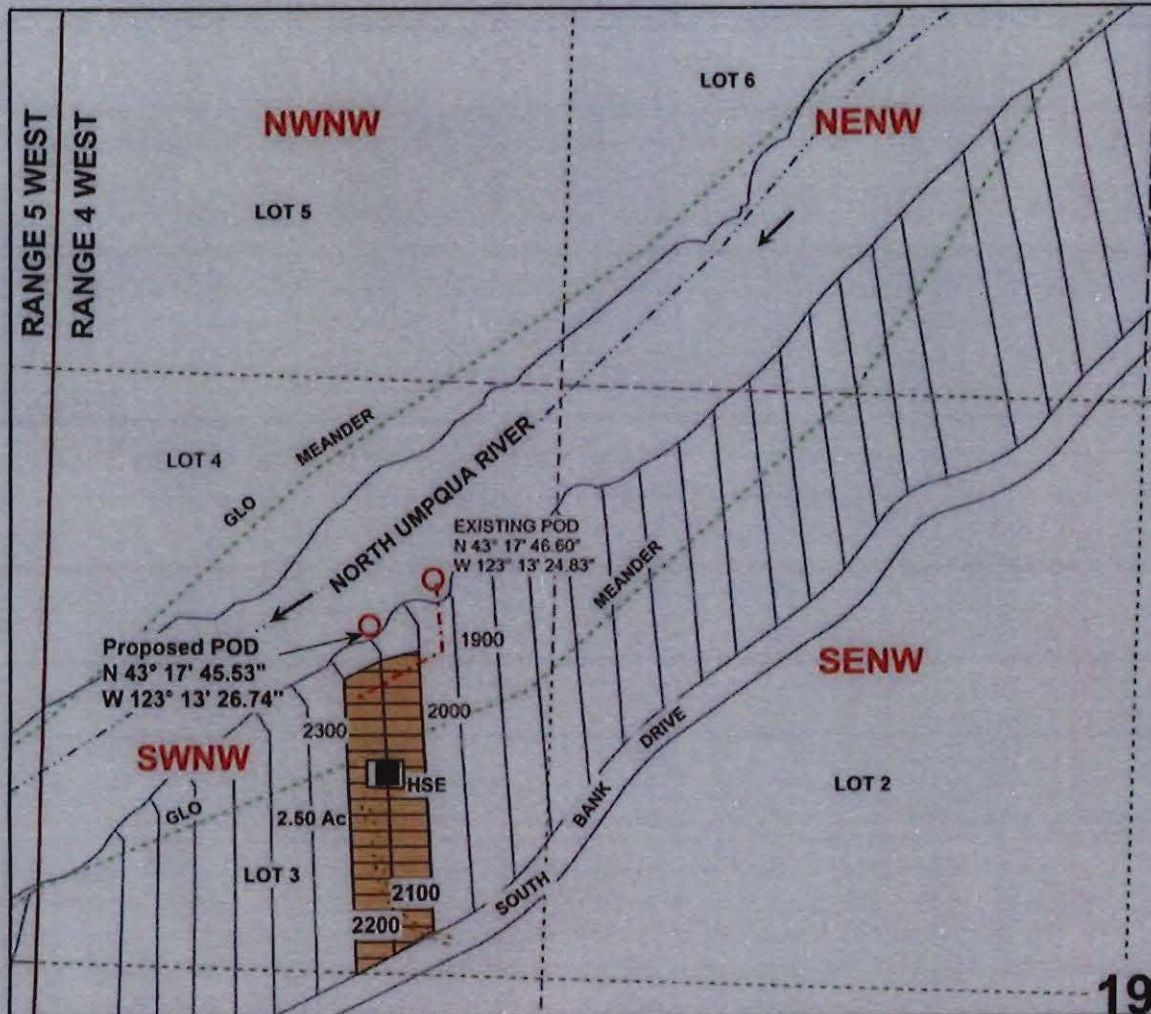

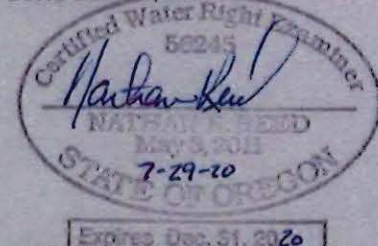

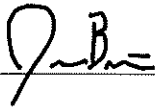

On September 15, 2020, we received your water right Transfer application. The application was accompanied by \$1160.00. Our receipt number 133441 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change. A review form will also be sent to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to determine if a fish screen is needed *or* to our groundwater staff to determine whether the proposed well accesses the same source of water as the original POD.

This application may require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not use water from the new point of diversion until a final order approving the transfer application has been issued by the Department. 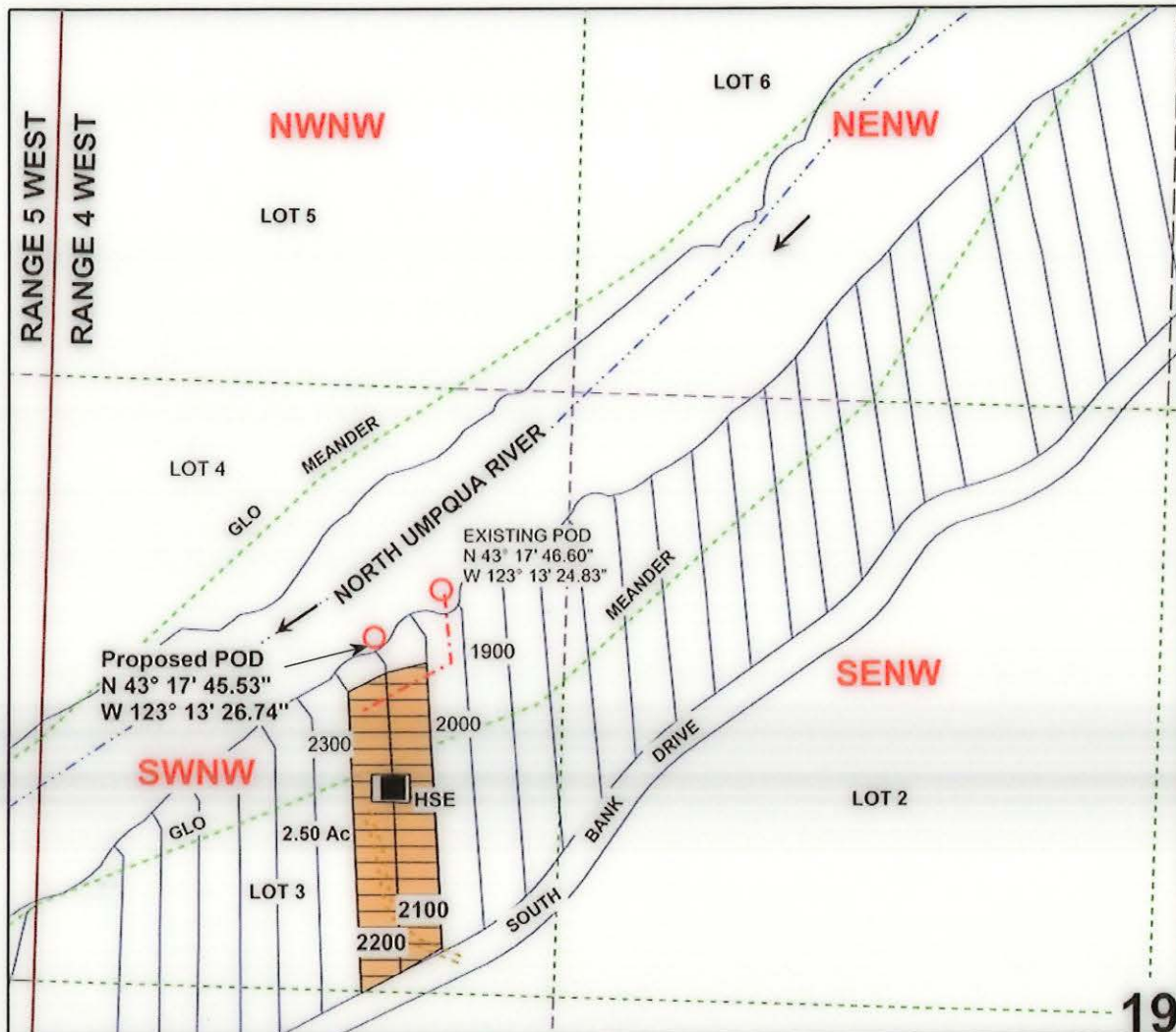
