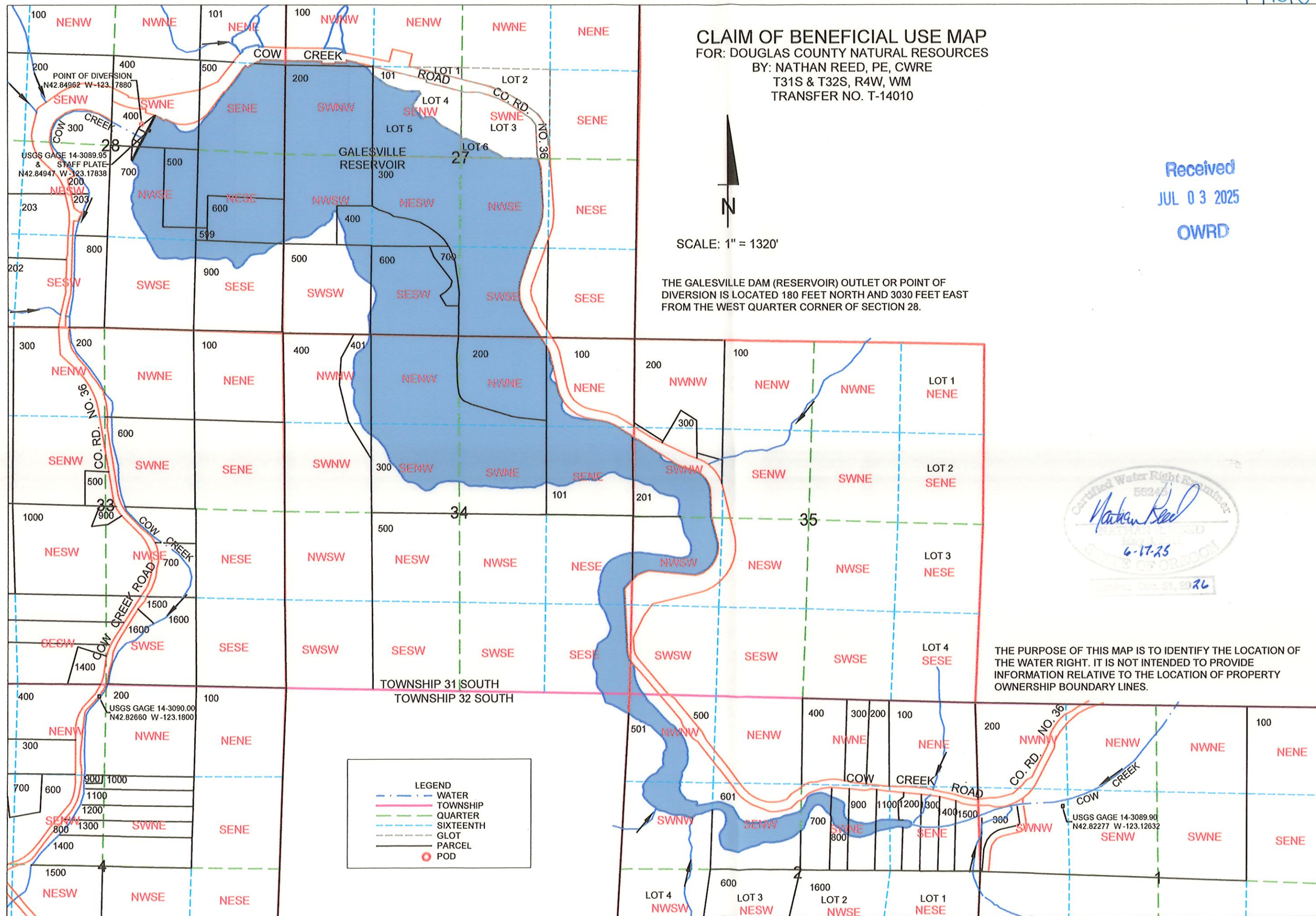

Summary

This Final Order on Reconsideration Approving a Change in Character of Use is issued to correct errors in the Final Order Approving a Change in Character of Use recorded in Special Volume 134, pages 933-937, and remaining right Certificate 98244.

Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes ("ORS") 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules ("OAR") Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provide the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications. ORS 183.482(1) and OAR 137-003-0675 govern reconsideration of final orders in contested cases.

Findings of Fact

1. On May 26, 2005, a Final Order Approving a Change in Character of Use under Transfer Application T-9543 was issued, recorded at Special Order Volume 64, Pages 553-556, involving the transfer of 4,000 AF under originating Certificate 75970. Certificate 75970 authorized the storage of 42,225 AF total, being 4,000 AF for fish enhancement, 4,450 AF for municipal use, 2,400 AF for industrial use, 14,951 AF for irrigation, and 16,424 AF for recreation.¹ Of the 42,225 AF storage volume, 38,000 AF had a priority date of May 6, 1981, and 4,225 AF had a priority date of February 23, 1982. The T-9543 Final Order

¹ Due to a scrivener's error, Certificate 75970 stated the storage volume for recreation as 14,626 AF. The T-9543 Final Order corrected storage volume for recreation to 16,424 AF.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

approved the transfer 4,000 AF with a priority date of May 6, 1981, from irrigation to multiple purpose.

2. On June 3, 2016, remaining right Certificate 91395 was issued describing the amount of water to be stored, in part, as, "The date of priority is May 6, 1981, FOR 38,000 ACRE-FEET (AF)..." The 4,000 AF involved in T-9543 was erroneously included in the remaining right's 38,000 AF and should not have been included. Instead, the 4,000 AF should have been deducted from the amount and remaining right Certificate 91395 should have stated that it allows storage of 34,000 AF with a priority date of May 6, 1981.
3. On May 23, 2022, DOUGLAS COUNTY NATURAL RESOURCES, filed an application to change the character of use under Certificate 91395. The Department assigned the application number T-14010.
4. On April 24, 2025, the Department determined there was a discrepancy with Certificate 91395. As described in Finding of Fact #2 above, there is a 4,000 acre-feet (AF) discrepancy in the amount of water to be stored with a priority date of May 6, 1981.
5. On June 10, 2025, a Final Order Approving a Change in Character of Use, recorded in Special Order Volume 134, Pages 933 to 937 ("Final Order"), was issued by the Department. Certificate 91395 was cancelled and remaining right Certificate 98244 was issued. When remaining right Certificate 98244 was issued, the 4,000 AF discrepancy was not taken from the appropriate priority date (May 6, 1981). Therefore, it was determined that this was an error by the Department, and that this superseding order and certificate should be issued to correctly describe the amount of water to be stored under Remaining Right Certificate 98244 and T-14010.
6. The volume of water to be changed under T-14010 is 16,424 AF, being 14,608.7 AF with the May 6, 1981, priority date, and 1815.3 AF with the February 23, 1982, priority date.

The Findings of Fact in the Final Order are incorporated herein, except that Finding of Fact #9 is changed to read as follows:

Conclusions of Law

The conclusions of law in the Final Order are incorporated herein. Under OAR 137-003-0675, the Department may enter a new final order on reconsideration modifying the Final Order and may issue a new remaining right Certificate in accordance with the final order on reconsideration.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. This Final Order on Reconsideration supersedes the Final Order issued on June 10, 2025, and recorded in Special Order Volume 134, Pages 933 to 937. The Final Order is of no further force or effect.
2. The change in character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14010 is approved.
3. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 91395 and any related decree.
4. Water right Certificate 91395 is cancelled.

5. Remaining right Certificate 98539 is issued to supersede Certificate 98244.
6. Certificate 98244 is hereby withdrawn and is of no further force or effect.
8. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install staff gages, or, with prior approval of the Director, other suitable measuring devices, that measure the entire range and stage between empty and full in each reservoir. Staff gages shall be United States Geological Survey style.
 - b. Before water use may begin under this order, if the reservoir is located in channel, weirs or other suitable measuring devices must be installed upstream and downstream of the reservoir, and, an adjustable outlet valve must be installed. The water user shall maintain such devices in good working order. A written waiver may be obtained, if in the judgment of the Director, the installation of weirs or other suitable measuring devices, or the adjustable outlet valve, will provide no public benefit.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the devices; provided however, where any device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
9. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2026**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
10. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

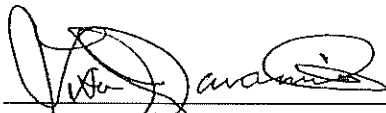

Findings of Fact

1. On May 23, 2022, DOUGLAS COUNTY NATURAL RESOURCES, filed an application to change the character of use under Certificate 91395. The Department assigned the application number T-14010.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on June 7, 2022, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. On November 1, 2024, the Department notified the applicant's agent via phone call of inconsistencies between the map and Table 2 of the application.
4. On November 5, 2024, the agent for the applicant submitted a revised application map, satisfying the inconsistencies.
5. On December 19, 2024, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14010 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of January 18, 2025, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a

Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

6. On December 23, 2024, the applicant's agent submitted an amended application page, adding the signee to the applicant information page.
7. On March 21, 2025, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14010 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on March 25, 2025, and in the Roseburg News Review newspaper on March 27, and April 3, 2025, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
8. On April 24, 2025, the Department noticed a discrepancy with Certificate 91395. There is a 4,000 acre-feet discrepancy in the amount of water to be held with a Priority Date of February 23, 1982 (1982 Date). As a part of a previous transfer (T-9453), the 4,000 acres of the 1982 Date were transferred, and were not removed from Certificate 91395. These acres will be removed on the Remaining Right (Certificate 98244) under this transfer.
9. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

10. Transfer Application T-14010 proposes to change the character of use to MULTIPURPOSE.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-0100(14), 690-380-4010(2) and 690-380-2300]

11. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
12. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14010.
13. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
14. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the right.

15. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in injury to other existing water rights.
16. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

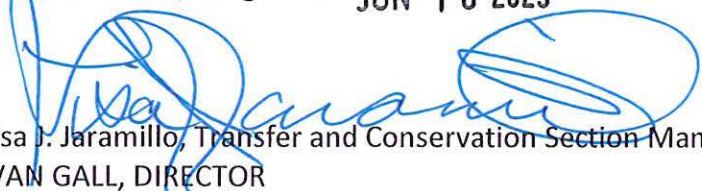

A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.

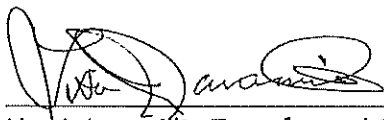

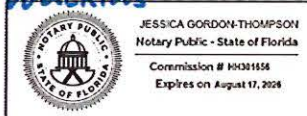

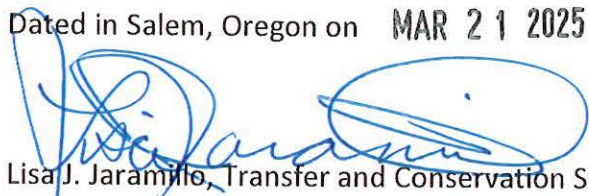

Protests

Under the provisions of ORS 540.520(6) & (7) and OAR 690-380-4030, within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later, any person may file, jointly or severally, a protest expressing opposition of approval of the transfer application and disagreement with this Preliminary Determination or a standing statement in support of this Preliminary Determination. If this Preliminary Determination determines that a change in point of diversion or appropriation would result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050. Protests and standing statements must be received by the Water Resources Department within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later.

Protests must be in writing and received in hard copy form with the appropriate statutory protest filing fee; protests cannot be filed by electronic mail. [OAR 690-002-0025(3) and 690-380-0100(9)]. The protest must include the following:

- The person's name, address, and telephone number;
- All reasonably ascertainable issues and all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position by the close of the protest period. Failure to raise a reasonably ascertainable issue in a protest or failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the Department an opportunity to respond to the issue may preclude consideration of the issue during the hearing;
- If you are the applicant, a protest fee of \$480 required by ORS 536.050; and
- If you are not the applicant, a protest fee of \$950 required by ORS 536.050 and proof of service of the protest upon the applicant.

Requests for Standing

Under the provisions of OAR 690-380-4030(5), the Department shall provide to persons who have filed standing statements as defined under OAR 690-380-0100(11) notice of any differences between the Department's Preliminary Determination and the Final Order, notice of a hearing on the application under OAR 137-003-0535, and an opportunity to request limited party status or party status in the hearing.

Requests for standing must be received in the Water Resources Department no later than 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later. Requests for standing must be in writing, and must include the following:

- The requester's name, mailing address and telephone number;
- If the requester is representing a group, association or other organization, the name, address and telephone number of the represented group;
- A statement that the requester supports the preliminary determination as issued.

After the protest period has ended, the Director will either issue a Final Order or schedule a contested case hearing. The contested case hearing will be scheduled only if a protest has been filed under OAR 690-380-4030. In accordance with OAR 690-380-4200, notice and conduct of the hearing shall:

- Be under the applicable provisions of ORS 183.310 to 183.550, pertaining to contested cases, and the hearing shall be held in the area where the rights are located unless all parties stipulate otherwise; and
- If a protest has asserted that a water right to be transferred has been forfeited through non-use, include the notice and procedures described in OAR 690-017-0500 to 690-017-0900.

If after hearing the Department issues a proposed Final Order finding that a change in point of diversion or appropriation will result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050 within 15 days of receipt of the proposed order. Notwithstanding 690-002-0175, if the applicant files a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050, the deadline for filing exceptions to the proposed order shall be 30 days after the Department provides notice to the parties that the transfer does not meet the requirements of 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050.

If you do not request a hearing within 30 days after the close of the protest period, or if you withdraw a request for a hearing, notify the Department or the administrative law judge that you will not appear, or fail to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Director may issue a final order by default. If the Director issues a Final Order by default, the Department designates the relevant portions of its files on this matter, including all materials that you have submitted relating to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a *prima facie* case upon default.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

This application may require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not use water for the new use until a final order approving the transfer application has been issued by the Department. In order to avoid any possible forfeiture of the water right, you should continue to use the water as described by your existing water right.
