confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK WILLIAMS CREEK, a tributary of WILLIAMS CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 2729. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 24, 1915. The right is limited to not more than 0.025 CUBIC FOOT SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 14, T 39 S, R 5 W, W.M.; EASTSIDE DITCH.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 17, 1981, and together with certificate 50378, supersedes certificate 2192, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This is to Certify, That D. S. RIGEL, IRVEN RIGEL AND NOAH RIGEL

of Williams, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Williams Creek, a tributary of Applegate and Rogue River, for the purpose of the irrigation of 33 acres of land

under Permit No. 2729 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered

of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1,

at page 311, on the 2nd day of December, 1918; that the priority of

the right hereby confirmed dates from November 24, 1915; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 0.415 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Office. On April 10, 1981, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Faye M. Rigel for approval of a change in place of use of water from East Fork Williams Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 2192, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of D.S. Rigel, Irven Rigel and Noah Rigel, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second from East Fork Williams Creek for irrigation of a certain 2.0 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 11, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, WM, with a date of priority of November 24, 1915.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Eastside Ditch, from a point located within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain other 2.0 acres within said NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of said Section 11.

Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

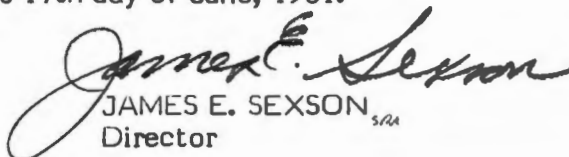
NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1982.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 2192, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this

proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

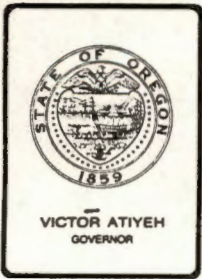

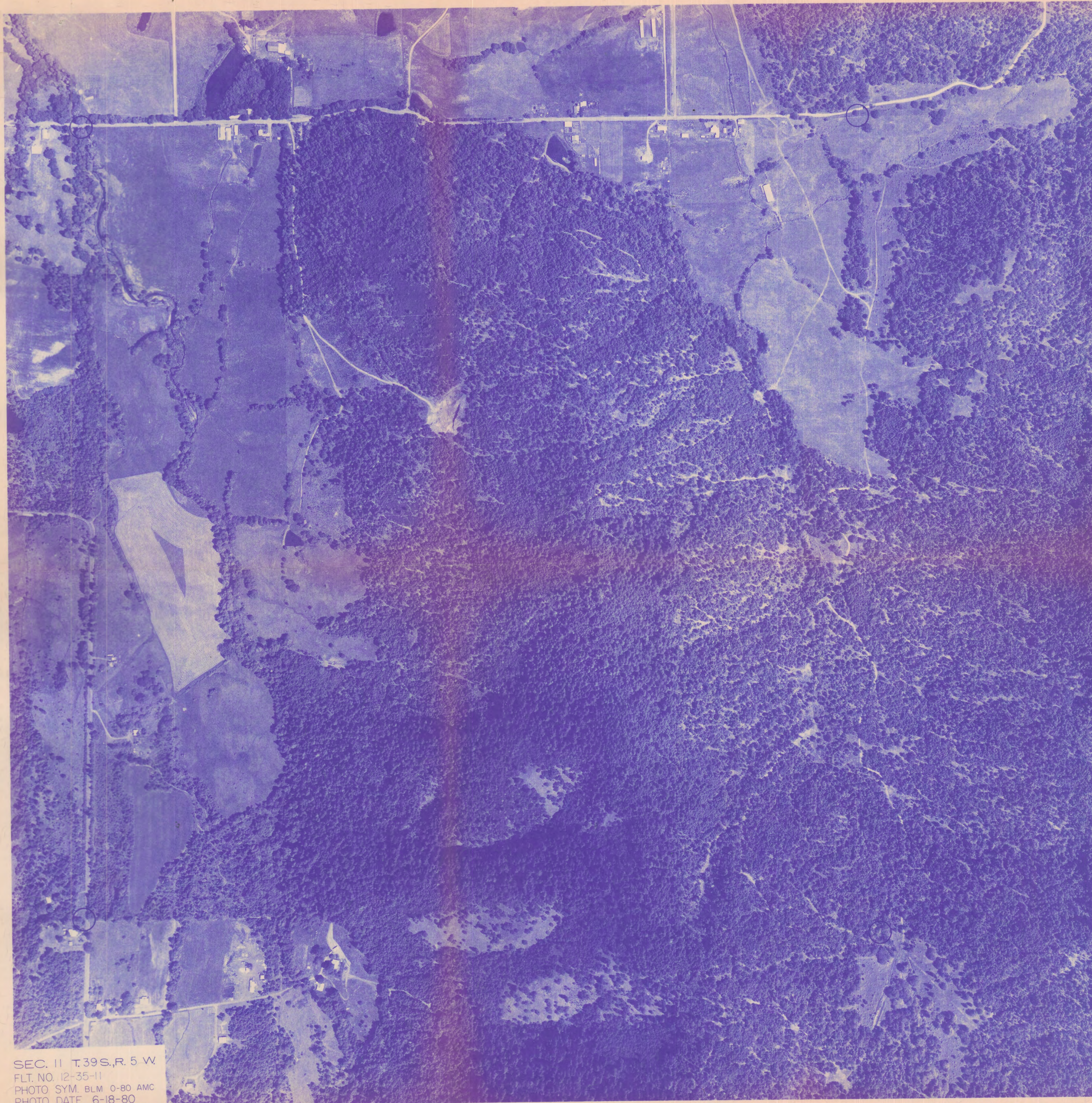
