Authority

Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 690-380-5140(2) authorizes the Department to grant an extension of time to complete a transfer.

OAR 690-380-6020 establishes an application process and criteria for the review of extensions of time to complete a transfer as authorized by a final order issued under OAR Division 380.

OAR 690-380-6020 (3) establishes that extensions are granted for one year, from October 1 to October 1 of each year. Extensions may be granted for longer time if the applicant can justify the need for a longer period of time by submission of pertinent evidence.

Findings of Fact

1. On May 4, 2026, the Department received an application for extension of time for Transfer Application T-8422.
2. On August 11, 2004, the Department signed an order approving Transfer Application T-8422 for change in place of use and point of appropriation. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 61, Pages 242-248. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2005.
3. On May 5, 2026, the Department recorded assignment by proof from Charles A. Bloodsworth to Roza Partners, LLC.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

4. Since the approval of the transfer, the original applicant initiated construction of the change in point of appropriation and place of use. Due to unforeseen circumstances the original applicant was not able to complete the required changes.
5. Since taking ownership of the property involved in transfer T-8422 in 2023, the current applicant has completed construction of the approved changes, irrigated the approved place of use, and made full beneficial use of the water right.
6. The changes were fully completed by the applicant in 2021 and 2024.
7. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2024. It has been almost 20 years since the issuance of the final order for T-8422 to the date the current extension application was filed. The completion date will be extended to bring the transfer file back into compliance. Consistent with OAR 690-380-6020(3), the Department will extend the transfer completion date to October 1, 2024.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-8422.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the changes authorized by Transfer Application T-8422 shall be extended to **October 1, 2024**.

Billy was seriously injured in a farming accident and passed away before completing the effort involved in the transfer. Charles passed away himself never recovering from the death of his son. This all happened before all the areas authorized in the transfer became irrigated. Roza Partners LLC rented, leased and farmed the Bloodsworth Farm after Charles' death. Charles' wife and Son-in-law put the property up for sale and Roza Partners, LLC purchased it without the knowledge of the transfer. Upon learning of the transfer, completed the irrigation of the area involved in the transfer in 2021 and 2024.

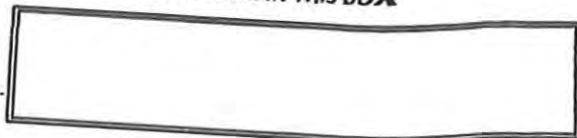

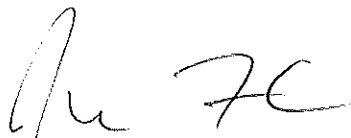

This letter is in regard to the Water Right Transfer Application referenced above. The Final Order approving this transfer, issued on August 11, 2004 (copy enclosed), required the transfer applicant of record to complete development of the changes to your water right by October 1, 2006. To date, the Department has not received proof (a Claim of Beneficial Use (COBU)) demonstrating that the proposed changes approved in the Final Order were completed according to the terms and conditions of said Final Order.

Why is this important?

Failure to complete development of the changes under your transfer by the above date, or by the date authorized under a subsequent Transfer Extension of Time approval, will result in serious consequences to the water right:

- **Transfers involving Changes in Character of Use or Place of Use:** OAR 690-380-6010(2) *"Any part of a transferred water use that is not applied to beneficial use under the terms of the transfer order for change in use or place of use, or within any extension of time allowed for completion, is lost."*
- **Transfers involving Changes in Point of Diversion or Point of Appropriation:** OAR 690-380-6010(3) *"Non-completion of a change in point of diversion or appropriation does not forfeit the water use subject to transfer. However, upon expiration of the time allowed for completion, the water use shall again become subject to forfeiture pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.610."* (6) *"If the change in point of diversion or appropriation is not completed, the point of diversion or appropriation shall revert to the last authorized point of diversion or appropriation prior to the transfer."*

NOTE: For transfers involving both a Change in Character of Use or Place of Use and a Change in Point of Diversion or Point of Appropriation for the same lands, be advised that only the point of

diversion/appropriation may revert if the change is not completed within the authorized timeframe; any portion of a change in character of use or place of use not applied to beneficial use may be lost.

What are my options?

The transfer holder of record or receiving landowner may choose one of the following options:

1. **File for a Transfer Extension of Time:** If you are not finished with the development of changes under your water right transfer, you need to file an *Application for Extension of Time for Transfer of Water Right* to complete your development. The fee for filing an extension of time is \$1,170.00. *Note: Filing of an extension of time does not guarantee approval of more time to complete the change. Each extension application is evaluated on due diligence and compliance with transfer final order conditions during the time period authorized for development.*

2. **Submit a Claim of Beneficial Use:** If you have completed development of the changes according to the terms and conditions of your transfer final order, you are required by law to hire a certified water right examiner to prepare and submit a Claim of Beneficial Use (COBU) report that includes a final proof survey map of the development. The map and claim of beneficial use report are to be submitted to our Department within one year of the completion date established in the Final Order. The fee for submitting a claim of beneficial use for transfer of a water right having a priority date of July 9, 1987, or later, is \$345.00.

3. **Assign the file to a new landowner:** If you no longer wish to be the transfer holder of record or receiving landowner of record, a *Request for Assignment* is needed to assign the transfer to a new transfer holder of record. The fee for submitting a Request for Assignment is \$180.00. Doing so results in this person becoming responsible for submitting the Claim of Beneficial Use report or Transfer Extension of Time application.

4. **Request a reversion of your change in Point of Appropriation or Point of Diversion:** If you do not intend to complete development of a change in point of appropriation or point of diversion and you wish the water right to revert to the last authorized point of appropriation or point of diversion, please send a letter addressed to the Transfer Section at the above address, stating that request. The department will then issue a Final Order and a new water right certificate, reverting to the last authorized point of appropriation or point of diversion prior to the transfer.

5. **Choose not to complete Character of Use or Place of Use change(s) and submit a Voluntary Cancellation request:** If you have not completed development of the Character of Use or Place of Use changes under your transfer, and you do not intend to do so in the future, please submit a request to voluntarily cancel the portion of the water right involved in the transfer.

What happens if you don't choose one of the above options?

If you choose not to pursue one of the options identified above within 60 days of the date of this letter, March 7, 2026, the Department shall issue either a Final Order authorizing the loss of the right and/or a Final Order reverting the affected portion of your water right, depending on the type of change proposed by the transfer application. If you need additional time to have a Claim of Beneficial Use prepared and submitted, please respond to me by the deadline listed above to halt further proceedings.

CANCELLATION OF A PORTION OF WATER RIGHT CERTIFICATE 51998

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter and order canceling the water right."

On January 20, 2000, the Department received an affidavit which accompanied the transfer application from Charles A. Bloodsworth,

owner of certain lands to which a supplemental water right is appurtenant to. The transfer request, in part, proposes to change the point of appropriation of the underlying primary rights to the same well as this supplemental groundwater right. The Department cannot allow a primary and supplemental right to receive water from the same source, in this case it is the same well. It is requested that a portion of water right Certificate 51998 be canceled.

The portion of water right Certificate 51998 to be canceled is:

A portion of the right described by Certificate 51998, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The right to be canceled is for the use of 0.21 cubic foot per second from the Lewis H. Wilson Well, within the Umatilla River Basin. The date of priority is October 28, 1974. The portion of the right to be canceled is for the supplemental irrigation of 17.0 acres.

A description of the place of use of the portion to be canceled is described as follows:

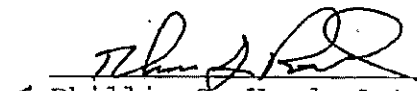
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

The 17.0 acres of Certificate 51998 requested to be canceled, are canceled.

Certificate 76001, 51997, 51996 and 51998 are canceled. A new certificate will be issued to describe that portion of water right Certificate 76001, NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes are received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS, within the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN, for the IRRIGATION of 120.8 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 161.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5763. The date of priority is APRIL 16, 1973.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.48 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, being 0.35 CFS FROM WELL 1 and 3.13 CFS FROM WELL 2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL 1 - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 5 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 700 FEET NORTH AND 510 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 19

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or it's equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall conform

to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

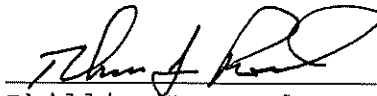

Pursuant to ORS. 537.705, Charles A. Bloodsworth has requested a change in PLACE OF USE and change in POINTS OF APPROPRIATION for certificates 76001, 51996, 51997 and 51998 , and the PARTIAL CANCELLATION OF A WATER RIGHT (Certificate 51998).

The proposed changes required publication of notice in the newspaper. No comments or timely protests were received in response to the published notice.

The Watermaster and Groundwater staff have reviewed the transfer application and found that no injury to existing rights or enlargement would result from the changes.

I recommend that the transfer be approved.
