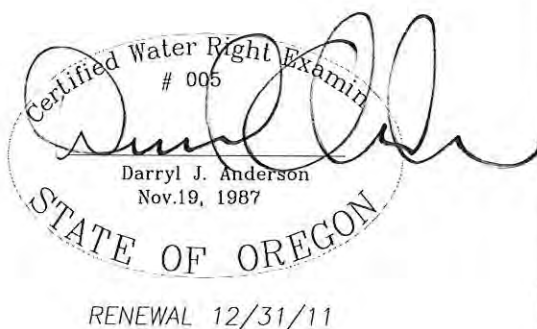

Step Test

The step test of the replacement to Lakeview Well 4 (Well 4R) was conducted by Western Water Development under the supervision of Anderson Engineering and Surveying, Inc. (AESI) on April 28, 2008. It comprised four steps of one hour duration each. The data are summarized in Table 1.

The test data collected by AESI were provided to ECO:LOGIC for analysis. They were analyzed using the computer program AQTESOLV (HydroSOLVE, 2006). A good match between observed and simulated drawdown was achieved using an analytical model developed by Dougherty and Babu (1984) which describes unsteady flow in a confined aquifer for a fully or partially penetrating well. The analysis yielded the following:

Transmissivity, $T \approx 2,200 \text{ feet}^2/\text{day}$ ($\approx 16,000 \text{ gpd/ft}$)

Storage coefficient ≈ 0.0001 (dimensionless)

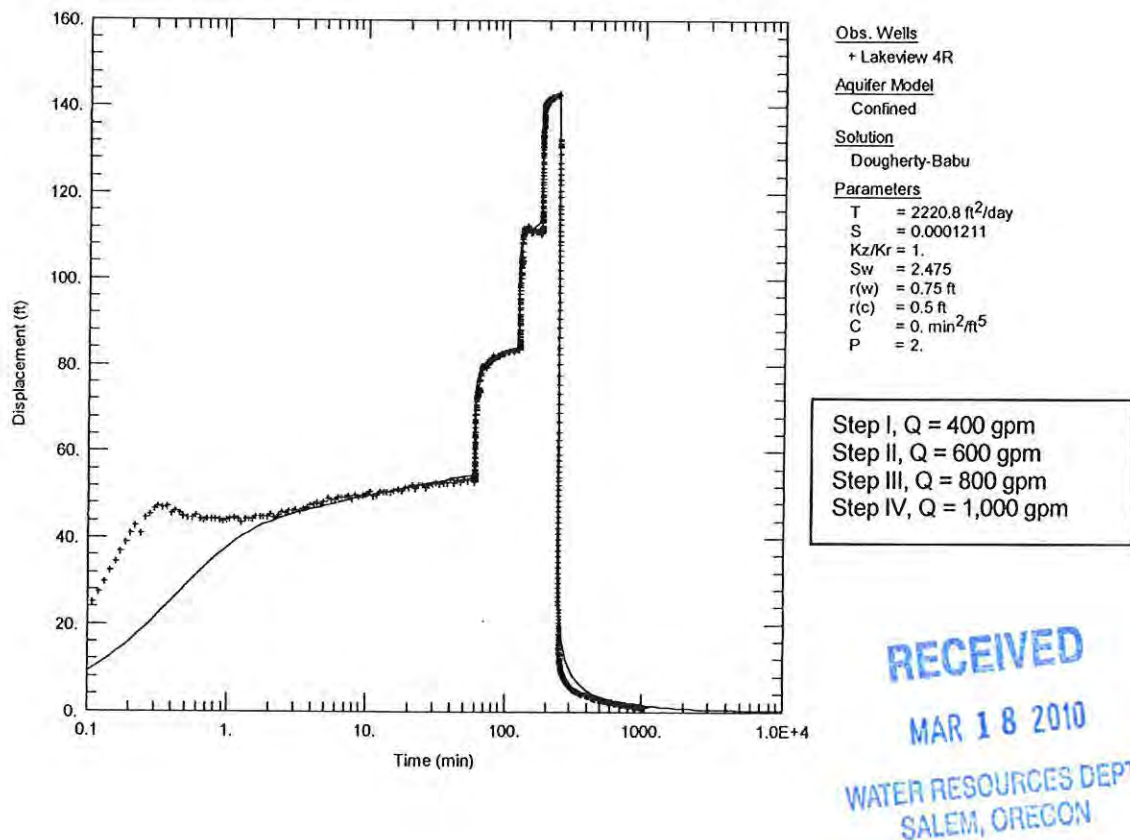


FIGURE 1. AQTESOLV solution to Lakeview Well 4R step-drawdown test data.

Wellbore skin ≈ 2.5 (dimensionless) (see Figure 1).

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Note that the storage coefficient cannot be calculated directly from the pumped well data. It was estimated using a method of successive approximations. However, the combination of skin and storage coefficient result in a non-unique solution, so the best fit was achieved using the judgment of the analyst.

The data suggest virtually no well loss due to turbulent flow (well loss coefficient, $C = 0$), but drawdown in the well and overall well efficiency does appear to be influenced by a positive skin factor. Overall efficiency of the well is approximately 77 percent, which is reasonably good.

Constant-discharge Test

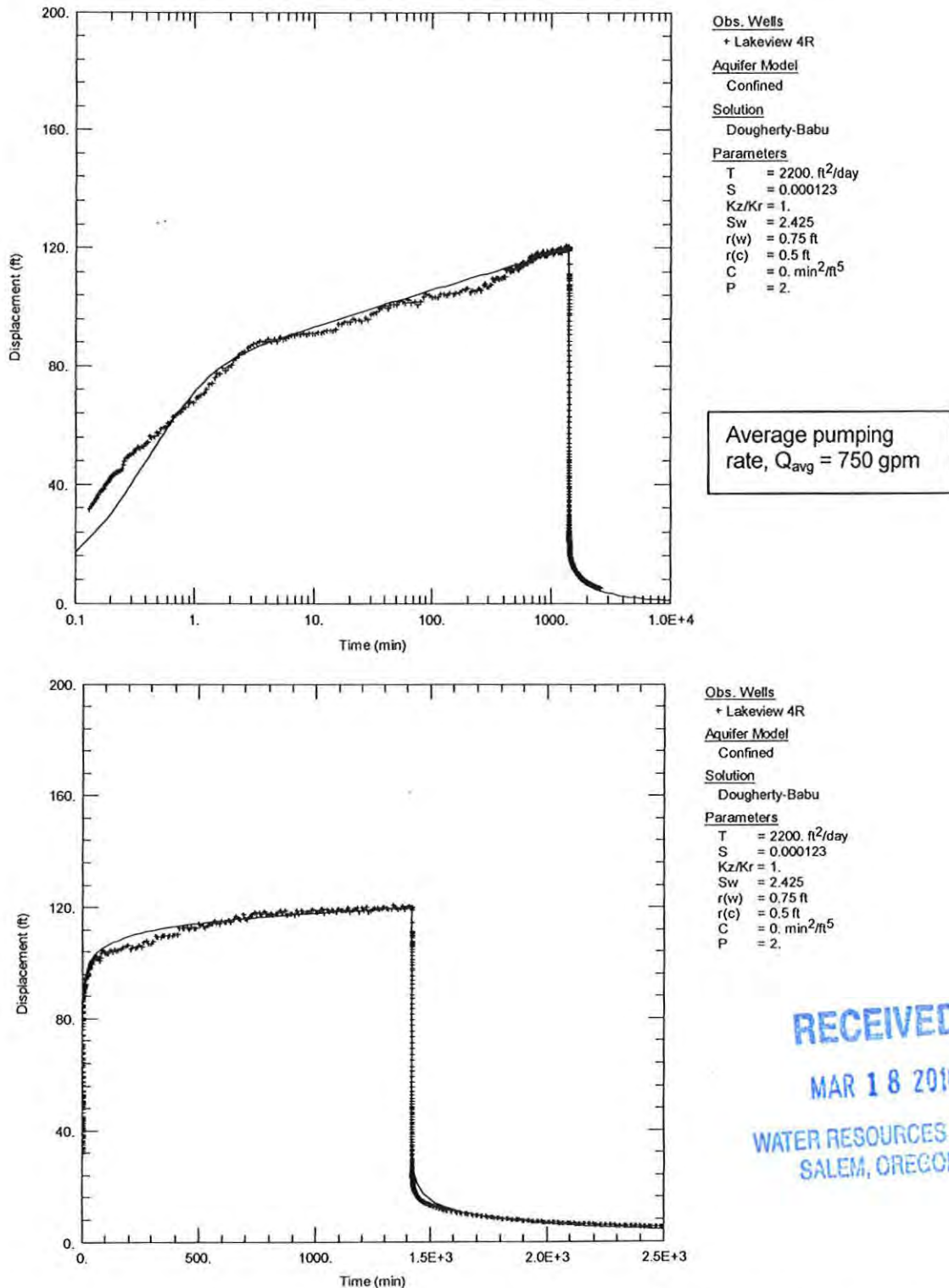


FIGURE 2. AQTESOLV solution to Lakeview Well 4R constant-discharge test data.

A 24-hour duration constant-discharge pumping test was performed May 7 and 8, 2008 under the supervision of AESI. The well was pumped at an average rate of approximately 750 gpm for 24 hours. A good correlation between observed and theoretical drawdown in the well was achieved using values for transmissivity, storage coefficient, and wellbore skin

consistent with those determined from the step test data analysis. The drawdown and recovery data are compared with the theoretical drawdown in the well in Figure 2.

Predicted performance of Well 4R.

The long-term performance of Well 4R was estimated using the "forward modeling" capabilities of AQTESOLV. Assumptions include:

Transmissivity, $T \approx 2,200 \text{ feet}^2/\text{day}$ ($\approx 16,000 \text{ gpd/ft}$)

Storage coefficient ≈ 0.0001 (dimensionless)

Wellbore skin ≈ 2.5 (dimensionless)

Borehole diameter = 18 inches

Casing diameter = 12 inches

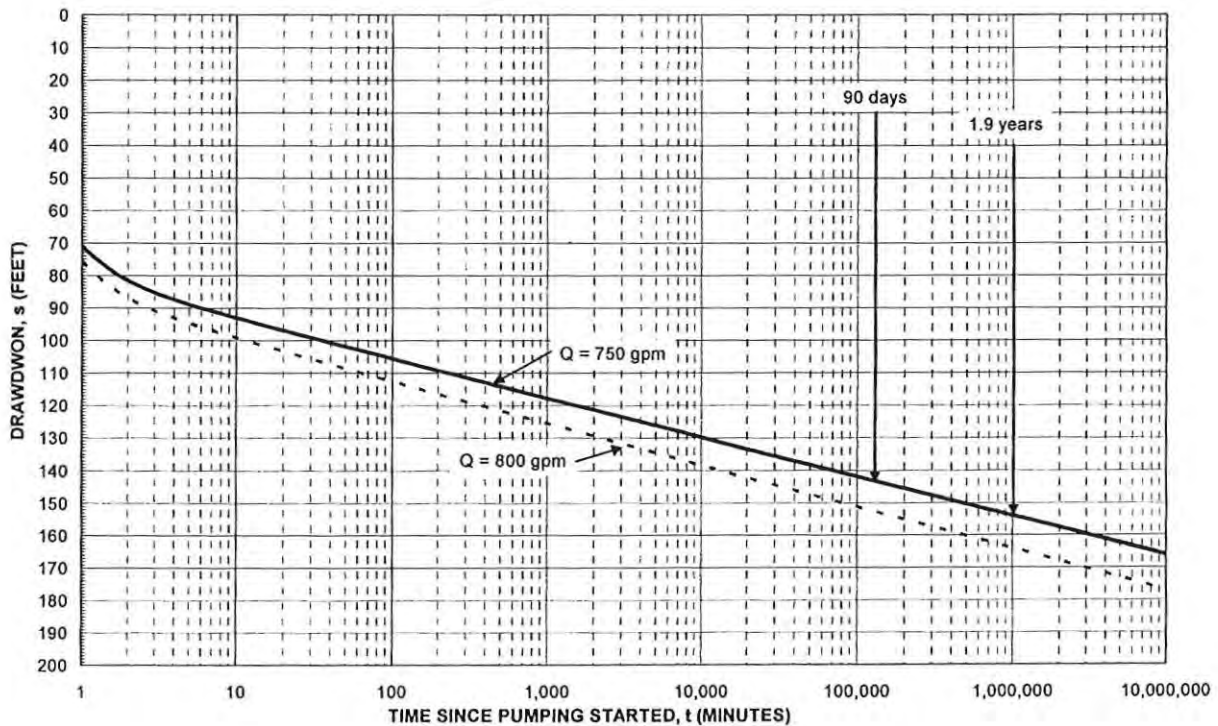


FIGURE 3. Predicted drawdown in Lakeview Well 4R.

Furthermore, the well is assumed to pump continuously 24 hours per day and seven days per week for the entire simulation period. In addition, all of the water is assumed to be derived from storage in the aquifer, i.e., no recharge to the aquifer occurs during the simulation period. The results of the simulation are depicted in Figure 3.

LAKEVIEW, OR WELL 4 REPLACEMENT

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From Figure 3, it is apparent that if Well 4R is pumped continuously at 750 gpm, approximately 143 feet of drawdown should be anticipated after 90 days. Assuming a static water level of 15 feet below the land surface, the pumping level after 90 days of pumping can be expected to be approximately 158 feet below the land surface. However, water levels in the alluvial aquifer system near Lakeview experience seasonal fluctuations of several 10's of feet. Given that the perforations in Well 4R begin 210 feet below the land surface, the pumping level in the well is not expected to be drawn down below the top of the perforations under normal operating conditions at the recommended rate of 750 gpm. The well might be equipped to pump as high as 800 gpm, which would result in a 90-day pumping level of 167 feet below land surface, but this allows for a smaller margin of error in the analysis. Actual performance of the well may vary because the conditions in most aquifers differ from the idealized aquifer assumed in the analysis.

In summary, we recommend the following:

- Design pumping rate – 750 gpm
- Design pumping level – 158 feet below the land surface.
- Pump setting – approximately 250 to 270 feet below the land surface (within the blank well casing located between 230 and 285 feet below the land surface).

No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

7. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
8. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application T-10526.
9. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
10. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The additional point of appropriation proposed in application T-10526 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

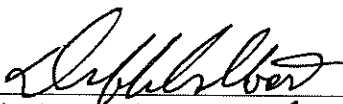
Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The additional point of appropriation proposed in application T-10526 is approved.

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2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 36772 and any related decree.
3. Water right certificate 36772 is cancelled.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
5. The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
6. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. The water user shall maintain and operate the measuring device as required by the Department.
7. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2014**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
8. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

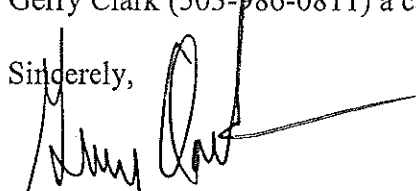
Dear Mr. Anderson:

Governor Theodore Kulongoski signed SB788 on July 23, 2009, which, in part, raised the fee for many of the Department's water right related processes and created fees for processes not previously requiring fees. The Bill created a fee for the submittal of a Claim of Beneficial Use (Claim). The Department has determined that the Bill did not contain a requirement for a fee to be submitted for transfer Claims; only for Claims for permits having a priority date of July 9, 1987, or later.

The main purpose of this letter is to return the fees submitted with the Claims. In the future, the Department will review the Claims to determine the amount of beneficial use developed within the terms and conditions of the transfer final orders. At that time, additional information may be requested.

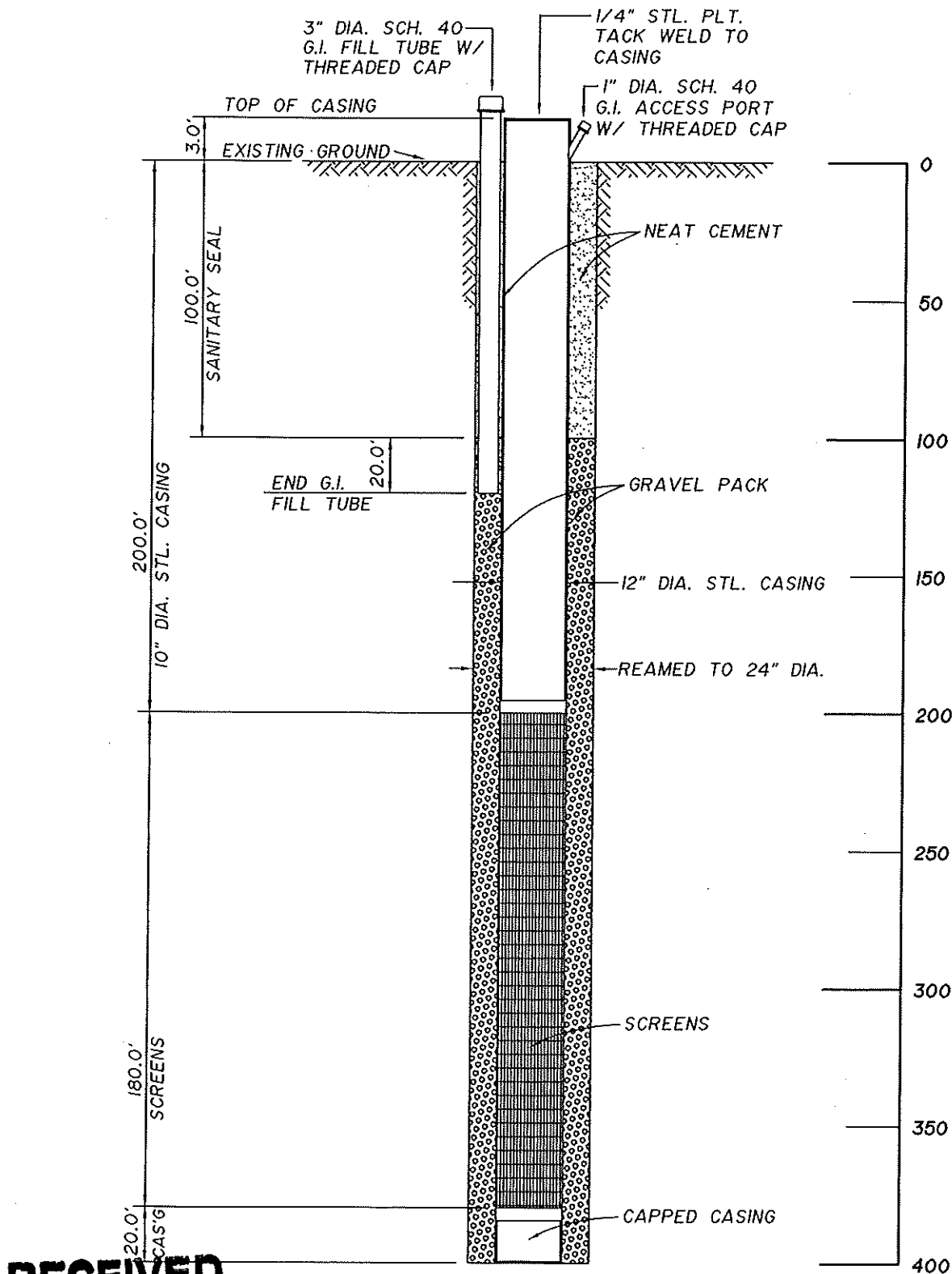

SUBJECT: Review

The transfer proposes to add an additional POA (well). This additional well would be the same well as the "new #4" that is proposed by T-10525.

The proposed POD is only about 2000 feet northwest from the existing, authorized well and would be of a very similar construction.

There are some domestic wells in the area per the well reports and some permitted wells in the area per WRD records. However, I see very limited potential for injury since the well hydraulics are good, aquifer depth is deep, and the spacing between wells is likely great. Therefore, I conclude that the proposed changes may be made without injury to an existing water right.

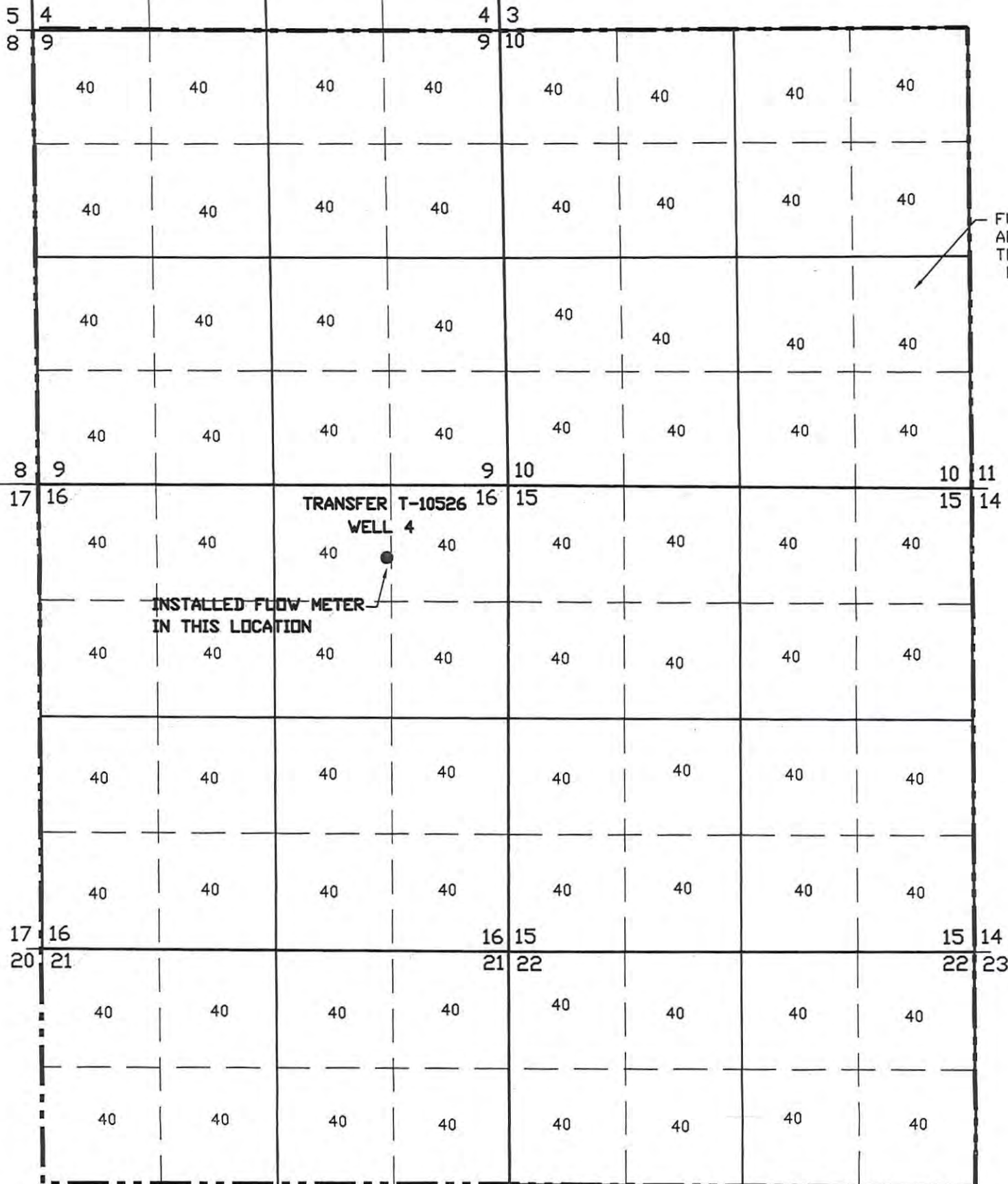

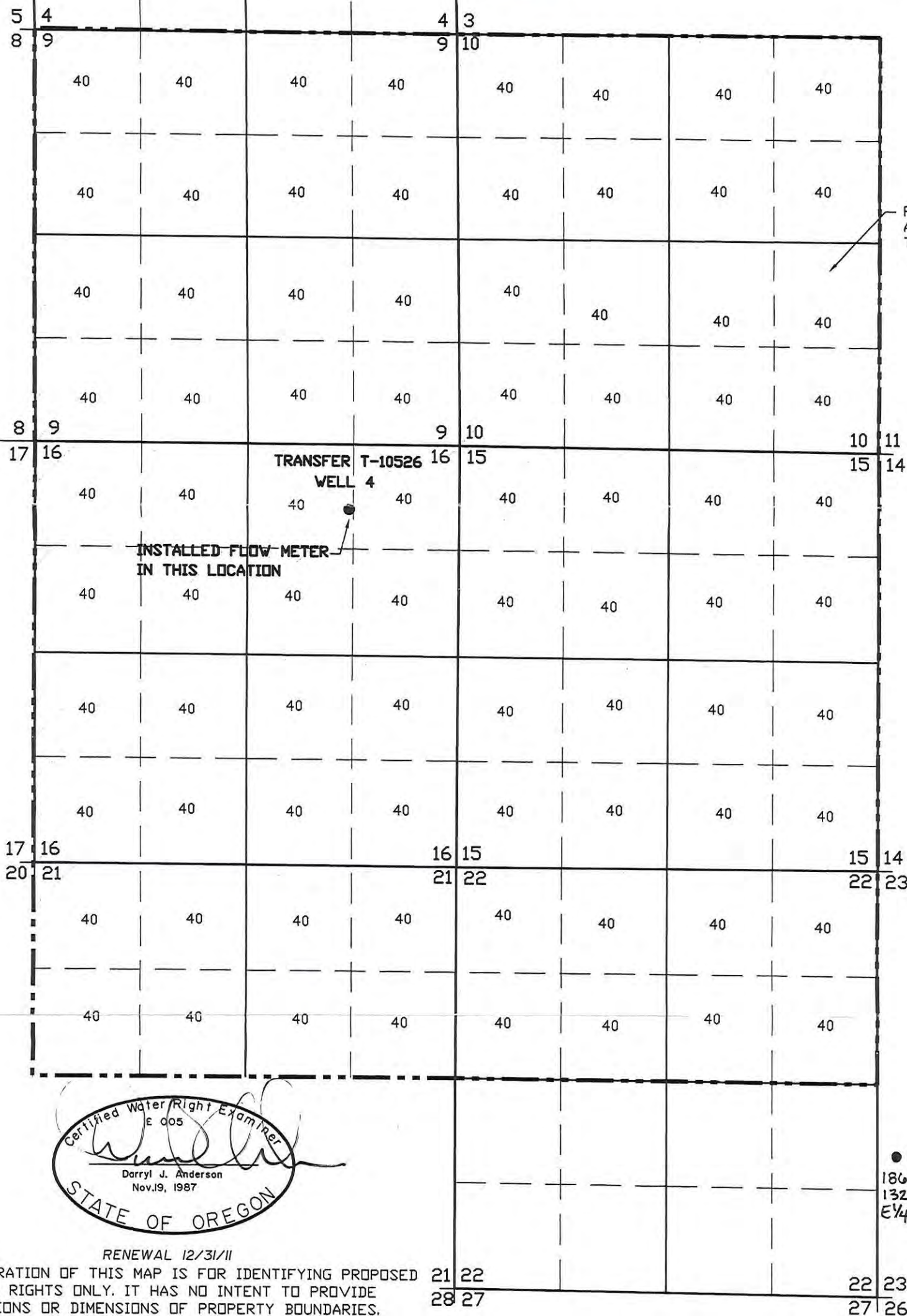
