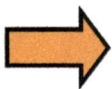

We are now applying to add the two other wells on our property GR-859 (MARI 4749) and Certificate 42225 (MARI 6493) to reflect our current system operation using all the existing wells.

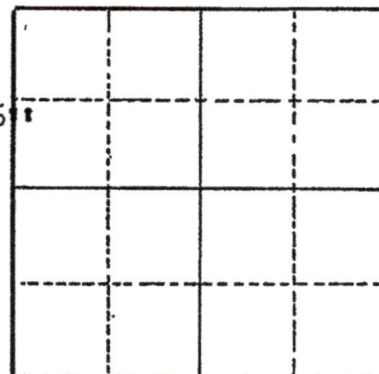

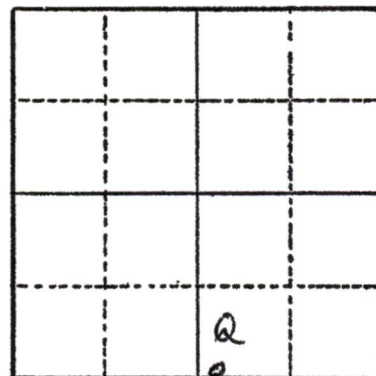
