CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SCHIEDEL NURSERY
11410 FARGO ROAD NE
AURORA, OREGON 97002

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 98.0 ACRES.

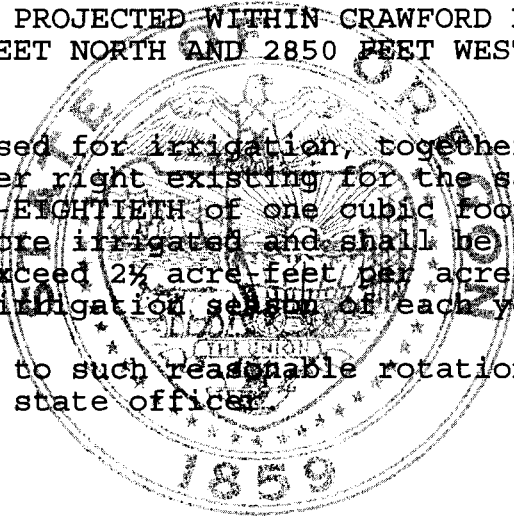
This right was perfected under Permit G-3758. The date of priority is JULY 24, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.79 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN CRAWFORD DLC 41, SECTION 9, T 4 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 890 FEET NORTH AND 2850 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF CRAWFORD DLC 41.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officers.

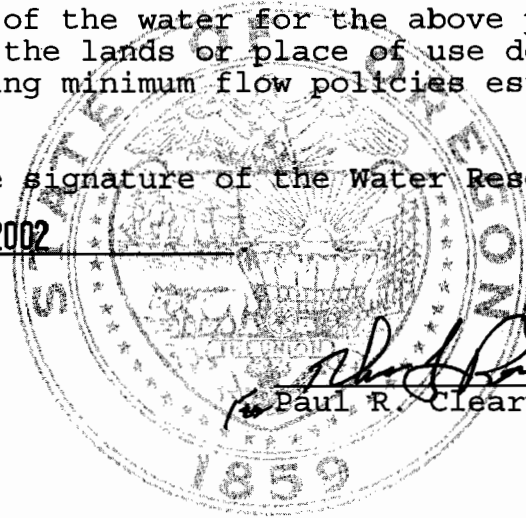
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
