Authority

- 28. Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 14, 2003, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 29. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and/or safely transport fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted and that the diversion is not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screening and/or by-pass device. Listed fish species are not present at the point of diversion, the originating water right diversion is not screened, cost-share funds are not currently available, and the proposed diversion may be eligible for ODFW's cost-share program. A grace period of two years is appropriate until such time as cost share funds become available to assist in the construction of a fish screening and/or by-pass device. If cost share funds do not become available, the water user must screen within the indicated time period regardless of the availability of cost share funding.
- 30. On August 16, 2007, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-9567 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline of September 9, 2007, for the applicant to respond. The applicant did not provide any comments.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 31. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 32. A diversion structure and ditch or a pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application T-9567.
- 33. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 34. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 35. The proposed changes will be confirmed by the approval of the Burnt River Irrigation District HB-3111/SB129 petition.

Determination and Proposed Action

The additional points of diversion proposed in application T-9567 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If application T-9567 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The additional points of diversion proposed in application T-9567 are approved.
- 2. Water Right Certificates 5875, 5877, 5919, 5972, 5992, 6004, 6034, 6038, 6040, 6052, 6063, 6137, and 9286 are modified. Superseding certificates will be issued upon approval of the Burnt River Irrigation District HB-3111/SB-129 petition.
- 3. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 5875, 5877, 5919, 5972, 5992, 6004, 6034, 6038, 6040, 6052, 6063, 6137, 9286, and any related decree.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of diversion, together with that diverted at the original points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.
- 5. Within two years after the date of this order, the water user shall install a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) design and construction standards. Prior to installation, the water user shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screen and/or by-pass device meets ODFW's criteria. The water user may withdraw water at the new point of diversion without screening or by-pass devices until two years after the date of this order. Prior to submitting a Claim of Beneficial Use, the water user must obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screening and/or by-pass device was installed to the state's criteria. The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.
- 6. When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate headgates to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgates must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 7. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 2010.
- 8. The approved HB-311/SB-129 petition for Burnt River Irrigation District shall serve as the Claim of Beneficial Use Report for Transfer Application T-9567.
